CAIRO CENTRE OF BRITISH EMPIRE

Even the Revival of the Treaty of 1833 Might Be a Blessing in Disguise.

London, Oct. 19.—The supremacy of industrial forces in a world once swayed by dynastic ambitions and diplomatic intrigues has been demonstrated by the events of the past week.

From the United States and Germany alike comes evidence of the paramount importance of the modern world. President Roosevelt is not only described by English writers as a man whom Americans trust as they trust Washington and Lincoln, but he is also looked upon as a man of action, with authority as an arbiter in settling questions which were creating world-wide disturbances.

The German Chancellor has chosen the week of the hazy and excitement over the visit of the Kaiser to Berlin for an authoritative speech on the question of German industrial and commercial policy.

The agrarians are proposing in effect to undermine the reciprocity treaties by tariff reconstruction. A parallel may be found in the sugar duties of the Wilson Tariff Bill, by which the entire series of reciprocity treaties negotiated by the Harrison administration was revoked.

The government proposal for the acquisition by the State of six private railways in Prussia is meant as a concession to the agrarian politicians who are overruling the tariff bill by protection for agricultural interests.

Vancouver, Oct. 19.—Dr. A. R. C. Selwyn, formerly director of Dominion Geological Survey, died here this evening, after a long illness. Deceased was 78 years of age.

DEEPLY DISTRESS THAN EVER. Eruption of Soufriere on Oct. 15 and 16 Caused Devastation.

Kingstown, St. Vincent, B.W.I., Oct. 18.—The eruption of the Soufriere volcano on Oct. 15 and 16—the fourth in the break since the catastrophe of May 7—has plunged the colony into deeper distress than before, crippling its agricultural resources by further devastating the already devastated areas of growing crops on lands which had been considered outside the volcanic zone.

IMMIGRANTS TO U.S. 648,743 Arrived During the Last Fiscal Year.

Washington, Oct. 18.—The annual report of the Commissioner of Immigration was made public to-day. It shows that of the 648,743 immigrants who arrived in the United States during the last fiscal year, 406,399 were males and 182,344 females.

A Long Canoe Trip. A. E. Bremner, managing director of the Sturgeon Falls Pulp Company, and C. W. Rantoul, general manager of the company, are to start from Toronto to-day on a canoe trip on the Ottawa river.
