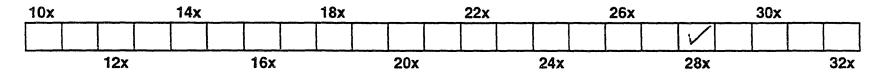

An Act to incorporate the St. George's Society of Toronto.

WHEREAS John Beverley Robinson, Thomas Brown, George S. Preamble. Jones, Robert Dodgson, F. W. Coate, George T. Walton, George Bilton, George Thomas, Henry Godson, Julian Sale, Isaac Falkner, B. Sanders, Frank John Joseph, and others, have by their petition to the Le-

- 5 gislature represented, that the Association, of which they are members, known as the St. George's Society of Toronto, has for many years been formed for the benevolent purposes of affording pecuniary, medical, and other relief to such natives of England and Wales, and their descendants, as may from sickness or other causes have fallen into dis-
- 10 tress, and have prayed that for the better attainment of the objects of the said Association, it may be invested with corporate powers, and by reason of the good effected by the Association, it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., enacts as follows:
- 15 I. The said John Beverley Robinson, M. P. P., Thomas Brown, Certain per-George S. Jones, Robert Dodgson, F. W. Coate, George T. Walton, sons and their Bedrau Badding D. B. - whatsoever, and by that name they and their successors shall have perpetual succession, and may have a common seal, and may break, change, alter, or renew the same at pleasure, and shall have power to
- 30 purchase, take, receive, hold and enjoy any estate whatever, real or personal, and to alienate, sell, convey, lease, or otherwise dispose of the same, or any part thereof, from time to time, and as occasion may require, and other estate, real or personal, to acquire instead thereof; Provided Provise: pro-always, that the clear annual value of the real and personal estate to- perty limited.
- 35 geth r held by the said Corporation at any one time shall not exceed eight thousand dollars; And provided also, that the said Corporation Proviso, shall not have or exercise any corporate powers whatsoever, except such as are expressly conferred on them by this Act, or are necessary for carrying the same into effect according to its true intent and 40 meaning.

II. Provided always, that the said Corporation shall have no power to hold any property except such as shall be derived from the following sources, or purchased with funds derived from the following sources. that is to say: The property of the association hereby transferred to the said Corporation, the life subscription of members, which shall in 5 no case exceed twenty dollars, the annual subscription of members. which shall in no case exceed two dollars per annum, the subscriptions of members to the charitable funds of the Corporation, donations, bequest, or legacies, made to the said Corporation, and the moneys arising from fines and forfeitures lawfully imposed by the by-laws; 10 And provided also, that the property and funds of the association hereby transferred to the said Corporation, and all sums which may hereafter be received by the said Corporation for life subscriptions of members, or from legacies, bequests, or donations, amounting to twenty dollars or upwards, not specially made for other purposes. 15 shall constitute the permanent fund of the Corporation, no part of the capital amount of which shall be expended or paid away, but the whole shall from time to time be invested in real or immoveable property (not exceeding the value afores iid), in bank stock, or Provincial or other securities, and the rents interests, or other income arising from 20 such investments, together with the moneys derived from other sources, shall be applied to the following purposes, that is to say, to defraying the current expenses of the corporation, for the purposes of its institution, and the relief of persons whom the corporation may deem proper objects of such relief according to the by-laws of the Corporation then 25 in force, and to the provisions of this Act.

III. The affairs and business of the said Corporation shall be managed. by a Committee of Management, consisting of a President, a first, second, and third Vice-Presidents, a Secretary or Secretaries, a Treasurer, two Chaplains, three physicians, and seven other Members, to 30 be elected annually at a General Meeting of the members of the Corporation held in conformity to the By-laws thereof, and any five members of the said Committee shall be a quorum for the despatch of business.
