SATURN is a morning star to April 24th, an evening star to November 2nd, afterwards a morning star. MERCURY is a morning star about March 24th, July 22nd, and November 10th, and an evening star about February 9th, June 4th, and October 1st.

VENUS brightest, August 14th, October 26th. MARS not being in opposition during 1895, the satellites will not be visible. The satellites of JUPITER are not visible from June 12th until August 8th, JUPITER being too near the Sun.

As a counter irritant and for Lumps, Swellings and Enlargements the Ointment should be used in smaller quantity and with less rubbing, once a day for two or three days, or until the desired result is obtained. Then wash and oil the affected part twice a day and all soreness and swelling will soon disappear. Experienced horsemen claim that this Ointment is as necessary in the stable as oats or hay.

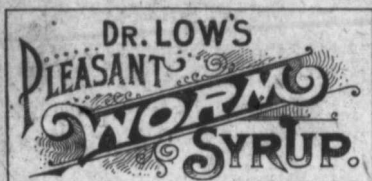
