For years Miss Colburn, who is executive head of the Presbyterian Mission at No. 923 Sacramento-street, had dared much to save Chinese girls and women from actual slavery and enforced degradation. Her life has been threatened by henchmen repeatedly, but she has never flinched in her work.
