CURRENT TRADE CONDITIONS. ONTARIO.

Little has transpired within the past week to change the lumber situation. The strength of white pine is still pronouncedand holders of stock are exhibiting a confidence which augurs well for a firm market throughout the winter. Further purchases of Ottawa valley mill cuts by shippers are reported, although the details are motato hand. On every side comment is heard regarding the strength of the upper grades of pine lumber. In this class the seller controls the market and is in a position to dictate terms to the

pendent upon Ontario for its lumber supply. One estimate places the amount to be exported to the Saginaw river next year at 100,000,000 feet. The buying of hardwoods is mostly in a small way, but it is sufficient to keep stocks down to a reasonable basis. Basswood is scarce and firm in price.

High prices are being realized for pine shingles. A Georgian Bay manufacturer is reported to have sold a quantity of XXX to a Buffalo dealer at \$2.60 at the mill. This, however, is an extreme figure, and is above the current selling price. Nevertheless, the scarcity of shingles brings almost any price within the realm of possibility.

QUEBEC AND NEW BRUNSWICK.

The lumber business is quiet throughout the eastern provinces, as exports have ceased for the season and most of the mills are closed down. The retail demand has shown a falling off during the past week as a result of the cessation of building operations. The figures of the exports of lumber from Montreal, published in another column, show a decrease of about 16,000,000 feet as compared with last year. The total is quite up to expectations, as throughout the entire season the British market was depressed. Shipments of cedar shingles are still being made to the Eastern States. For Boston delivery \$3.20 is being obtained for extras, \$2.90 for clears, \$3.40 for second clears, \$2.15 for saps, and \$1.75 for extra No. 1. The demand for clapboards seems to have been supplied, although the market remains firm at \$32 for extra spruce and \$30 for clear. Logging operations are progressing favorably. Of the 31,000,000 feet of logs stranded in the St. John river, a contract has been given at 5 to 12 cents per log to have nearly 10,000,000 feet hauled ashore. The balance of the logs are above Grand Falls and will probably be saved in the spring. Most of the mills at St. John are shut down, and it is probable that only two will be able to operate all winter. Ocean freights are low.

UNITED STATES.

in the case of certain sizes which are in short supply It was shown at the meeting that there is a very light stock of dimension in large sizes, and that before next spring manufacturers would be completely sold out. The buying of lumber is not particularly active, the recent advance having checked the manufacturers demand, but convinced that the condition of stocks throughout the Mississippi and Wisconsin valleys warrants a firm attitude. An improvement in the conditions surrounding the car shortage situation is reported, and as a result lumber is being shipped in large quantities from Buffalo and Tonawanda to the Eastern States. The higher grades of pine are still advancing. In our Buffalo list the price of fine common has been marked up about \$2 per thousand, as well as No. 1 and No. 2 cutting up stock in 114 and 114 inch. The feeling in Buffalo and Tonawanda is that dealers are in full command of the situation, and that there will be little good pine lumber in the market by spring. The city of New York is said to be short of lumber, with prospects of a heavy demand for building purposes in the early spring. In the Saginaw valley there is an equally confident feeling. Reference to the price list will show an advance of \$3 on nearly all sizes of uppers and selects, and of \$2 on fine common. No. 3 barn boards are also slightly higher, selling on the basis of \$17.50 for 8 to 10 inch. Box lumber, 7 inch and up, brings \$18. Shingles have also been marked up to \$3 for clear butts in pine, and \$3.50 for XXXX cedar. Lath continues strong at \$3 to \$3.25 for both pine and spruce in the A bany

An improvement is noted in the hardwood market, and although the demand is not active prices are becoming firmer all along the line. Birch is scarce and strong, but there is little doing in maple and basswood. Hemlock lumber has been advanced in New York to the basis of \$15.

GREAT BRITAIN.

The timber business of Great Britain is gradually getting into a stronger position. The imports from Canada are al advance. Canadian spruce is showing unusual firmness. For two cargoes of deals just arrived at Liverpool the ship

pers refused to entertain less than £8 c.i.f., although a cargo from Cape Tormentine, N.B., was recently sold to Liverpool buyers at £7 10s. London dealers have sold third quality spruce, 3 x 9, 12 feet and upwards, at £8 125 6d, but it is doubtful that this low price will be repeated again this year. Alfred Dobell & Company, of Liverpool, advise that spruce deals and birch timber are in a decidedly stronger position. Prices of pine deals show some improvement. There is a good demandfor 11-inch, as well as for siding and strips. Second quality is dull of sale. Waney and square pine has improved, and prices are stiffer. Ash is little inquired for, and stocks are accumulating. As far as can be learned, importers have not placed contracts for next year's delivery, and it is improbable that much will be done until after the turn of the year.

STOCKS AND PRICES.

Tuttle Bros., of Wallace, N. S., have contracted to saw 700,000 feet of lumber at Lansdowne, Pictou county.

Thirty million feet of logs were driven to the boom at Bangor, Me., this year, compared with 58,000,000 feet in 1900.

Thomas Mackie, M. P., of Pembroke, is reported to have purchased, for \$100,000, a large timber limit on Garden Island, near Sault Ste. Marie, Ont.

John Wilkinson has been given a contract to get out 1,00,000 feet of logs for Mooney & Company, of St. John, N. B. Hehas 23 men in the woods at Grand

The S. P. Benjamin Company, of Wolfville, N. S., have 250 men in the woods at Upper Falmouth. During the past season the company cut 9,000,000 feet of

The Dominion Government is about to build a wharf at Caraquette, Gloucester county, N. B., which will require a large quantity of timber and will cost upwrids of \$25,000.

In the Buffalo market hoops are scarce and bring \$8.50 to \$8.85 for coiled 51/2 and 6 foot. Basswood heading is selling at 5% to 514 cents for first-class, and elm staves at \$8.25 to \$8.50.

Ernest Marceau, superintending engineer of canals in the province of Quebec, is asking for tenders up to 16th inst. for the supply of timber and lumber required on the canals during next year.

Receipts of lumber at Tonawanda by vessel for the season to December 1st

were 433,654,216 feet, far in excess of the amount that arrived during the season of 1900. The shipments from North Tonawanda were 205,838,854 feet.

The Timber Trades Journal of November 23rd says: "It is rumored that a cargo of spruce deals to be loaded in a steamer now about due at St. John, N. B., has been sold at £7, 15s. c. i..f. or better for the Manchester district.

THE LOGGING SITUATION IN NEW BRUNSWICK.

Last year out of a total cut of about 140,000,000 feet of logs on the St. John river, in New Brunswick, 11,500,000 feet were hung up. This year the cut has been 133,000,000 feet, and of it no less than 31,-000,000 feet have failed to come down. The drives which were hung up last year were 5,000,000 feet of Kilburn's logs and 6,500,000 belonging to the Woodman estate. This year the 31,000,000 feet are divided among different lumber operators, nearly every one having some interest in

Of the drives which have failed to come down, 25,000,000 is regarded as being in danger, while the other 6,000,000 is safe. On the main river, just below Eel river, are 10,000,000 feet of the lower corporation drive. The tail of this drive is twenty miles below Woodstock and thirty miles from the boom limits. It belongs to Geo. Kilburn, W. H. Murray, Cushing, Stelson, Cutler & Co., Charles Miller, N. H. Murchie, Randolph & Baker, Cunliffe Sons, and Dunn Brothers.

Another 10,000,000 is on the main river above Grand Falls. It is owned chiefly by W. H. Murray and is what is known as Kilburn's drive.

The balance of the 25,000,000 which is regarded as being in danger, consists of

5,000,000 feet at present situated at the head of the Aroostock Falls. It is part of the big drive now below Eel river, which failed to get into the main river. This drive is owned by N. H. Murchie, Dunn Bros. and Robert Aitken.

Besides these drives there are 6,000,000 feer lying in safety at three different points. One drive of 2,000,000 is on the Fish river; another of 3,000,000 on the Northwest river, both of these being owned by W. H. Murray. On the St. Francis river there is a small drive of 1,000,000 feet, owned

by Charles Miller.

The 25,000,000 feet are so situated that if in the spring the ice runs out as it does four times out of five all the logs will be saved. It is hoped that there will not be a rise in the water, for if this should occur the logs up river will be liable to be brought into almost certain danger. In the position in which they now lie they will be quite easily saved, but a rise in the water or a sudden running out of the ice in the spring will make their loss almost

The cut this year was estimated at 135,000,000 feet and the returns to date show this estimate to be a very correct There have been rafted from the Fredericton booms 35,332 joints, containing a little over 67 tons of timber. This is made up of 119,000 feet hemlock, 6,417,000 feet cedar, 3,768,000 feet p. ne, 81,093,000 feet spruce, in all 91,000 feet

Above the boom limits there have been rafted 11,497,000 feet, making a total of almost 103,000,000 which has reached safety.
