CHAPTER 68. An Act to Incorporate the Toronto and York Radial Railway Company. Assented to 17th January, 1898.

Whereas, WILMOT DELOUI MATTHEWS, of the city of Toronto, in the county of York, grain dealer; EDWARD FREDERICK CLARKE, of the city of Toronto, insurance manager; CHARLES HENRY RITCHIE, of the city of Toronto, agent, one of Her Majesty's counsel learned in the law; JAMES GUNN, of the city of Toronto, agent, superintendent, and Archibald Campbell, of the town of Toronto Junction, in the County of York, merchant miller, have prayed for incorporation under the name of "The Toronto and York Radial Railway Company," and for power to acquire and take over the franchises, rights, powers, privileges and property of the several and respective railway companies hereinafter mentioned, and for other purposes.

2. The expression, "the vendors," wherever the same occurs in this act, shall mean all or any of the following companies, viz.: The Toronto and Scarborough Electric Railway, Light and Power Company (Limited); The Toronto and Mimico Electric Railway and Light Company (Limited); The Toronto Suburban Street Railway Company (Limited), and the Metropolitan Railway Company.

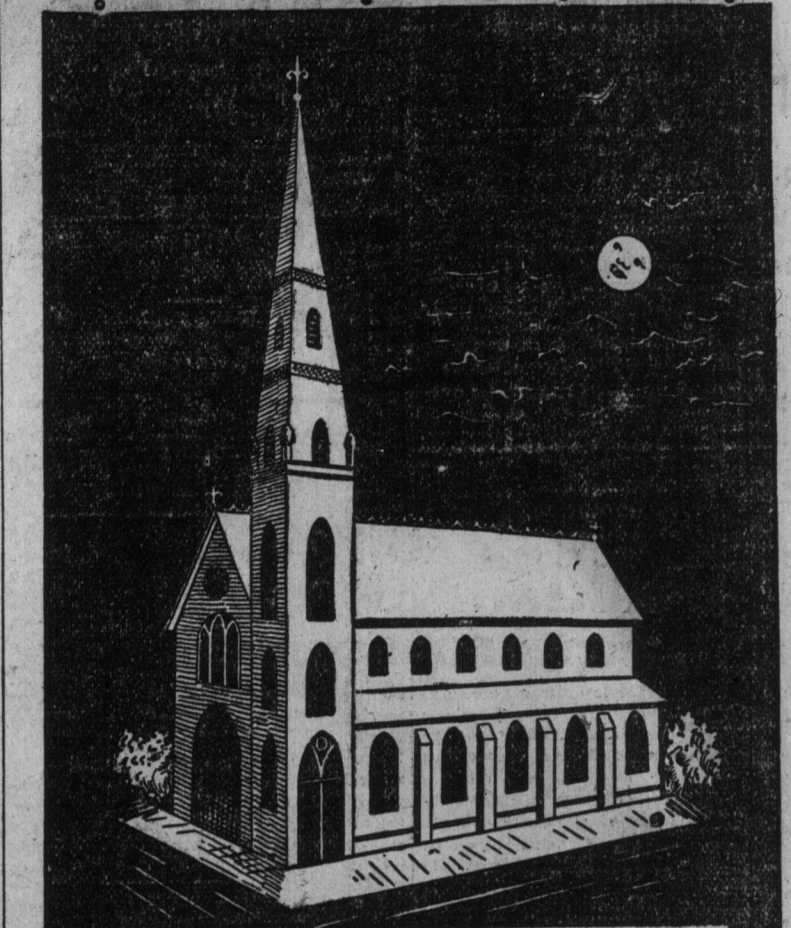
