Junction Council to Act Against "Be

Must Have Satisfactory Rates or a Municipal System Will Be Pushed Ahead.

The telephone question is still the live issue in rural districts. In East Toronto, and in Toronto Junction. The trial of President Sise has given zest to the advocates of independent lines, and municipal systems. The Junction Council will discuss the matter to-night. The farmers of Ontario County will proceed against the Bell Company in order to smash the notorious "no compromise" law of their act, and it is expected in East Toronto, where the question of a municipal exchange is being pressed to a head.

Toronto Junction, March 1.—(Special.)—"Since The World has opened the eyes of the public to the fact that there is a criminal law against a telephone monopoly which prevents the public from reaching a public office on account of an agreement between two companies, it would be criminal on our part, and the responsibility rests on us if we do not act," said Councillor James Bond.

"I think The World has sized up President Sise about right," said the humorous member for Ward 5 when asked if the Council intended to take any action in regard to municipal telephone ownership. "I shall certainly bring the matter up in Council on Monday night," said the councillor, "and if we cannot get satisfactory rates from the Bell Telephone Company, I shall advocate starting a municipal system right away."

The Mayor and Councillor Ford said that they both favored municipal ownership, but the question under discussion was such that they could not say just how far they would go until it had been fully debated. The idea, to both of them, was a good one. Councillor Sheppard had not heard that councillor Bond would move in Council on Monday night for lower rates or a municipal system. "I fully intended to move along those lines myself," said the councillor, "and if Councillor Bond brings in the resolution he will find a ready responder in me." It is safe to say that Councillor Bond will find the unanimous support of the Council upon the principle of cheaper phones of a municipal system.

Have Town Wires.

The town already has three miles of telephone wires, and connected with it are three phones—one at the pumping works station on the Lake Shore road at Swagway; another at No. 1 fire hall, and a third at No. 2 fire hall. It is absolutely necessary to have these wires connected with one another. Very often an alarm is sent in over the phone station on the Lake Shore road, and with the other fire hall and water works station. When a still alarm is sent in, No. 2 fire hall is notified over the private wire, and the other station is notified to put on more pressure by the private system.

If the town finds it necessary to keep up three miles of telephone system for two phones than pay \$15 a phone to the Bell Telephone Company.

POPE REFERRED TO HIS ENO

Against His Physician's Advice, He Insisted on Receiving the Cardinals on Sunday.

Rome, March 1.—Dr. Lappino, the Pope's physician, made this morning a last effort to induce His Holiness to renounce his reception of the cardinals, but without avail.

The audience was held in the Pope's private library, and Leo XIII. spoke continuously for half an hour with the forty-two cardinals present. No address was delivered.

The Pope, in the course of his remarks, referred to his approaching end. The cardinals greeted this reference with a chorus of noes and with exclamations of, "We have all come to wish you a long life."

By this time the excitement of the reception had improved Pope Leo's appearance. When he received the cardinals, he was bowed and trembling, but he now seemed to have acquired strength and animation.

Before retiring he presented to each cardinal a richly bound pamphlet reviewing the chief events of his pontificate, and containing a Latin poem of his own composition, and five of his most important encyclicals.

Members of the Ontario Government Who Need Not Pay Express Charges.

ANOTHER PHASE OF THE PASS EVIL

Editor World: With reference to Mr. Patterson's letter and your editorial in regard to express charges in this country, perhaps the public would like to know that cabinet Ministers don't find them even cheaper than a state owned service would be. It simply costs them nothing at all for the privilege of express goods under the present system, and they would probably have to pay the general rate under a state owned system. But the dear public get it in the neck by paying for these privileges in the end, as our esteemed postmaster has found out to his cost. The writer is in a position to know that Hon. Mr. Stratton and Hon. Mr. Gibson of the Ontario cabinet have their goods carried for nothing by the Dominion Express Company, and a late member of the Ontario cabinet enjoyed the same privilege.

State Owned Railways.

I would crave your indulgence on the publicly owned railways of Switzerland. They were taken over by the people about five years ago, and are certainly very valuable. In 1900 they paid a net profit of over \$1,000,000, and the travel on these roads is increasing every day. The Swiss railways are better than any other in the world, and the general season tickets. You can buy a two-week, a month, a quarterly, a yearly ticket, a two-week ticket, a monthly from \$12 to \$20; third-class \$12, second-class \$14, first-class \$20 for three months the rates are \$24, \$34 and \$48, and for the year \$80, \$85 and \$120. You could start on Jan. 1 and keep traveling day and night on Swiss trains and steamboats with the best accommodation until Dec. 31 without extra charge. Such tickets are sold to anyone, the only condition being that you have to furnish an unmounted photograph of yourself, which is pasted on your ticket. The cars are the same as they are in this country, with passenger seats through the center. The second-class are nicely upholstered in plush and are kept clean and comfortable. The first-class are done up in mahogany and are dropped down out of sight when one wishes to look out. Dining cars are attached to all trains.

Good Postal Service.

The Swiss postal service is also as good as could be. The post office has 16,000 postoffices and 2,000 letter boxes, and delivers mail to the very top of the Alps. It is a pleasure to collect your bills for you and bring the money to you, a person who sends you, say, \$2, all you have to do is to send them your bill for the amount in a sealed letter, with a word or two on the outside of the envelope, and a 2c stamp added to pay the postage for the trouble in collecting and delivering the money to you. The charge is 1 per cent on all collections. If payment is refused the government does not recover the postage.

After the same manner all sorts of goods are sent C.O.D. by the stores, and farmers' money is returned to them. What a boon this would be for our Canadian farmers and citizens, and they would be well advised if they will only keep up the agitation like our Ontario Locust Hill brethren are doing.

CLASH WITH TURKEY.

St. Petersburg, March 1.—Some publicists are of the opinion that only the sternest language towards Turkey can prevent a war between Russia and Turkey in the spring. They believe that Turkey will pursue bands of Macedonian revolutionaries across the Bulgarian frontier, and that public opinion will compel Russia to interfere. The Russian thoroughly understand that a war with Turkey will be a more severe one than in 1878. Of course they are quite right. The Turkish army is the best in the world owing to its German organization and armament.

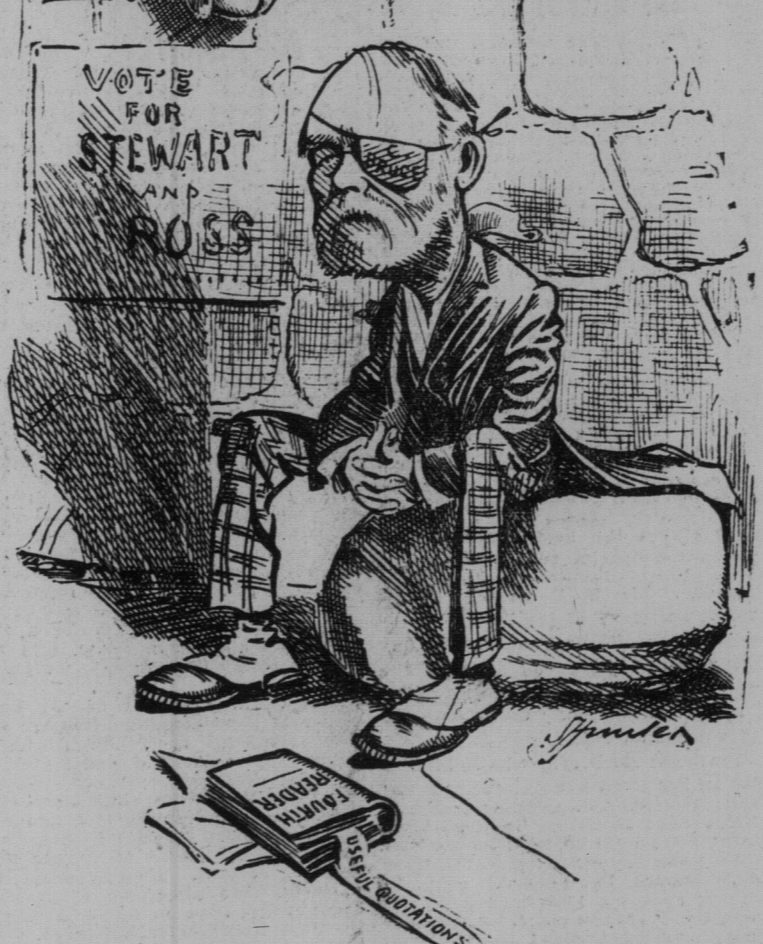

Tait Called to Australia to Organize Its Railways

C.P.R. Official Leaves Canada on May 1 to Take a Managerial Position.

Montreal, March 1.—(Special.)—Thomas Tait, general manager of the transportation of the C.P.R., will go to Australia on May 1 to become head of the railways of the Australian Commonwealth. Negotiations looking toward this end have been going on for three months, Mr. Tait being in cable communication with Premier Barton at frequent intervals. The negotiations have led to a head today, when Premier Barton called the Canadian offering him the position of superintendent and general manager of the railways of the Commonwealth. Mr. Tait replied accepting the offer. It is understood that the salary attached to the position will be in the neighborhood of \$50,000 a year. The railways in Australia are owned by the Commonwealth and are managed by a whole system of state owned railways. Mr. Tait will be given a commission of £10,000 a year, and a pension of £10,000 a year. Mr. Tait was born at Melbourne, P.E.I., not quite thirty-nine years ago, and entered railroad work in the autumn of the Grand Trunk at the age of 16. After two years' experience in several capacities he became private secretary to the vice-president and general manager of the Canadian Pacific.

THREE-STORY LADDER FELL

Firemen on It Trying to Put Out Halifax Fire Escaped Death by a Miracle.

DAMAGE ESTIMATED AT \$200,000

Halifax, N.S., March 1.—One of the most disastrous fires that have happened in Halifax for fifteen years broke out a few minutes after 10 o'clock Saturday evening in Moir, Son & Co.'s bakery and confectionery establishment, and in less than half an hour the place was a mass of flames. The entire fire department was called out, but fanned by a terrific hurricane from the west, it soon got beyond control of the firemen. A call for assistance was sent to Dartmouth, and was promptly responded to, the Dartmouth firemen coming over with their engines and doing good work in preventing the spread of the flames. As one time it looked as if the entire block, between Luke and George streets, would go. The fire was soon cut out and as the firemen were working on the north side of Duke street, across from Moir had caught fire by this time, the fire was already started, south and adjoining Moir, on Argyle street, was Lustin's confectionery store, also a two-story wooden building owned by William Austin, but unoccupied, and next to this was Moir's box factory, a two-story brick structure; these were all destroyed.

Two residences adjoining the box factory, south, owned by Dr. Cameron, and occupied by Dr. Walsh and Mrs. Fawcett, were badly damaged. The Argyle street end of the City Hall was on fire a number of times, and the interior of the citizens' library, including hundreds of books, were badly damaged. A large quantity of books, between 100 and 200, were saved.

The destruction of Moir's throws nearly 350 out of employment. The firm secured the use of ovens at Poir's Aglyum and had their men at work there today looking bread for their own families.

The total loss will be about \$200,000, with \$50,000 insurance.
