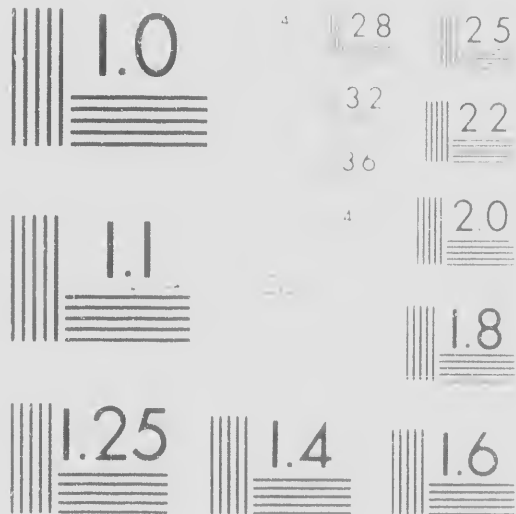

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS it is provided, by the 11th section of an Act of Congress, entitled "an Act to interdict the commerce between the United States and Great Britain or France, and for other purposes, that in case either Great Britain or France shall so revoke or modify her edicts, that they shall cease to obstruct the commerce of the United States, the President may terminate the same by Proclamation; after which the trade between the United States and the said Great Britain or France, and by an act laying an Embargo on all ships and vessels in the harbors of the United States, and the several States, may be renewed with the nation so doing."
