The lot formerly purchased for building a Parsonage off Sherbrooke Street, being, under existing circumstances, less eligible for that purpose than when it was originally acquired, has been sold at an advance over its original cost of £325. This sum it is proposed to apply towards the purchase of a lot within the block on which the New Cathedral now stands, with the ultimate view of building a Rectory thereon.
