An Act to extend the time limited for the construction of certain Turnpike Roads in Isle Jesus and for other purposes.

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to amend the Act 25 Vic., Cap. 77, to incorporate a company for the construction of certain turnpike roads in Isle Jesus, so as to extend the period limited by the said Act for the construction of the said roads and for other purposes: Therefore Her Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:—

**1.** The words “within five years from the day of the passing of this Act” in the thirty-first section of the said Act are repealed, and the following substituted therefor, “within seven years from the passing of this Act.”

**2.** The proviso to the thirty-fifth section is repealed and the following substituted therefor, “but nothing in this section shall be construed to prevent passengers from passing on the ice by the roads traced and maintained by the Municipalities.”

**3.** The words “Provided always that the consent of the Municipality shall have been obtained” in the fifth and sixth lines of the thirty-seventh section are repealed.
