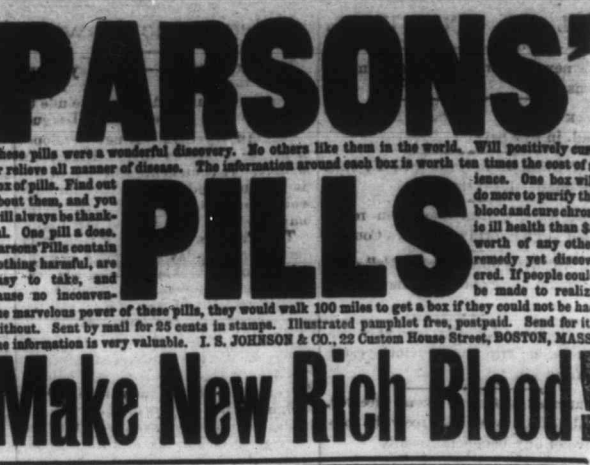
'True,' she assented with a puzzled air, 'I never thought of that; my father must have wished me to keep my mother's name. You would never discover my country from my name.'

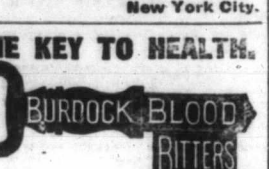

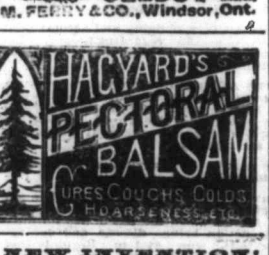
