FROM EUROPE. IMPORTANT NEWS! THE WAR BEGUN. NEW YORK, June 27. The steamship Java from Liverpool, June 16th, via Queenstown on the 17th, arrived this evening. The Federal Diet having, on the 14th, by a vote of 9 to 6 agreed to the Austrian proposal for the mobilization of the Federal army, accordingly to previous notice carried out her troops to consider it as an act of hostility on the part of those states which supported it, and on the following day commenced war by sending troops into Saxony and Hanover. It is also announced that the Prussian troops entered Saxony. It was not confirmed, but believed that Gen. Benedek would immediately move to attack the Prussians. The Emperor of Austria in a speech to the Imperial Diet, and said that Prussia considered the declaration of war as an act of aggression, and that the Prussian representation had protested against it as unconstitutional, and that the Emperor had dissolved and immediately withdrawn from the Diet.
