BELGIAN SUFFRAGE RIOTS

Violent Harengues at Two Socialist Meetings Saturday—Soldiers Charge a Mob Near Charleroi, Killing One Citizen and Wounding Another.

Two Socialist meetings were held last evening at which speeches of a menacing and violent character were delivered, and the speakers announced amid loud cheering that there would be a further demonstration on Tuesday next at the meeting of the Chamber of Representatives.

At Charleroi, near Brussels, a severe riot broke out, the working people, who were protesting against the proposed extension of the working day, were met by police and military to disperse them.

The rioters then scattered and resistance ceased. Both chambers of the Landtag are gratified with the proposals, which give the landowner interests advantages which were not granted in the former law.

Minor objections were put aside in order to get the bill passed before the opening of the Reichstag in Berlin. It is possible to foresee the passage of the bill. Dr. Müller definitely secures the friendship of the Conservatives and some Centre supporters at the sacrifice of his old national Liberal allies.
