At the present time there are 60 coke ovens in operation at these works, which are increased to 1000, while the output of the several mines now in operation will be increased to a million tons per day.

Capitalists have grasped the stupendous possibilities of the district, and are trying their best to purchase the privileges of the original Crow's Nest Coal Company and the original operating mines.

The Sullivan Mining Company have thrown a limited block of shares on the East Kootenay market.

A. Elton & Co. have sold a block of 5000 at 35 cents. The shares sold readily, as the property is of the first class.

The ledge is 400 feet thick, is traceable for over 800 feet, and consists of good quality iron in proportion that is almost self-paying.

The development up to the present time consists of a series of open cuts, the result being an enormous showing of ore.

The North Star, an adjacent property, is just a similar wonder.

The town of Kimberly lies immediately between the two mines and is one of the finest towns in the country.

The C.P.R. are putting in a telegraph line from Fort Steele to Kimberly.

Several surveys have been made from Fort Steele, and the results have been ordered west to superintend construction.

The intention of the C.P.R. to tap the North Star and Sullivan at Kimberly by the summer.
