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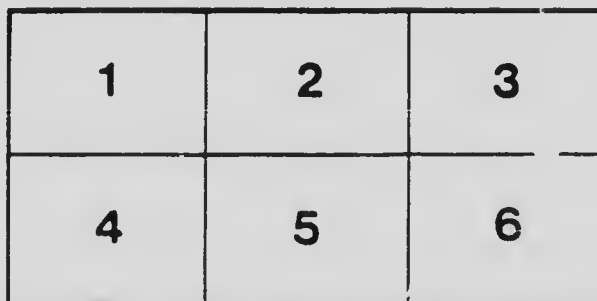
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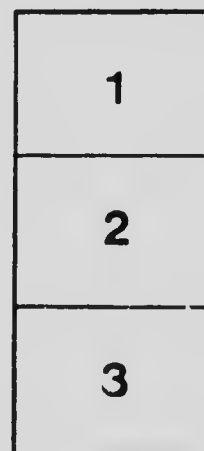

SIR,—I have the honour to hand you a report dealing with 151 samples of various character; but chiefly with that class of cattle feeds which cannot be legally sold without registration, as provided by Section 5 of the Commercial Feeding Stuffs Act of 1909. It was intended that this report should have regard only to this class of feeds; but several of our inspectors collected samples of cattle medicines or of feeds which are exempted from registration by Section 2 (b) of the Act.

So far as I am able to classify the samples herein reported, they may be defined as:—

	Samples.
Bran, shorts (middlings) or chop feeds—not requiring to be registered for sale.	35
Cattle medicines, not sold for their food value.	24
Stock feeds, which can only be legally sold under registration.	92
Total.	151

Bran is required to contain a minimum value of 14 per cent protein, 3 per cent fat and a maximum of 10 per cent crude fibre.

There is nothing to prevent a manufacturer from guaranteeing higher values than these minima, and giving the article a distinctive name, in which case, such feed will be regarded as a feed requiring registration, and it will be expected to possess the guaranteed value claimed by the manufacturer. If sold simply as *bran* I do not think that we can characterize it as adulterated so long as it meets the legal standard for *bran*.

Ten (10) samples were sold as bran. All of these meet the legal standard for bran.

Shorts (middlings) is required to contain at least 15 per cent protein, 4 per cent fat and not more than 8 per cent crude fibre.

Thirteen (13) samples are sold as shorts. All of these meet legal requirements for shorts. Four of these samples are sold under a guarantee considerably higher than the legal minimum, and in only one instance (No. 50697 does the sample fall below its guarantee.)

In Bulletin No. 231, pp. 4-6 I have pointed out the fact that feeds sold as shorts and middlings vary greatly among themselves, and that while it appears impossible to distinguish shorts from middlings, as these terms are ordinarily used there is an accepted belief that an article containing less fibre and more starch than are found in ordinary shorts or middlings, has a higher food value especially for fattening hogs, than the darker coloured article. This feed is variously sold as *number one shorts*, or *special shorts*, or *feed flour*, or *gru blanc*. I have suggested that the classification of feeds not requiring registration as defined in the Order in Council of May 1, 1911 (published as G. 968) might be amended by recognizing *Feed Flour* as something distinct from shorts (middlings), (See Bulletin No. 254, p. 6) and having a ^{higher} protein value and a lower content of crude fibre than shorts. The French equivalents for feeds which are vendable without registration appear to be as follows: bran son; shorts (middlings), *gru rouge*, *son fine*, *petit son* or *reconpe*; feed flour, *gru blanc* or *remoulage*; chop feed, *moulée* or *grains concassé*. low

For the present, it would seem necessary to identify *gru rouge*, *gru blanc*, and *feed flour* with middlings or shorts.

Chop feed is required to contain at least 10 per cent protein 2 per cent fat and not more than 10 per cent crude fibre.

Twelve (12) samples are sold as chop feeds, and all meet legal requirements for chop feed.

Six of these give special guarantee of value, and in all cases of the kind, the values found are equal to the guarantee.

Of 24 samples sold as medicines, nothing need be said. Parties interested are referred to Bulletin No. 282, which deals with this subject.

Registered feeds must be sold under the particular number granted to the manufacturer by this Department, and every package is required to have this number affixed to it in a plain and legible manner. (See Section 7 of the Act). In addition to the registration number the tag or label or stencil on the bag must carry the name of the brand, the name and address of the manufacturer and the guarantee of analysis showing the percentage of protein, fat and fibre claimed.

Ninety-two (92) samples fall into this class of feeds. Of this number sixty-nine (69) samples are registered and meet the requirements of their guarantee. Twelve (12) samples are sold without registration numbers on the package and in these cases the vendors are amenable to the penalty fixed by Section 15 of the Act. Several of these samples bear a guarantee of analysis, and it may be that such samples are registered by the Department. In such cases the vendor incurs the penalty for selling the article without its registration number, which constitutes identification of the brand. (See Section 7 of the Act). The guaranteed value of the article is met by the following samples, which however, do not bear registration numbers.
