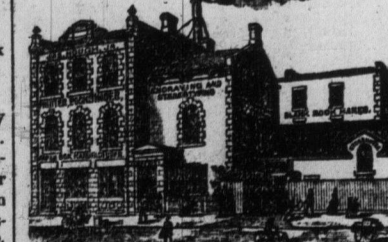

MAN THE LIBERATOR. A. O. E. Naval Brigade Take Up a Practical Matter. The project for forming a life-saving crew and procuring a lifeboat for some time has agitated the Naval Brigade of the City of Toronto, and at last it has taken form and substance. At a recent meeting of the brigade, at which Richard Caddick, high admiral, presided, it was resolved to form a life-saving crew and procure a boat. Teachers have been invited for instruction and several bids have already been received. The plan has received the sanction of the Executive of the N.O.E. The boat will be fashioned after the model of the English lifeboats, and the crew will be drilled and every evening during the boating season the boat will patrol the harbor. There are well-drilled stalwart young fellows, some of whom have been in the navy already, and who are well equipped for each night will be drafted from the number. Yesterday a committee composed of Richard Caddick, chairman; George Tyler, commander-in-chief; Richard Frank, P.O.E. and Mr. Mallon, D.S., waiting on the Lieutenant-Governor and solicited his patronage of the lifeboat. His honor responded liberally to the invitation, promising that when the boat was ready Mr. Kirpatrick would launch it, and insisted on adding his name to the subscription list.
