TWENTY-SIX SENATE HOUSE McCLELLAN RECEIVES SALARY FROM \$150,000 TO \$75,000

Retrenchment in Mutual Life Begun and Lops \$150,000 Off Pay Rolls—Investigating Committee Reports and Asks For Increase in Its Powers.

New York, Nov. 16.—At a special meeting of the board of trustees of the Mutual Life Insurance Company in this city today a preliminary report of the recently appointed special investigating committee was submitted. President Richard McClellan announced that at his own request his salary had been cut in half from \$150,000 to \$75,000.

This action was taken at a meeting of the finance committee, and Mr. McClellan said was the first step in reducing the expenses of the company. Salaries of the other executive officers of the company also have been reduced the saving amounting in all to between \$145,000 and \$150,000 per annum.

Mr. McClellan's statement to the directors preceded the submission of the investigation committee's first report. The preliminary report was adopted together with the resolution increasing the powers of the committee to continue its investigation. The directors announced that full publicity be given to the report as well as to the statement made by Mr. McClellan.

President McClellan in his address to the board outlined a policy of retrenchment the executive officers had decided upon. He declared he did not know what was contained in the report of the special investigating committee and he did not desire to forestall anything the committee might do for he would come to the same conclusion that the management had been advised to do.

Not All Deserved. "But I am not," he said, "that all criticism which has been made is just or deserved, but on the other hand, I am not so blind as to know that a public opinion unfavorable to the administration has been created and that its persistence must continue to work harm to the business of the company."

The principal reform demanded was the reduction in the cost of insurance. Mr. McClellan said that the committee was asking that his salary be cut in half. Commissioners of insurance will be asked to reduce the cost of insurance to a salary basis and legislative expenses will be done away with.

Wishes an Audit. The committee asked to be empowered and directed "To make such audit of the company's accounts and affairs as it shall see fit and for that and any other purpose the committee is authorized to have access to take under its control any and all things, all records, papers, documents and memoranda belonging to the company."

"LOTS OF MARL" — "NO MARL."

Town Council Experts Say Supply is Inadequate for Some Directors. "Believe It's Gone—A Few Interesting Facts."

Durham, Nov. 16.—(Special)—Alleging that the deposits of marl in this vicinity are becoming exhausted, ignoring the fact that the mills are prospering now in the roughest sense of the word, and refusing, it is openly said, to be shown absolute proofs of the abundance of the contentions that the supply of material is not sufficient for scores of years to come, the five of the seven directors of the National Portland Cement Co. have organized a committee.

At present, and for some time past, the mills, which employ 100 men, have been turning out 1000 barrels a day. The amount of marl used in the process is 5000 and 35,000 barrels, which would yield a profit of \$700 a day. If it had not been for the marl, the profit would be 10 per cent. more.

LEGISLATION COMMITTEE PASSES ON TO COUNCIL RECOMMENDATION FOR THE CUTTING OF 27 LICENSES

Alderman Sheppard Breaks a Deadlock by Supporting the Mayor's Motion, That He Doesn't Promise Continued Allegiance.
