CERAY BUILDING MATERIALS.—Very desirable buildings are now being constructed, the walls of which are composed of stonecutor's spalls or chips of coarse gravel, sand and lime, mised into a mortar at the rate of one part of lime to eight parts of the other ingredients. Movable moulds are set to form the walls and the mixture showelled in and left to harden, and then the mould is raised for another course. The whole mass is represented as hardening into a solid artificial stone in a short time.
