**We have one further** advance notice. Dr. McLaurin will preach in our church Sunday evening, Nov. 19.

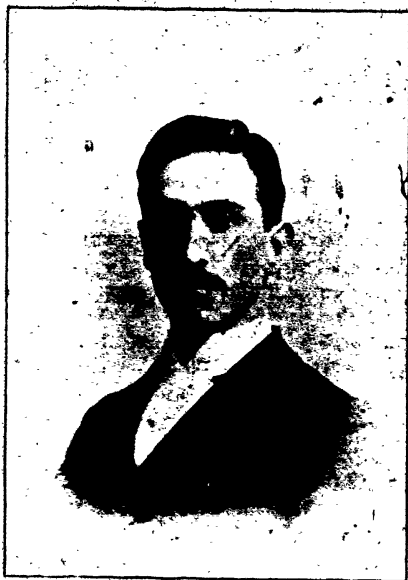
