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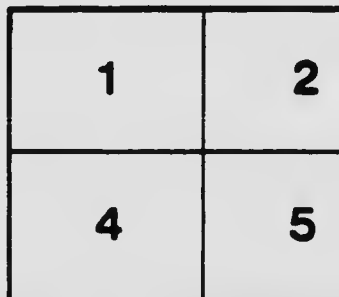
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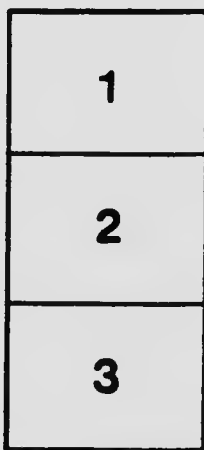
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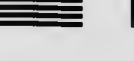
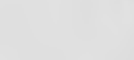
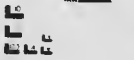
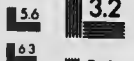
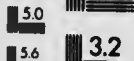
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# MICROCOPY RESOLUTION TEST CHART

(ANSI and ISO TEST CHART No. 2)



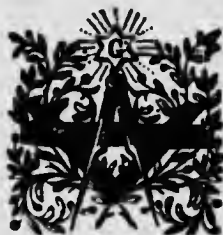

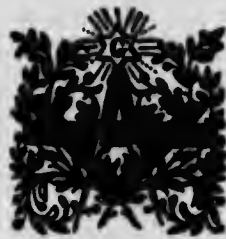

# BY-LAWS.

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## ARTICLE I.

This Lodge shall be known by the name of "TEMPLE LODGE, NO. 33, OF ANCIENT, FREE AND ACCEPTED MASONS," and its officers shall consist of a Master, a Senior Warden, a Junior Warden, a Treasurer, a Secretary, a Senior Deacon, a Junior Deacon, an Inner Guard, two Stewards, a Tyler, and such other officers as the Lodge may deem proper to appoint.

## ARTICLE II.

SECTION 1. The Master, the Senior and Junior Wardens, the Treasurer, the Secretary and the Tyler shall be elected at the regular meeting in December of each year.

SECTION 2. The other officers shall be appointed by the Master elect on the day of installation.

SECTION 3. The installation of officers shall take place on "St. John's Day," December 27th, or the next regular meeting in "January."

## ARTICLE III.

SECTION 1. The stated meetings of this Lodge

shall be held on the second Saturday of each month.

SECTION 2. Special meetings may be called from time to time as the presiding officer may direct.

#### ARTICLE IV.

SECTION 1. All petitions for initiation or affiliation must be signed by the petitioner, in which petition he shall state his residence, age and occupation, and a deposit of ten dollars (\$10.00) must accompany the petition for initiation, and five dollars (\$5.00) that for affiliation. If the candidate be rejected his deposit shall be returned.

SECTION 2. He shall be recommended by two members of the Lodge, who shall sign as vouchers for him.

SECTION 3. Every person raised to the Degree of Master Mason in, or elected a member of this Lodge, shall, when duly qualified, sign the By-laws thereof.

#### ARTICLE V.

SECTION 1. The table of fees for this Lodge shall be as follows: With the application ten dollars (\$10.00); for the Degree of Entered Apprentice, twenty dollars (\$20.00); for the Degree of Fellow Craft, ten dollars (\$10.00); for the Degree of Master Mason, ten dollars (\$10.00); and for affiliation, five dollars (\$5.00).

**SECTION 2.** All fees for Initiation, Passing and Raising shall be due the night the ceremony takes place, and the whole shall be paid to the Secretary before conferring the Degrees.

#### **ARTICLE VI.**

In all ballots for candidates for initiation one black ball shall reject, and for affiliation three black balls.

#### **ARTICLE VII.**

The regular dues from each member of this Lodge shall be 50 cents per month. Half dues shall be paid by members residing outside the jurisdiction of the Grand Lodge of British Columbia.

#### **ARTICLE VIII.**

Any member who shall have been suspended for non-payment of dues shall be restored to membership upon payment of all arrears, providing application be made within two years.

#### **ARTICLE IX.**

When a candidate for initiation or affiliation is rejected, or when a Brother is reprimanded, or suspended, no member or visitor shall reveal, either directly or indirectly, to such person any transaction which may have taken place on the subject, nor shall any proceeding of the Lodge, not proper

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to be made public, be disclosed outside thereof, under penalty of reprimand or suspension as the Lodge may determine.

#### ARTICLE X.

All difference between members, which cannot be arranged by the Lodge, shall be laid before the Grand Lodge at the earliest opportunity, and the member who appears to the Lodge to be in fault shall not be permitted to attend the Lodge until the matter is decided in his favor, or otherwise amicably arranged.

#### ARTICLE XI.

SECTION 1. The Treasurer shall receive all monies from the Secretary, and shall keep an accurate account thereof; and shall pay the same out only upon orders duly signed by the Master and countersigned by the Secretary.

SECTION 2. He shall at the stated meeting in January of each year submit a report in full of the monetary transactions of the Lodge.

#### ARTICLE XII.

SECTION 1. The Secretary shall keep a faithful record of all proceedings proper to be written; shall transmit a copy of the same to the Grand Lodge when required; shall keep a separate account for

each member of the Lodge; shall report at the stated meeting in January the amount due by each; shall receive all monies due the Lodge and pay the same to the Treasurer, and shall perform all such other duties as may properly appertain to his office.

SECTION 2. He shall receive such compensation for his services as the Lodge may direct.

#### ARTICLE XIII.

The Tyler shall receive such compensation for his services as the Lodge may direct.

#### ARTICLE XIV.

SECTION 1: That a copy of these By-laws be fairly transcribed in a proper book, and signed by every member of the Lodge as a pledge of his intention to observe and keep the same, and that a printed copy shall be delivered to him.

SECTION 2. They shall also be read by the Secretary in open Lodge at least once a year.

#### ARTICLE XV.

The cash, arrears of contributions, furniture and other appendages belonging to this Lodge, shall be and the same by the consent of all the members, are hereby vested in, and shall be deemed the property of the Master and Wardens for the time being,

in trust for the use and benefit of the Lodge, and to be paid, applied and disposed of as the majority of the members shall from time to time in due form direct, and an inventory of the jewels, furniture, &c., belonging to the Lodge shall be entered in the minute book and a copy of the same delivered to the Master at his installation, who shall see that the same is correct, and then pass them over to the Treasurer, who shall be responsible to him for their safe keeping.

#### ARTICLE XVI.

The regular order of business of every stated meeting shall be as follows :

- 1st. Reading of the minutes.
- 2nd. Reading correspondence.
- 3rd. Reports of Committees.
- 4th. Balloting.
- 5th. Reception of petitions.
- 6th. Miscellaneous and unfinished business.
- 7th. Conferring degrees.

#### ARTICLE XVII.

These By-Laws may be amended at any stated meeting by the votes of two-thirds of the members present; provided that a notice of such amendment shall have been given at the stated meeting next preceding.

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**ARTICLE XVIII.**

That Article IX. be read after the rejection of any candidate for membership, either by initiation or by affiliation.
