A correspondent of the Indiana Farmer illustrates as follows the amount of travel necessary to raise a crop of corn: "I have a 20 acre field 40x80 rods. To break this up would take 100 miles; harrowing it about 40 miles; furrowing out, 90 miles; planting, 45 miles, if with a planter, and if dropped and then covered, 90 miles. Thus you see it takes about 800 or 900 miles of travel to raise twenty acres of c. ra, not coulding going to or returning from the field. Besides, there are replanting, thinning, rolling, etc."


