

#### An Act to Incorporate the North British Society, n Halifax, Nova Scotia.

(Passed the 24th day of March, 1856).

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council, and Assembly, as follows:

- 1. The following persons, that is to say:—Peter Ross, John Taylor, William Annand, William Murray, John Watt, William B. Smellie, and John B. Campbell, and all such other persons as now are or hereafter shall become members of the Society, shall be a body politic and corporate, by the name of the "The North British Society, in Halifax, Nova Scotia."
- 2. The rules of the Society, adopted on the seventh day of November, 1833, are hereby declared legal and binding, and the Corporation is empowered to collect all monie and arrears due thereunder.
- 3. The personal property, debts and effects now belonging to the Society, are vested in the Corporation, and the Corporation is empowered to invest its funds to such extent and in such way as it shall think fit.

### CONSTITUTION

#### SECTION I.

DESIGNATION OF THE SOCIETY—ITS SEAL.

The corporate name of the Society is,—The North British Society, in Halifax, Nova Scotia.

The Seal shall be a silver Seal, with a Thistle and Crown engraved thereon, with this motto, "Nemo me impune lacessit."

#### SECTION II.

#### MEMBERSHIP.

- (A) None but those who are Scotsmen, and those who are descendants of Scotsmen, are eligible for membership in the Society.
- (B) A Candidate for admission must be proposed by a member of the Society, who shall state in writing the name of the candidate, his occupation, present address, place of nativity and qualification for membership. This written notification shall be given to the Secretary in time to be presented at a meeting of the officers of the Society to be held eight days before the quarterly meeting. If they approve, intimation of the candidature shall be given in the notice convening the said meeting, and the election shall be determined by ballot at that meeting. Adverse votes by one-fourth of the members present shall exclude.
- Every person thus elected an ordinary member shall, at the time of his admission, subscribe to the rules of the Society, and pay to the Secretary the sum of four dollars.
- 3. When a member has been elected by the Society, he shall be introduced to the President and others holding office, as soon as convenient by the member who proposed him.

- 4. Every ordinary member resident in the City of Halifax, shall pay quarterly to the Secretary the sum of \$1.00, or such other sums as shall from time to time be judged sufficient for promoting the general purposes of the Society.
- 5. Life Members shall consist of those who having been elected to membership pay into the funds of the Society at one time the sum of Forty dollars, and also of those who as ordinary members have paid dues for Twentyfive years. Life Members shall be exempt from the payment of quarterly dues, but shall retain all the rights and privileges of ordinary members.
- 6. Associate Members shall consist of those whose place of residence is more than twenty miles from Halifax. They shall, when elected, contribute to the funds of the Society the sum of Six dollars. If such members subsequently become residents of the city they shall be transferred to the list of ordinary members, and shall pay accordingly.

Ordinary members removing more than twenty miles from the city may be placed on the list of Associate Members if they so desire.

- 7. Men of notable distinction by reason of their position, achievements or beneficence, and who are otherwise eligible for membership, may be elected Honorary Members of the Society, such election being subject to the same regulations as those governing election to ordinary membership.
- 8. At the annual meeting in November the Secretary shall present a life of all members three years or more in arrears of dues. Any member thus reported shall be specially notified to pay the same, and, falling to do so, may be suspended. Any member thus suspended may be reinstated on the payment of dues owing at the time of his suspension, by a majority vote of the Society.
- 9. Should any member, not in arrears, resign from the Society, he shall have the privilege of again submitting his name for membership, and, if elected, he shall be admitted free from payment of entry fee.

#### SECTION III.

MEETINGS: ELECTION OF OFFICERS: ORDER OF BUSINESS.

- For cultivating a mutual good understanding among the members, and for conducting the business of charity, the Society shall be assembled four times in the year, in addition to its Anniversary Meeting, namely, on the first Thursday of the months of February, May, August and November.
   This meeting in November shall be called the annual meeting.
- 2. The President, or in his absence, the officer highest in rank who may be in the City, shall, when any emergency occurs which, in his opinion, may render it expedient, or upon the written requisition of ten members, call a special meeting of the Society. Fifteen members shall be necessary to form a quorum at a special meeting, and no resolution shall be declared carried at such special meeting unless at least ten members shall vote in favor of such resolution. Whenever such meetings are called, each member of the Society shall be notified, in writing, as to the time and place of meeting.
- 3. At all meetings of the Society, after the President or Vice-President has taken the chair, the rules shall be laid on the table for the perusal and direction of the members.

- 4. Every member speaking on business shall stand up and address himself to the Chair, and no member shall speak more than once on the same subject, except by leave from the Chair, or to explain something already offered.
- When the subject before the Society has been stated and discussed, the President shall propose the same for the decision of the members, which shall be determined by a majority vote.
- 6. At the meeting in November the members shall, by ballot by a majority of those present, elect the officers for the ensuing year, to wit, a President, a Vice-President, a Senior and a Junior assistant Vice-President, a Treasurer, a Secretary, an Assistant Secretary, a Committee of Charity, two Chaplains, an Historian, two Auditors, and a Marshal or Messenger, who shall enter on their duties at noon on St. Andrew's Day.
- 7. Candidates for office shall be first nominated in writing, and the ballot shall be restricted to those nominated. Should the first ballot not show a clear majority the subsequent ballots shall be restricted to those having the highest number and collectively a majority of the votes cast.
  - 8. The order of business of meetings shall be:
    - (a) Reading records of previous meeting.
    - (b) Consideration of the reports of officers,
    - (c) Consideration of the report of the Charity Committee.
    - (d) Applications for membership.
    - (e) Balloting for members.
    - (f) Introduction of new members to the Society.
    - (g) Communications.
    - (h) Report of Committee on the celebration of the Festival and on dues and membership, (February meeting).
    - (i) Unfinished business.
    - (i) New business
    - (k) Election of officers (November meeting),
- At ordinary quarterly meetings ten members shall constitute a quorum.
- 10. At the meeting in November, a regulation shall be made for celebrating the Festival of St. Andrew. At the said Festival, every member of the Society should appear with the Cross of St. Andrew on his breast.

#### Installation of President.

11. The President elected at the Annual Meeting for the ensuing year, shall be invested with the Collar and Badge of Office, and the Seals of the Society shall be delivered to him at noon on Saint Andrew's Day, by the retiring President, or either of the retiring Vice-Presidents, or by a Past President, and the service of investiture shall be attended by as many Past Presidents and members as may find it convenient to be present. If the 30th November, Saint Andrew's Day, fall on Sunday, the investiture shall take place on the day following. The installation charge and order shall be after the ancient Scottish formula, viz.:

The Marshal announces to the Company of the members present that the term of office of President of the North British Society for the past year has expired, and that the President-elect awaits Installation, at the same time handing the Badge, Collar and Seal, to the Investing Member, who thus proclaims—

By the authority of the North British Society I hereby declare and proclaim. the elected Head and President of our Scottish Charitable Brotherhood for the ensuing year, and hereby invest him with the Collar and Badge of President, and deliver to him the Seals of Office. May his term be prosperous and happy, and may he deliver up his honorable charge to his successor in office with an increased roll of members, greater wealth and resources, and an augmented prestige for this Ancient and Charitable Institution. God Save the King.

12. The Committee for the purpose of celebrating the Festival of St. Andrew shall consist of the office-bearers of the Society and the officers elect for the succeeding year, together with as many of the older members of the Society as the President may deem it expedient to summon.

#### SECTION IV.

#### THE OFFICERS OF THE SOCIETY: THEIR DUTIES.

1. It shall be the duty of the President to preside at all meetings; to regulate the deliberations of the Society; to state and put questions both in the affirmative and the negative, according to the sense and intention of the meeting; to check undue warmth or irregularity, and keep all persons in order; to direct summonses for all ordinary and special meetings of the Society, and to appoint the time and place of meeting; and to execute or superintend the execution of all the rules and orders of the Society. All proposed disbursements shall be submitted to him for his approval, and all orders of distribution shall be signed by him. He shall retain the custody and use of the Seal, with all other powers vested in him by ancient usage.

No person shall be eligible for the office of President who has not been at least three years an Ordinary or Life member of the Society.

- In the absence of the President his duties shall devolve upon the Vice-President, and in the absence of both of these, upon the Senior or the Junior Assistant Vice-President.
- The Senior and Junior Assistant Vice-Presidents shall perform the duties of stewards of the Society at the quarterly meetings, and shall superintend all matters relating to the providing of refreshments, speeches, music, etc.
- 4. The Secretary or Assistant Secretary shall attend all meetings of the Society, with the rules and records; shall take down all minutes, particularly noting, in a regular account, all moneys received and disbursed, and shall produce the same, fairly written, in proper books, at the next meeting; shall receive all fees and dues and hand the same promptly to the Treasurer, taking his receipt therefor; shall read all letters, petitions or papers sent or communicated to the Society, and shall record such of them as may be deemed worthy of preservation; shall prepare all answers in such terms as may be directed; shall make proper indexes to the books of the Society, and shall issue Diplomas and Certificates, duly signed by the President and Secretary, to all new members.

- 5. The Treasurer shall give such security as the Society may require for the trust reposed in him, and if a bond is furnished, the Society shall pay the premium thereon. He shall receive all moneys belonging to the Society and shall deposit the same in the name of the Society in a Chartered Bank; he shall make all disbursements by cheque on such bank; he shall at each quarterly meeting present his accounts, and shall annually present a financial statement, duly audited, of the resources of the Society, and shall distribute copies of such statement with the notice of the November meeting. He shall have no credit in his account for any sum disbursed for which he does not produce the order or approbation of the President in writing, or, in his absence, the Vice-President.
- 6. A Committee of Charity, consisting of five members, shall be elected annually by the Society for the following purposes:—
  - (a) To enquire into the claims, characters and circumstances of all such as apply for the aid of the Society, to prevent the charity of the Society from being improperly or fruitlessly applied.
  - (b) To deliver their opinion candidly and freely with respect to the general merit of claimants, and to the extent of the relief it may be necessary to afford them.
  - (c) To report to the Society any instances of members, who through accident, illness or otherwise stand in need of aid, and to indicate the nature and extent of the aid it behooves the Society to give them.
- 7. It shall be the duty of the Chaplains to perform the religious duties customary at the meetings of the Society; to promote by their counsel and advice harmony and good-will among the members, and to visit such sick and distressed persons as are recommended to their attention by the Committee of Charity.
- 8. The Historian shall have the oversight and care of the records and archives of the Society, and shall keep, each year, a summary of the doings of the Society, and of the celebration of the Festival of St. Andrew.
- It shall be the duty of the officers of the Society and of the officers for the preceding year to meet not later than the second Tuesday of January to
  - (a) Examine and authorize the payment of all accounts contracted for the celebration of the Festival of St. Andrew.
  - (b) Consider means for increasing the membership of the Society.
  - (c) Arrange for the collection of dues.
  - (d) Revise the roll of members.
  - (e) Consider means for extending the usefulness of the Society

A report embodying the above matters shall be submitted to the Society in writing at the next quarterly meeting.

10. If any officers of the Society are, by sickness or otherwise, necessarily absent from a regular meeting, others shall be called, for the time being, to act in their room; and if any of the officers happen to remove our

of the province or to die during the year for which they were elected, the members assembled at the next quarterly meeting shall, as upon the meeting in November, choose others to serve in their stead for the remainder of the year.

#### SECTION V.

#### Funds of the Society and Appropriation Thereof.

- 1. All the money collected from the members, or received by donation or otherwise, shall be applied to the best advantage for promoting the ends of the Society, as determined by the members at its regularly appointed meetings; and if, at any time, there shall be more money in the funds than present exigencies require, the Treasurer and President for the time being shall invest the same in securities available for Trustees.
- 2. The Charity of the Society shall be applied in the following manner, viz.:—The President or, in his absence, the Vice-President, with the Committee of Charity, shall have the power to draw orders on the Treasurer for the time being in favor of such poor or distressed persons as they shall judge fit objects of the Society's bounty, which orders the Treasurer shall immediately pay, Provided Always, that none but those who have the same qualifications in regard to country and parentage as is stated in the rule respecting admission of members, their widows and children, shall ever be entitled to any part of this charity; Provided Also, that the sum so drawn at any one time does not exceed \$20 in the case of any one person, and when \$20 are drawn by order on the Treasurer, the said order shall be signed by every member of the Committee of Charity. All orders on the Treasurer shall be signed by at least three of the said Committee of Charity, when under \$20.
- 3. As a stated provision is made for the resident poor by municipal laws of the City, to which the members of this Society contribute their portion in their private capacity as citizens, the fund of charity shall be rather applied to the relief and assistance of persons who have met with sudden misfortune, or who suffer by occasional distress, than to continued allowance for the settled poor; but as no adequate regulation suitable to all times and all circumstances can be devised on this subject, the Society shall, notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this rule, be always free to exercise its own discretion and humanity with regard to it.

#### SECTION VI.

#### PROVISION IN CASE OF DEATH OF MEMBERS.

When the attendance of the Society is requested at the funeral of one of its members, or of a countryman, a stranger in the place, the President shall issue orders for that purpose; and the customs of Scotland, as far as expedient, shall be adhered to in the procession on such occasions.

#### SECTION VII.

#### GUESTS.

For the purpose of extending the usefulness of the Society, and for making the objects of it more generally known, each member shall have the privilege of introducing, at the quarterly suppers, a guest, eligible to become a member of the Society. A member introducing such a guest shall notify the Stewards.

# CERTIFICATES TO BE GRANTED TO RESIDENT, ASSOCIATE, LIFE OR HONORARY MEMBERS.

All resident, associate, life or honorary members, shall, upon application, be furnished with a certificate of their admission and attendance, under the Society's seal, and signed by the President or Vice-President, and Secretary, the form of which shall be as follows:—

Given under our hands and seal of the Society the day and year above written."

But as it may be expedient for members of this Society to remove in quest of settlement to other parts of this Continent, where similar institutions exist, whose countenance and direction might be of great assistance to them, a second form of certificate shall be granted, upon application, to such members of this description as the Society shall think worthy of the same, the form whereof shall be as follows:—

"These certify that Mr. ... was regularly admitted a member of the North British Society of Halifax, in Nova Scotia, on the ... ... day of ... ... , and having duly conformed to all its rules and regulations during his residence here, he is therefore recommended to the countenance and protection of any and all similar Societies."

The foregoing rules shall be deemed the fundamental articles and regulations of the North British Society in Halifax, Nova Scotia, and shall not hereafter be altered or abrogated, on any pretence whatever, otherwise than by consent of at least two-thirds of the members regularly met at any quarterly meeting in November; Provided also that a Committee of at least five has been previously appointed, and that such Committee after consideration has reported that alteration of them seems necessary or expedient.

Passed at the Annual Meeting at the Halifax Hotel, the 3rd day of November, 1910.

### NORTH BRITISH SOCIETY SCHOLARSHIP.

### FOUNDED IN 1868, IN CONNECTION WITH DALHOUSIE COLLEGE.

"That the sum of sixty dollars be appropriated annually from the funds of the North British Society for a Scholarship in connection with Dalhousie College, as a permanent commemoration of the Centenary of the Society, subject to the following conditions:

"1st. That the holder of it be a person eligible to be a member of the Society.

"2nd. That the Scholarship be held during the third and fourth years of his undergraduate course.

"3rd. That it be competed for at the end of his second year course, and that the first competition take place at the end of the present session, and that the examiners be always appointed by the Senate.

"4th. The money to be paid on certificate from the Principal of Dalhousie College.

"5th. Any year when no competitor has presented himself, the money for that year to remain in the hands of the Society, but the Scholarship to be again open for competition in the following year, subject to the foregoing resolutions."
