JULY WHEAT ADVANCED 1-8
 On the Strength of Encouraging European Cables.
 May Wheat Also Improved Yesterday at Chicago—English Markets Higher—Increase in American Visible—Quantity About—Week's Shipments—General Casualty.
 Monday Evening, April 4.
 At the opening to-day the Chicago wheat market looked firm in sympathy with the strength in cables, but weakened on the better advice that visible has increased instead of showing a large decrease for the week, as had been expected. At the close the market firmed up. May wheat gained 1/8 for the day and July 1/8, while the September and December options lost respectively 1/8 and 1/4. In Liverpool wheat was up from 40 to 41 to-day, while in English country markets the price showed an improvement of from 1d to 1s. Corn and oats were quiet and provisions strong.
 Russian shipments for the past week were 2,700,000 bushels of wheat and 929,000 bushels of corn. Danube shipments were 170,000 bushels of wheat and 482,000 bushels of corn. India shipments of wheat were 1,100,000 bushels.
 The stocks of wheat in Liverpool houses, public and private, total 1,050,000 bushels, or 387,000 bushels more than a week ago. London stocks to-day are: Wheat 800,000 bushels, flour 2,400,000 sacks.
 Live stock receipts at Chicago to-day were: Cattle 20,000, hogs 23,000.
 The decrease in the English visible supply of wheat is 260,000 bushels, as against a decrease of 578,000 bushels of the corresponding week of last year.
 Primary receipts leading centres to-day were: Wheat 97,000 bushels and corn 45,000 bushels. The corresponding week of last year were: Wheat 97,000 bushels and corn 45,000 bushels.
 Total clearances to-day were: Wheat and flour 340,000 bushels, corn 469,078 bushels. Exports at New York to-day: Flour 3883 bushels, and 44,864 sacks, wheat 18,762 bushels. No blockade of any importance or duration is considered probable in case of war with Spain, unless other countries should be come involved, which seems unlikely at the present time. The wheat crop is well taken up for the next two months, a good part being owned by Letter, it is said, to accommodate his sales abroad.
 Pillsbury reports the sale on Saturday of 100,000 bushels of flour.
 The English visible supply of wheat for the week ending April 3rd, 1898, was 1,240,000 bushels, as against a decrease of 578,000 bushels the corresponding week of last year.
 Imports to the United Kingdom for the week ending April 3rd, 1898, were: Wheat 224,000 quarters, flour 174,000 quarters.
 Lard is up 1/4 in Liverpool.
 As compared with a week ago, the visible supply of wheat in Canada and the United States has decreased 750,000 bushels, and that of corn 1,000,000 bushels. The following is a comparative statement for the week ending to-day, the preceding week and the corresponding week of last year.

STOCKS ROSE OVER SUNDAY
 On Unconfirmed Rumors Pointing to Cuban Settlement.
 Big Realization in Wall Street Caused a Reaction, But the Close Showed an Improvement in London—Canadian Securities Stronger.
 Monday Evening, April 4.
 Securities opened to-day on Wall Street from 1 to 4 points above Saturday's closing, the advance over Sunday being in sympathy with the improved London market, supported by rumors looking toward peace. These rumors, however, to have no definite basis, and to-day may see an entire change in the situation. The improvement in prices continued for the first hour, after which heavy selling set in, and the close showed a gain of from a fraction to 2 and 3 points over Saturday's final figures.
