## BILL.

An Act to incorporate the Toronto Necropolis.

HATHEREAS John McMurrich, Alexander McGlasher Preamble. and John Shaw, inhabitants of the City of Toronto, have, by petition set forth that owing to the increase of the inhabitants of the said City, and the small portions of 5 land at present allotted for burying grounds free from sectarian control, it is desirable that a Cemetery be established in the vicinity of the City, as well for strangers as inhabitants of the City, of whatsoever sect or denomination they may be-and that the said Petitioners may be 10 incorporated for that purpose: Be it therefore enacted;

And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, Certain per-That the said John McMurrich, Alexander McGlasher and miced. John Shaw, their heirs, devisees, and assigns, are hereby constituted a body corporate by the name of the " Toronto

II. And be it enacted, That the said Corporation may Corporation acquire, take and hold a parcel or tract of land, within the may acquire. said City or in its vicinity, not exceeding which land when acquired by the said Corporation or Cometery.

20 their grantees, shall be used exclusively as a Cemetery, or place for burial of the dead, and for this purpose it shall be surveyed and subdivided into lots of a convenient size, respectively designated and numbered, and with such walks, paths and avenues as may be deemed 25 advisable, and a map of such survey shall be fyled in the office of the Registrar of the County of York; and when the said Corporation shall have acquired an indefeasible title in fee to the premises, free and clear of all incumbrances, and shall have fyled the said map in the office 30 aforesaid, the said Corporation may sell, convey or otherwise dispose of the said lots (reserving a section which shall forever be devoted free of expense for the benefit of the stranger and those who may be unable to purchase,) to any person or persons on such terms and conditions, and 35 at such prices as shall be agreed on, to be used and appropriated exclusively for the burial of the dead; which conveyances shall be under the Seal of the Corporation and signed by the Secretary thereof.

III. And be it enacted, That the said Corporation And may lay 40 may enclose, lay out, improve and embellish such land, as they think in such manner, and may erect such buildings thereon, as proper.

IV. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful for the said Corporation at any time to make, do, Cometery can commit, or cause any act, matter or thing whatsoever, whereby the said Cemetery and the land and premises appertaining thereto, or any part thereof, can or may be in any wise impeached or encumbered in title, charge, 10 estate or otherwise.

V. And be it enacted, That all lots of ground when conveyed and designated, and numbered as lots by the said Corporation, shall be indivisible, but may be held and owned in undivided shares.

Penalty on persons desments, &c.

VI. And be it enacted, That any person who shall persons destroying monu. wilfully destroy, mutilate, deface, injure or remove any tomb, monument, grave stone or other structure placed' in the Cemetery aforesaid, or any fence, railway or other wall for the protection or ornament of the said Cemetery 20 or of any tomb, monument or grave stone or other structure aforesaid, or shall wilfully destroy, cut, break or injure any tree, shrub or plant or flower within the limits of the said Cemetery, or commit any other kind of trespass, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanour and, shall upon 25 conviction thereof, before a Justice of the said City of Toronto or County of York, or other Court of competent jurisdiction within the said City or County, be punished by a fine not less than ten shillings, nor more than ten pounds currency, according to the nature and aggravation 30 of the offence, and such offender shall also be liable in an action of trespass to be brought against him in any Court of competent jurisdiction, in the name of such Corporation, to pay all such damages as shall have been occasioned by his unlawful act or acts, which money when 35 received shall be applied by the said Corporation to the reparation and restoration of the property destroyed or injured as above, and the members of the said Corporation shall be competent witnesses in such suits.

VII. And be it enacted, That it shall be the duty of 40. the said Corporation to put up and maintain in at least three conspicuous places within the limits of the said Cemetery, a printed notice containing the words of the preceding section.

Corporation may receive donations of property for improvement of Cemetery.

VIII. And be it enacted, That the said Corporation 45 may take and hold any grant, donation or bequest of property upon trust, to apply the same or the income thereof for the improvement or embellishment of the said Cemetery, or for the erection of any tomb, monument or grave

stone, fence, railing or other erection, or for the planting and cultivation of trees, shrubs, flowers or plants in or around any cemetery lot, or for improving the said premises in any other manner or form consistent with the 5 design and purposes of this Act, according to the terms of such grant, donation or bequest.

IX. And be it enacted, That the said Cemetery shall Cemetery be and is hereby declared exempt from all public taxes, exempt from taxes, taxes. rates or assessments, and shall not be liable to be sold on

- 10 execution, or be applied in payment of debts due from any individual proprietor or prop retors, but they and their heirs or devisees or assigns may forever hold the same entirely and totally exempt therefrom as long as the same shall remain dedicated to the purposes of a Ceme-15 tery, and during which time no public street, road or avenue shall be laid through the Cemetery or any part of the lands held by the said Corporation for the purposes aforesaid, except by special permission of the legislature.

And be it enacted, That the said Corporation shall Corporation appoint a Secretary to the same, with power to dismiss may appoint a and re-appoint or appoint another at pleasure, and are make By-laws. hereby authorised to make By-laws not inconsistent with any existing law, for the management of its property, the 25 regulation of its affairs and the transfer of the shares of its stock.

XI. And be it enacted, That this Act shall be a Public Public Act. Act.
