C A P. XVII.

An Act to continue, until the First Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and three, an Act, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of *Newfoundland*; and to continue, until the Expiration of Forty Days after the Commencement of the next Session of Parliament, several Laws relating to the Admission of certain Articles of Merchandize in neutral Ships, and the issuing of Orders in Council for that Purpose; to the authorizing His Majesty to make Regulations respecting the Trade to the *Cape of Good Hope*; and to the enabling His Majesty to permit Goods to be imported into this Kingdom in neutral Ships. [19th *February* 1800.]

WHEREAS the Laws herein-after mentioned have by Experience Preamble. been found useful and beneficial, and are near expiring; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and

Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That an Act, made in the Thirty-third Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for establishing Courts of Judicature in the Island of Newfoundland and the Islands adjacent*; which was to continue in Force until the Tenth Day of *June* One thousand seven hundred and ninety-four, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which, by several subsequent Acts of the Thirty-fourth, Thirty-fifth, Thirty-sixth, and Thirty-ninth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, and of this Session of Parliament, was further continued until the Twentieth Day of *February* One thousand eight hundred, shall be and the same is hereby further continued until the First Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and three.

II. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Thirty fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act for rendering effectual His Majesty's Orders in Council, of the Sixteenth and Twenty-first Days of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, respecting the Admission of the Effects mentioned in the said Orders, into the Ports of this Country to be warehoused, and for indemnifying all Persons who have acted in consequence of such Orders*; and also an Act, made in the said Thirty-fifth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to make further Provision respecting Ships and Effects come into this Kingdom to take the Benefit of His Majesty's Orders in Council of the Sixteenth and Twenty-first Days of January One thousand seven hundred and ninety-five; and to provide for the Disposal of other Ships and Effects detained in or brought into the Ports of this Kingdom*; and also an Act, made in the Thirty-sixth Year of His present Majesty's Reign, intituled, *An Act to indemnify all Persons who have acted in consequence of Orders in Council, issued since the Twenty-second Day of November One thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, for the Admission of certain Articles of Merchandize in neutral Ships, and to authorize the issuing of Orders in Council for the like Purpose, for a limited Time*; which said Acts were, by several subsequent Acts made in the Thirty-seventh, Thirty-eighth, and Thirty-ninth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, and in this Session of Parliament, further continued until the said Twentieth Day of *February* One thousand eight hundred, shall be and the same are hereby further continued until the Expiration of Forty Days after the Commencement of the next Session of Parliament.

And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the Thirty-seventh Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act, authorizing His Majesty, for a limited Time, to make Regulations respecting the Trade and Commerce to and from the Cape of Good Hope*; which said Act was, by Three Acts made in the Thirty-eighth and Thirty-ninth Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, and in this Session of Parliament, further continued until the said Twentieth Day of *February* One thousand eight hundred, shall be and the same is hereby further continued until the Expiration of Forty Days after the Commencement of the next Session of Parliament.

IV. And be it further enacted, That an Act, made in the last Session of Parliament, intituled, *An Act to enable His Majesty, by Order in Council, to permit, until Six Weeks after the Commencement of the next Session of Parliament,*

Parliament, such Goods as shall be specified in such Order to be imported into this Kingdom in neutral Ships; which Act was continued, by an Act made in this Session of Parliament, until the said Twentieth Day of February One thousand eight hundred, shall be and the same is hereby further continued until the Expiration of Forty Days after the Commencement of the next Session of Parliament.
