THE RETAIL MARKETS.

High Prices Paid for Venison and Game—Peaches Take a Sudden Rise.

Game has made its appearance in the market this week, the hunting season having commenced in the month of August. Game is fairly plentiful and retailing at from 75 to 85 cents per brace; venison is not quite so plentiful as yet, and is 124 cents a pound makes it pretty "dear."

The drift gill nets employed for taking cod salmon outside of the waters of the Fraser river to be used from 25th September until 15th December. The fishery is recommended that in all rivers commercial fishing with nets be restricted to the tidal part of the river.

We consider it very important that the movement of the salmon toward the spawning grounds be facilitated by weekly close times of thirty-six hours during the season, from 6 a.m. on Saturday to 6 p.m. on Sunday, each week during the continuance of the season.
