Where there should be encouragement there is discouragement.

Farmers here and there have recognized that the birds are necessary to the protection of their fruit and grain from crawling insects, aside from the joy that the songsters bring to country life. It is good to see, therefore, that at least one farmers' organization has actively taken up cudgels in defense of the birds.

Encourage boys and girls by giving them a plot of ground on which to grow vegetables or whatever crop they wish, and let them have the re-



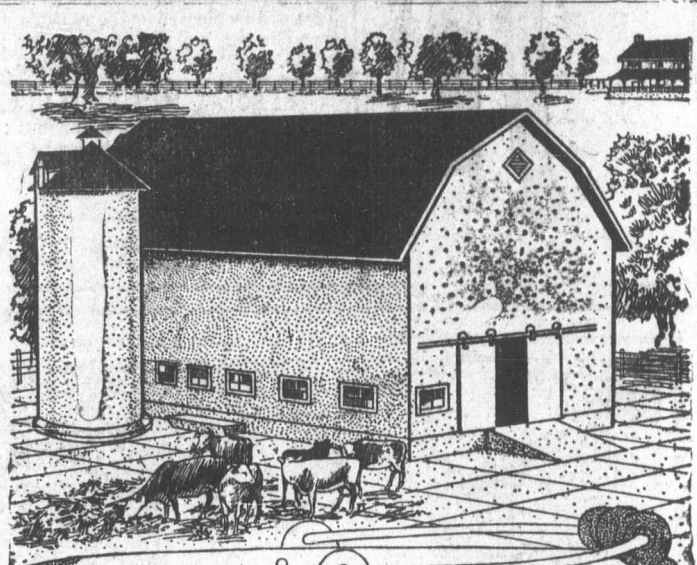
