DE FOREST'S WIRELESS TELEGRAPHY

The Public Demonstration to Be Made on Monday.

A great deal of interest is being taken in the wireless telegraph to be made by Dr. de Forest. Yesterday the tall masts, both in Toronto and Hamilton were placed in position, excepting only the topmost section. Today minor experiments will be made with a view of ascertaining the connection, and on Monday a public demonstration will take place in the presence of several prominent citizens of both cities. Although this will be the first test made across inland waters, Dr. de Forest, who at 29 is an excellent type of the strenuous man of the day, is positive that the demonstration will be successful and anticipates a free exchange of messages between the two cities. AN ARMY OF THIEVES. An Italian Town is Terrorized by One Thousand Robbers.

Rome, Feb. 20.—The Corriere della Sera, one of the most important journals in Italy, vouchers for the truth of the following facts, which would appear to show that the little town of Pietrafesa is almost entirely in the hands of a gang of thieves, the population being so overawed by the criminals that they seem powerless to take any steps to check their depredations.

One after another the gang has burgled many of the chief houses in the town, their method being to break holes in the walls of the buildings and enter by means of ladders.

Some of the inhabitants have armed themselves and taken to mounting guard, but a force of about 100 men, day and night several hundred shots were fired, but so far as can be learned, no one has been injured.

The police force in the neighborhood is not sufficiently strong to organize a determined attack on the robbers, who are in sufficient strength to make short work of the police. It is believed that the gang consists of several hundred men, and has been in existence for at least 1000 years.

### YEAR FOR IMPERSONATORS

F. B. Carlisle and Robert Raynor Voted for Others on Liquor Act on Dec. 4.

THEY MUST ALSO PAY FINE OF \$400

J. D. Coulter, for Procuring, Found Guilty and Judgment Reserved.—One Failed to Appear.

F. B. Carlisle, impersonator, one year in Central Prison and fine of \$400.

Robert Raynor, impersonator, one year in Central Prison and fine of \$400.

J. D. Coulter, procuring; held that case had evidence for it; judgment reserved till Tuesday.

Daniel Cohen, impersonator, failed to answer.

Joseph McNeil, impersonator, adjourned till Tuesday.

The trial of the impersonator cases arising out of the referendum vote was continued before Judge McCormick yesterday. The first case called was that of F. B. Carlisle, in which judgment was reserved Thursday afternoon. At the outset of the proceedings Mr. Haverson called his honor's attention to his objection to the court's jurisdiction.

After James Robertson, assistant to the Clerk of the Crown in Chancery, had given evidence as to the authenticity of the poll books and other records, G. G. Mills, solicitor for the name of Peter Gallagher, told how Carlisle came into the polling booth and applied for a ballot under the name of Peter Gallagher, a dead man, and on being challenged immediately left the booth, but returned his name after and tried to explain his action as a joke.

Mr. Robinette contended that the prosecution had not made out a case of impersonation, basing his contention on the fact that Carlisle had only made an attempt to get a ballot, but had not formally applied for it, and claiming that the act does not cover an attempt to procure. After a somewhat lengthy argument, the judge, after judgment, sentencing Carlisle to one year in the Central Prison, and to pay a fine of \$400 and costs. In default of payment within one month, a further term of three months is to be imposed.

Case of Robert Raynor. The next case was that of Robert Raynor, burglar and impersonator, who was charged with impersonating a member of the Ontario Legislative Council, and received a ballot under the name of Robert Robinson, of 7 Millard-street, which ballot was marked and placed in the ballot box. The identical name of Robinson was identified. Frank Jackson, one of the scrutineers at this booth, was personally acquainted with Raynor, and knew at the time that he was impersonating. He said that "Bob was persuing full the day."

Raynor testified that he was so drunk that day that he had no recollection of voting anywhere, nor of anything that happened after he met J. D. Coulter at the West Queen-street committee rooms.

T. C. Robinette based the defence on the plea that Raynor was too drunk to be responsible for his actions, and was merely a tool in the hands of other men. His Honor replied that the evidence showed that Raynor did choose but to impose a sentence of one year in the Central and a fine of \$400 and costs, and that he was not to be excused on the ground of drunkenness.

Was Obligated to Commit

Young McEachern was brought before H. P. Moore, J. P., on Monday evening, and the evidence was so strong and conclusive that the justice had no alternative but to commit him for trial. The evidence showed that at least three of his companions had received money, which they knew to be stolen, and they will, doubtless, be obliged to face the evidence in court, along with McEachern.
