As to our own statistics a very gratifying feature of them is that the annual increase of members is greater on Missions than on the Churches. For instance, out of 28 Missions on our roll during the past year, 20 report an increase, and after deducting a decrease of 28 on the remaining 6, the net increase for the year on our Mission Stations is 1,177. There is an apparent decrease, compared with last year, in the number of members, but this arises from four of our old Missions, members having by last Conference been declared as having departed this life.

REPORT.

In presenting the Report for 1871-2, we have decided to confine ourselves to a succinct statement of our own operations, as inseparably connected, however, with, and an essential part of the great work to which, before ascending up on high, the Saviour commissioned his Church—and believing that, however interesting to us a recital of the progress of the work in general may be, after all, that of the first importance to any given section of the Church is as to the state and prospect, of its own operations. We would merely remark, that the great enterprise is still advancing, and before it false systems everywhere recede. Christianity is the only really aggressive religious system in the world to-day; hence it is the only one whose character is such as to render its ultimate and complete success by any means possible. Paganism, Bhuddism, Brahminism, Mahomedism, &c., appear to be homogeneous to certain soils, are bounded by certain well defined geographical lines, and only find favor among particular races of mankind; whereas Christianity flourishes in every clime, lays claim to the habitable globe as its heaven-appointed field of labor, and imparts conscious salvation to all who come under its beneficent sway. The spirit-stirring battle-cry of Israel's hosts is to-day in harmony with the commission verbally given by the Master nearly nineteen hundred years ago:—"Christ for the world, and the world for Christ," is but a change of phraseology for the command, "Go ye out into all the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature." The past year has been no exception to the rule of our army's triumphal advance upon the foe, of blessed victories achieved. The Lord of Hosts is with us, according to the promise; and, in the light of passing events, every year gives increased force to the prophetic declaration—"His dominion shall be from sea even to sea, and from the river even to the ends of the earth."

As to our own statistics, a very gratifying feature of them is, that the annual increase of members is greater on Missions than on the Circuits. For instance, out of 26 Missions on our roll during the past year, 20 report an increase, and, after deducting a decrease of 89 on the remaining 6, the nett increase, for the year, on our Mission Stations, is 239. There is an apparent decrease, compared with last year, of 137; but this arises from four of our old Missions, with 403 members, having by last Conference been declared self-sustaining Circuits.

During the past year, your outlay has assumed unusually large proportions, owing to the opening up and sustaining Missions in the Cities of Toronto and Hamilton. In connection with this, it was necessary to procure additional men from England, the expenses of whom, with their families, forms quite a heavy item of expenditure. We gratefully acknowledge, however, the kindness of the Parent Society in sparing such efficient men as the Brethren Kenner admittedly are, and trust that they may, in their new sphere of labor, be blessed and made an abundant blessing.

Of late years, we have been concentrating, more than formerly, our efforts upon the centres of population. Within the last two years, we have obtained a footing, for the first time, in such places, for instance, as Lindsay, Lakefield, Campbellford, Oakwood, Beaverton, Sutton, Ashburnham, and Summerside P.E.I. These, and many other villages, in addition to the Cities, have been successfully occupied, and in most of them we have valuable Connexional property, societies and good congregations, and our Denominational *status* is proportionately enhanced.

If the last decade has not given us such an increase to our membership as it was reasonable to expect, it has been to us a period of unparalleled consolidation and material advancement; as is evident from the fact that within the ten years last past, more than two-thirds of our connexional property has been accumulated, although our operations in Canada cover a period of nearly 40 years,

Our vitality, as a Denomination, will be manifest from another fact, namely, that for 17 years the Bible Christian Church in Canada has sustained her Missionary operations unaided by the Parent Society—a position assumed by no other Methodist Body in Canada, having connection with an English Conference. Further, we may add, that for some ten years, from our separate Conferential existence to the transfer of the Prince Edward Island District to this jurisdiction, one-tenth of our Missionary receipts were annually remitted to England, and for which we received no financial equivalent, beyond trying to pay in kind the liberal expen-

diture of the Parent Society in the earlier years of our comparative dependence. These matters we respectfully present, not by way of self-laudation, but as calculated to evoke thankfulness for past success, and stimulate to further prayer, faith, and benevolence, effort, in the mission to which God has so manifestly called us.

A very pleasing feature connected with the past year's operations, is the quarterly reports from Missions, which, coming through your Secretary, have by him been prepared for, and have ultimately appeared in the *Observer*. The publication of these Reports, coming fresh from the Missions sustained by this Society, has doubtless led to an increased interest in our Mission work, and we see, as one desirable result, an increase, to the extent of about \$1000, in our regular Missionary receipts. By a glance at the brief summary of Reports following, and the tabular statement subjoined, a pretty accurate idea of our affairs may be gathered.

We have taken up an appointment at Ashburnham, an important centre immediately contiguous to the town of Peterborough, where religious services had been held for many years. Here quite a society has been formed, and a connexional brick church is in course of erection. Owing to Peterborough being a Circuit, and Ashburnham connected with it, no mention is made of it in the synopsis of Mission Reports following.

First in Alphabetical order, is the new mission of BROCK AND GEORGINA.—The report says: "One year ago, we had not a member, nor an adherent even, on this ground—save at Derryville, where a few had acknowledged us, through the preaching of the Mariposa brethren. During the year, a comfortable church has been built at Derryville, and its entire cost provided for. Our congregations are still increasing, and we are securing considerable respect with the public. Special meetings were held, under very discouraging circumstances; but several souls were converted, seven of whom have united with the Church. At Sutton, the great want has been a suitable preaching place, for which purpose we occupied successively a Ball Room, a Carpenter's Shop, and a School House. While occupying the Carpenters' Shop, some special meetings were held, at which 18 persons professed faith in Christ. Owing to violent opposition, the School House, which had been kindly placed at our disposal by the Trustees, was again taken from us, and we had to fall back on the Ball Room. After we had been laboring in the village a short time, the Wesleyans came in, and a few of our members left and joined them; but we still number 14, and one on trial. We subsequently, with great difficulty, secured an eligible building site, and, before many months

elapse, we expect to be in possession of a connexional church at Sutton, the cost of which will be fully provided for. At Pefferlaw, we preach in the Hall. The congregation is not large, but the Missionary list will shew that the people are interested in our cause. We devoutly thank God for the success of the past year on this new Mission, and pray that the coming year may witness still greater things."

The motto of CAMPBELLFORD, the Report declares to be "onward!" Since the church was opened in the rising village of Campbellford, shortly after last Conference, our cause has been improving all over the Mission. A fair congregation and membership, have already been gathered in the village. The membership on the Mission has increased more than 75 per cent., and the Sabbath School Scholars more than doubled during the year. The finances have also improved, so that, according to the report, "the friends hope, by next year, to have no further need of a Conference Grant." It is believed that the work on the Mission is more than one man is able to do justice to.

COLBORNE.—The report speaks of many difficulties, experienced at the beginning of the year, now happily passed away. The labors of the year have been owned of God in the salvation of many souls. At a new appointment, taken up during the year, a class of 10 has been formed. In the course of the year, 45 have been admitted on trial; and a net increase of 23 is reported. Bethel chapel has been seated and painted, at a cost of \$125, which has been provided for. The financial aspect, however, is not so gratifying.

The new Mission in COLCHESTER was opened, shortly after last Conference, under embarrassing circumstances, and the result of the first year's labor is not what it otherwise might have been. The settlers, who had but recently penetrated the forest, were not in a position to contribute much; and hence they asked for a single man; but as there was not a suitable young man, a married preacher was sent, who, on his arrival, found no shelter for his family, and had forthwith to build. The good Brother has also had to undergo severe family affliction during the year. The services have been held in the houses of the settlers, who have contributed about \$100 towards the support of the Missionary. The Report says: "We are pleased to say our prospects are more cheering. The contract for building our chapel is let, and we hope to be able to occupy it at no very distant day. Our congregations are increasing, with the growth of the settlement; and our Sabbath School is in a flourishing condition. There is a deeper interest in our class meetings, and

CLINTON.—This Mission is steadily improving, financial-ly, numerically, and spiritually. A commodious shed has been built on the town property; but a new church is already needed, as the present building is filled to overflowing. The social means are also better attended. The Holmesville friends are preparing to build a new shed. Mount Pleasant has suffered from want of pastoral visitation. An increase of 25 members is reported.

FENELON appears to be about as reported a year ago. Membership the same; deficiency in Sabbath School Scholars and finances; 14 admitted during the year, have been counterbalanced by removals and unfaithfulness.

GREY has somewhat advanced, showing an increase of 7 members and 10 scholars. The financial state is improved, and, on the whole, there is room to hope for a brighter day for the Missions than until now was thought possible.

HAMILTON.—By resolution of last Conference, this City was placed on the list of Stations, and on the arrival of Bro. W. Kenner from England, in September last, he was appointed by the Executive Committee to take charge of it. A number of families at once united, and some others have since turned in with us—so that we now report 22 members. A serious drawback, for several months, was the want of a suitable place in which to worship. This, however, has been corrected by the purchase of a very suitable property on which quite a commodious church was already erected. Since taking possession of our own property, the congregations have been less fluctuating, and have materially increased. We think that energetic and united efforts will soon place the Bible Christian Church in a good position among the evangelical churches of the City.

The HUNGERFORD Mission has had the advantage of two laborers during the past year and appears to have been advantaged proportionably. A new church has been opened, almost free of debt; and the Tweed church, long in disuse because sadly out of repair, is now undergoing improvements, and will soon be ready for use again. Quite a number have been admitted during the year; but after making up for unfaithfulness and removals, the numbers stand about the same as last year. The Sabbath scholars have apparently, but not really diminished.

HUNTINGDON.—The connexional property has been improved, and, as a consequence, the Missionary is *minus* his salary. The new Parsonage must, on such a field as Huntingdon, have been a pretty heavy tax; but the old house

had become absolutely untenable. A fair subscription for the Parsonage has been raised, but the severity of the late winter, demanding unusually large outlay for cattle feed, &c., has lessened the contributions for the support of the Ministry. It is intended to complete the new church in the Robinson neighborhood during the present year. To the low state of piety prevailing, and concomitant evils, may be attributed the lack of power and consequent lack of success in winning souls.

INGERSOLL is reported to be steadily, though slowly advancing. The Ingersoll congregation is much improved, and a successful effort has been put forth to lessen the church debt. The Sabbath School presents a most cheering aspect. Putnamville church is quite overcrowded, and the society in a state of spiritual prosperity. At the 4th Concession, steps have been taken to build a good church, and \$700 subscribed towards the object. A rich effusion of the Holy Spirit realized, and this Mission would soon become a self-sustaining Circuit.

LAKEFIELD.—The very nice church in the village of Lakefield has been completed, and opened free of debt, and considerable raised towards the paying off of the recently purchased Parsonage. Notwithstanding this, the Missionary receipts are over in advance. Lakefield congregation has increased largely since opening the Church, and a Sabbath School, recently organized, will prove a valuable auxiliary. On the whole, our *status* has so much improved, that an independent position is sought, and will doubtless be readily granted.

LINDSAY.—This Mission, not yet two years old, under the fostering care of the Denomination and an energetic pastor, has assumed quite unlooked-for proportions. After allowing for 15 removals during the year, there is still an increase of 26 members. The Sabbath School is in a most healthy state, numbering 140 scholars, and steadily increasing. A Total Abstinence Society, in connection with the Church, is doing a good work. Quarterly receipts during the year amount to \$239.51; Missionary receipts, \$110: while money has also been freely given for a variety of other connexional and evangelical objects. The erection of a spacious brick church, at a cost of \$5000, is being proceeded with, and will be completed in September next. On the whole, the Lindsay Mission, so far, has exceeded anything the most sanguine dared to hope for, and the prospect is excellent.

LITTLE PRAIRIE, WIS.—Another year of toil, with good results, otherwise than denominationally. With a small

grant from this Society, the disbursements of the Mission have been met. The congregations have been good, and the Word preached is apparently appreciated. The social means are also well attended, and an inquiring spirit is very general. Several conversions during the year are reported; and the membership has somewhat increased.

LONDON.—“Our cause in the city is as prosperous as at any former period,” says the Report. The country part of the work, however, seems to be sadly effected by certain unfavorable circumstances, and quite a few have left our ranks in consequence. Those in full membership on the Mission, are 153—an increase of 3; but, including those on trial, the aggregate return shows a decrease of 26. The schools are still an interesting feature of the work, although a decrease in the numbers of scholars is reported. The finances are freed from embarrassments; the Trust Fund having been relieved several hundreds of dollars. The day approaches when church improvement in the city must be made; indeed, the necessity for it already exists. We could extend our borders, if we had men and means. St. Thomas presents a very favorable opening; but if we take advantage of it, \$1000, at least, will be necessary to make a suitable commencement. Who will help in this matter?

OSHAWA—During the year, the sum of \$645 has been subscribed to free the Church of debt and \$200 more towards its enlargement. Some special services have been held, and a few souls have professed converting grace. Sabbath scholars 25 less than last year. The congregation is considered much improved, and the Quarterly and Missionary receipts are in advance.

In PERRYTOWN Mission, the congregations have been good, and the meetings characterized by much of the Divine influence. Owing to removals and unfaithfulness, a diminished membership is reported. Finances are in a healthy state—receipts being somewhat in advance of disbursements. Owing to some mistake, the entire receipts of this Mission, for the past two years, have been returned as Missionary money, thereby causing much confusion. Owing to this, the list was not published last year, and, in simple justice, we can only pursue the same course this year—crediting the Mission with its surplus of \$5, as a donation to the Mission fund. A new Brick Church is in course of erection at Elliott's, and Providence chapel property has been much improved.

PICKERING.—This station comprises appointments in the Townships of Pickering and Scarboro', on which are 5 connexional chapels. Duffin's Creek is the only village occupied, and here, although 7 other Denominations exist, our cause is in

a very encouraging state. We have only 2 Denominational Sabbath Schools; while 4 others, consisting chiefly of Bible Christian teachers and scholars, are conducted on the "Union" principle. Removals are frequent, owing to many of our friends being renting farmers; and hence, although several have united with us during the year, our increase is small. The station is too large for one preacher to work.

PORT HOPE was set off last year as a separate station, and already the wisdom of the step is evident. "Numerically," says the Report, "we about double last year's return. Spiritually, too, we have advanced; and the society is living in peace. Our church is undergoing enlargement, to meet the want of an increasing congregation. Financially, we have gone beyond what was at all expected; and, with our increased accommodation, continued exertion, and the blessing of God, we fondly hope, after another year, to be self-sustaining—a position we might have nearly reached already, but for the great outlay in Church improvements and in paying off the long-standing Church debt.

PRINCE ALBERT.—"Expected good has not been fully realized; while some matters, with which were associated anxious fears, have been brought to a successful issue. The new Brick church at Williamsburg, (a gigantic undertaking, everything considered) costing about \$2,300, has been completed, and at its dedication was presented a free gift to the Lord. A Sabbath School has been organised in the new Church, with cheering prospects. We have had quite a number of removals, which, with deaths, &c., will leave our number a few less than last year. Our Quarterly receipts are in advance, but in Missionary money we are somewhat behind the previous return, owing to strenuous effort all over the Mission to free the new church of debt.

P. E. ISLAND MISSIONS.—Our Mission work on P. E. Island is progressing. The four stations declared to be self-sustaining last year, enjoy their independence and are doing well. The West Devon Church is to be finished this summer, and some signs of improvement appear on the Western Mission. The new Mission in Summerside, opened in July last, is not without encouraging prospects; though the difficulties are many, the opposition of some, great, and the friends few. A most eligible building site has been purchased, in one of the best parts of this rapidly growing town, at a cost of \$500, and the friends are already preparing to build.

SCOTT.—The Mission is about the same as in years gone by, with a little brightening in the prospect for the Uxbridge work. We trust that judicious legislation, at the Confer-

TORONTO.—A new mission, opened by our church last
 autumn. It has succeeded beyond what any of us expected;
 while to very many of our best friends the effort appeared
 a most unwise and unwarrantable one. With not a mem-
 ber to recognize your agent on his arrival in the City, it is
 matter for devout thankfulness that 34 (many of them gath-
 ered in from the world) are now in church fellowship with
 us. From our first appointment until now, not one service
 has failed, for want of a congregation, or from any other
 cause; and since we opened the Tabernacle, the regular con-
 gregation has improved, and less fluctuation has been man-
 ifest. The Executive Committee incurred a grave respon-
 sibility in purchasing the City property, and erecting the
 temporary Church; but such a step appeared to be absolute-
 ly necessary, and results already prove its wisdom. As our
 numbers increase, they liberally sustain the cause; and all
 appear confident as to the future of the Mission. The re-
 port concludes as follows: "The Bible Christian Church of
 Toronto gratefully acknowledges, at the very earliest oppor-
 tunity, the liberality of the Church which has called them
 into being, and thus far sustained them; and hail with
 pleasure the occasion to offer fraternal greetings to the De-
 nomination to which, under God, they owe their being as a
 Church, and of which they now claim to be regarded as an
 integral part."

WIARTON has undergone much trial, arising from severe
 reverses which the friends generally have had to sustain.
 Last summer's drought has been followed by a winter of
 unusual severity. The Missionaries have shared in the
 hardships of the friends, to an extent known only to God
 and themselves. The work of God has gone on, however;
 and several souls have found peace in believing, and been ad-
 ded to the Church. Three preaching places have been added
 during the year, at one of which 5 persons are prepared to
 unite with us. We preach at 12 regular appointments, and
 have societies at 7 of them. There is a small increase of
 members on the year. The Sabbath School at Wiarton,
 which was originally "Union," has been converted into a
 connexional one and is working well.

The subjoined tabular statement will show, in a condens-
 ed form, the actual state over the whole ground covered by
 the Missionary operations of the Bible Christian Church in
 Canada.
