We have the pleasure of handing you here-with our Weekly Prices Current, showing the condition of our market for the past week. Our quotations, it should be understood, represent the *wholesale prices* generally. In the making up of small orders, higher prices have to be charged. All quotations are duty paid, unless otherwise stated.

## Commercial Report.

**BREADSTUFFS.**—Our market remains without quotable change since our last. Canada superfine is still in very small supply, and is held at \$7.50 to \$7.75. New York market remains firm; prices at Toronto are relatively lower, and we hear of several orders being forwarded to the latter place. Demand keeps very light, and sales are limited to retail transactions—buyers holding off, anticipating a decline as soon as Canadian stock begins to arrive.

Corn meal is very firm, at \$4.60 and \$4.75.

**FREIGHTS.**—Our freight market has been very dull during the week. The quantity of tonnage offering continues light: at the same time there is very little demand, and market rates may be considered lower. The following detail charters are reported: *Bina*, 647, for the Clyde, 715.3d.; *N. Churchill*, Bristol Channel, 738.9d.; *Confederate*, 220 Dundalk, 77s. 6d.; *J. A. Viree*, 299, Drogheda, 83s. 9d.; *Diogenes*, 310, Limerick, 80s.; *Maud Potter*, 177, Sligo, 82s. 6d. For the West Indies, we hear of the charter of the *Lizzie Troop*, 207, for north side Cuba, at \$94 and \$10.

Coastwise freights are about the same as at last report. The following transactions are reported: *R. J. Leonard*, 128, *Ella*, 192, *Georgiana*, 83, and *Black Bird*, 77—all for Boston, at \$4; *Sarah Gordon*, 115, New York, laths, 192c.; *Ida J.*, 93, Sydney to this port, coals, \$2.50 per chal.; *Riverside*, —, Lingtan to Providence, coals, \$3.75 cy. per ton.
