Lethbridge，Aug．8．－－Martin Adams，residing near this city，is the first farmer of this district to thresh．His winter wheat went through the machine yesterday and the day before， The last few hout days have done wonders in ripening crops all over the south and wheat cutting is general．Ten more days；will see most of it in shock and some threshed．Crop conditions have been 100 per cent，during the last two weeks，and farmers who had dispaired of getting more than half a crop will probably harvest the best yield of their lives．A week ago crops in southern Alberta were reported 70 per cent．Absence of frost and plenty of sunshine for the next month will make it 80 per cent．or over．The harvest help problem is
