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BILL.

AN ACT to annex the Old Survey of West Gwillimbury,
in the County of Simcoe, to the adjoining Township
of East Gwillimbury, in the County of York.

WHEREAS it is expedient that the tract of land Preamble.
hereinafter described should form part of the
Township of East Gwillimbury, in the County of York,
rather than of the Township of West Gwillimbury, in
5 the County of Simcoe:

Be it therefore enacted, &c.

That all that tract of land in the Township of West
Gwillimbury, in the County of Simcoe, lying East of the
West Branch of the Holland River, and known by the
10 name of the Old Survey, shall be, and the said tract of
land is hereby, detached from the said Township of West
Gwillimbury, in the County of Simcoe, and shall here-
after form part of the Township of East Gwillimbury, in
the County of York, to all intents and purposes what-
15 soever, save and except as hereinafter mentioned.

II. Provided always, and be it enacted, that the said
tract of land, and the rateable property therein, and of
the inhabitants thereof, shall still be and remain liable
to any assessment equitably assessed, or to be assessed,
20 on the whole rateable property of the County of Simcoe,
as constituted at the time of the passing of this Act,
which may be requisite for the liquidation of any debt
due or owing, at the time of the passing of this Act, by
the said County of Simcoe: And provided also, that
25 the Toll Road leading from Holland's Landing to Brad-
ford, recently purchased from the Provincial Government
by the County of Simcoe, shall be and remain the pro-
perty, and in the possession and under the control of
the County of Simcoe, as fully as if this Act had not
30 been passed, and the said Road still remained wholly
within the said County.
