The Steamship America arrived at Halifax on Saturday morning. Liverpool dates to the 7th inst. Parliament had adjourned over the Easter holidays.

The Powhatan arrived at Halifax March 5, and reported that the British Ambassadors were there received with all the formal honors. Private households were extended them on every hand, and the King and Queen welcomed them in appropriate terms.

The news from the Sandwich Islands is unimportant. Several British ships of war, arrived at Honolulu on the 16th inst. San Juan Island is in joint occupation by the American and British troops.

It is estimated that 2000 white men and 2000 Chinamen are now engaged in mining on Fraser River. Mining accounts are very encouraging. New diggings were being discovered in various places.

An embassy from Japan, consisting of twenty-two persons, has arrived at San Francisco, on route to Washington. A Japanese man-of-war called the Commodore had also arrived there. Several of her officers had landed.
