THE TELEGRAPHERS.

The Next Convention Will Probably Be Held at Denver.

The report of the Committee on Credentials was again taken up at the convention of the Order of Railway Telegraphers yesterday morning, after which the Assistant Grand Chief Weatherhead read his report as chairman of the Executive Committee.

He spoke chiefly of the additional equipment which had been necessary in the order's headquarters at Victoria, B. C. The report is now the finest possessed by any similar organization on this continent.

A committee composed of Grand Chief Ramsey, Assistant Grand Chief Weatherhead, Grand Secretary Fox and Past Grand Chief Thurston was appointed to confer with the representatives of the Order of Commercial Telegraphers now in the city, for the drafting of an agreement of federation with that order.

It will be of such a nature as not to affect in the slightest the close relations now existing between the railroad telegraphers and the commercial telegraphers. The latter relations were ratified by the convention.

In the afternoon much time was spent on small technical amendments to the constitution, and this business will be continued to-day. This afternoon the reports of the committees will be taken up. Matters are going forward expeditiously, and it is thought that the convention will be brought to a conclusion by 1 o'clock Saturday.

Saturday afternoon the delegates will embark for Buffalo, visiting the Falls, and from thence at noon on Sunday the vast majority of them will start for Denver, Col., Salt Lake City, Utah, and Peoria, Ill., for next year's place of meeting, and it is altogether probable that Denver will be the popular choice.

The officers say that so far the arrangements made by the Toronto people for the reception of the convention are the best on record.

THE HEALTH OF THE CITY.

What the Monthly Report of Dr. Sheard Suggests.

At the meeting of the local Board of Health yesterday Dr. Sheard read a report of the workings of the Medical Health Department, which was received and adopted.

The number of patients admitted to the various hospitals for the month of March were 207 and for April 131, being a decrease in April of 76 patients. The total expenditures for hospital patients for the months of March and April were \$2298.50 and for April \$2045.00, a reduction in April of \$253.50.

The Doctor reported against the dumping of garbage by the City Commissioners in the various localities of the city, which he considered most unwise proceeding. He says: I do not think it possible to deposit it in a place where it will become a nuisance.

Contagious diseases were reported during the months of March and April: Diphtheria..... 101 56
Scarlet fever..... 20 22
Typhoid fever..... 139 22
Epidemic typhus..... 25 150

For the month of April in the two years, 1892 and 1893, the contagious diseases were:

Diphtheria, number of cases..... 1892 1893
Scarlet fever..... 70 50
Typhoid fever..... 49 28
Measles..... 49 28

By this report it will be seen that although there are 77 less cases of typhoid fever reported in April than in March, yet there is still a large increase over the report of last year.

Dr. Bailey gave notice of a motion which he intended to introduce by which he wished to enter sectarian hospitals would have to pay their own fees.

Dr. Hallam was granted with a motion to shut out the figures contained in a report from the press, but the Assistant Grand Chief Weatherhead insisted that the committee were not prepared to back up any such scheme.

The Sir John Macdonald Status. The Macdonald Hotel yesterday afternoon for the purpose of selecting a suitable site for the Sir John Macdonald statue, as \$10,000 of the \$12,000 required has already been received.

At a meeting of the Executive of the Toronto Christian Endeavor Union this resolution was unanimously passed: "That wherefore in the last month there have appeared on the city bill boards certain theatrical advertisements of such a character as tend to appeal to the lowest feelings of passers-by, and whereas, the effect of such disgraceful displays, especially on the young, is most deplorable, be it resolved that we, the members of the Executive of the Toronto Christian Endeavor Union do hereby protest against the display of such unseemly pictures."

Mr. Edwin Arrowsmith, who for 17 years past has been in charge of the Children's Seattle Missions in England, proposes holding a 10-day mission for children in Toronto, and to this end invites the clergy, Sunday school superintendents and others to meet him at the Upper Canada Bazaar, Board Room, 105 Yonge-street, on Friday at 4.30 p.m., where he may have an opportunity of further explaining his work.
