EXTRACT from the Journals of the
LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, in the years
1819, 1820, 1821, and 1822.

IT IS ORDERED,

THAT on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays in every week, the Library of the Legislative Council be open to the Governor and the Lieutenant Governor, to the Members of the Legislative Council, of the Executive Council, and of the House of Assembly, and the Officers of the two Houses for the time being; to His Majesty's Judges, to the Clerk of the Executive Council, and to the Law Officers of the Crown. And that no person having such access shall be permitted to carry any Book or Books out of the building, except the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Person Administering the Government; and that for all books which shall be delivered to His Excellency, a receipt shall be given.

*Legislative Council,
Monday, 8th March, 1824.*

RESOLVED,—That the Members of the Legislative Council be permitted, during the Recess of the Provincial Legislature, to take from the Library of this House, one or two volumes of Books at the same time, and to keep the same during fourteen days, on giving the Librarian a receipt for the same.

RESOLVED,—That no Member shall lend a book belonging to the Library, or shall keep a book for a longer time than is prescribed by the rule of this House.

IL EST ORDONNÉ,

QUE tous les Lundis, Mercredis et Vendredis de chaque Semaine, la Bibliothèque du Conseil Législatif soit ouverte au Gouverneur et au Lieutenant-Gouverneur, aux Membres du Conseil Législatif, du Conseil Exécutif et de la Chambre d'Assemblée, et aux Officiers des deux Chambres, pour le tems d'alors aux Juges de Sa Majesté, au Greffier du Conseil Exécutif et aux Avocats de la Couronne.
