A SHORT SKETCH

— ON —

MONTRÉAL

Montreal was founded in 1642 by Maisonneuve at the foot of Mount Royal whence it takes its name, and is, to-day, the largest, richest, most commercial, populous, and beautiful city in Canada.

Its early developments (1642-1690) were successful only by dint of great perseverance and many sacrifices made by our forefathers, for many a desperate battle did they engage against a most barbarous and sanguinary tribe of savages, the Iroquois.

Incorporated in 1832, it now rivals in importance with the chief cities of the United States, and in beauty with many European cities of fame.

Its site is uncommon with its round mountain whose large reservoir ornaments it as a diamond does a jewel. The majestic St. Lawrence flowing by, its side is furrowed by hundreds of boats of all sizes and varieties, from the smallest pleasure boat to the largest ocean steamer of enormous tunnage, real floating palaces. Montreal presents many admirable points-of-view; from its two platforms on Mount Royal and the summit of its tower built on the highest point of the mountain you may view all the different parts of the city and the neighbouring countries. The central and western parts appear to be built in the heart of a thick forest. No important point escape the eye, you dominate all, being at an altitude of more than 700 feet above the river.

It has a very large port and contains a number of splendid steamboats. Its wharfs are well built and offer every modern convenience that ocean vessels might require. L'ile aux Millions, now a peninsula which very soon will be transformed into a beautiful wharf, runs along the middle of the river and is nearly a mile long; its elevators at present under construction are to be of enormous size and will have a capacity for millions of bushels of grain.

Its Victoria bridge, nearly two miles long, 60 feet wide, with a height of over 100 feet above the river, is undoubtedly a marvel of civil engineering and genius. It has a double railroad, a double carriage way, and a double road for bicycles, pedestrians and electric cars. Notwithstanding its massive construction and weight it retains an elegant appearance. The bridge rests on 24 huge piers. The bridge affords the most interesting standpoint from which the port may be seen, and from the view it affords you may form an idea of the gigantic works going on at the expense of the Canadian Government with the view of making Montreal the national port, and of offering access to the largest ships crossing the ocean.

The city is very regular; St. James, Notre Dame, Commissioners, Craig, St. Catherine, Ontario and Sherbrooke streets varying in length from 8 to 12 miles traverse it in its greatest length from east to west; Guy, Mountain, Bleury, St. Lawrence, St. Denis, Amherst, Papineau, Delormier, etc., 4 to 8 miles long, cross it in its widest extent from south to north.

The principal commercial streets are: Commissioners, St. Paul, St. James, Notre Dame, Craig, McGill, Bleury, St. Lawrence, St. Catherine, and Ontario, which rival in beauty, each having its own characteristic features.

Bonsecours market and Jacques-Cartier square which cover an area of 30 acres are much too small to accommodate the many farmers who assemble there to sell the produce of their lands.

The following places should also be visited:

The Court House with its rows of maple trees, the Champ de Mars, an elevated table-land of about 30 acres, at the disposal of our military reviews and fire brigade tournaments, the City Hall, the Drill Hall, 300 feet long by 150 feet wide and about 100 feet high. Place d'Armes with its Maisonneuve monument erected on a spot which recalls one of the most glorious battles fought by the French in Canada.

Its magnificent banks, such as The Bank of Montreal, Hochelaga, Toronto, and Molson's; its Post Office, its Board of Trade, destroyed by fire in 1900 and since rebuilt.

Notre Dame Church, 250 feet long, 133 feet wide and over 100 feet high, with its two long galeries on each side, its two towers 216 feet high, from the top of which we behold the most interesting and inspiring panorama. Those two towers contain the most beautiful chimes in America. Its largest bell ranks second in the world, being surpassed only by that of Moscow. The exterior of Notre-Dame is very imposing and its interior has a seating capacity of 12,000. The organ is one of the most powerful on the continent.

The Cathedral, built after the plan of St. Peter's in Rome, surmounted by a dome rising to a height of 250 feet, has a grand and noble appearance; its front, ornamented by 13 bronze statues of 12 feet high recalling to memory the most devoted and learned bishops of the Christian Catholic Church, is most majestic. In its vaults repose the ashes of its first three bishops; Mgr Lartigue, Bourget and Fabre. One must also admire the Jesuit's, a real jewel,

with fresco embellishments, and of Greek and Latin style. This church must be visited in detail to admire all its beauties. People also like to visit St. James (French) of Gothic style, St. Patricks, magnificently built on a high site, with its parterre of bright verdure ornamented and shaded by rows of tall stout trees.

St. Louis de France (French), both massive and delicate, offers a very fine view. One could never tire admiring both its exterior and interior; it should be seen on holy days, robed in its rich garments, with its altar illuminated with art and taste by over 1200 electric lights; all is perfect and complete; this church is no way inferior to any in the city.

St. John the Baptist, on the point of completion, offers to the public a majestic temple; its exterior is imposing.

There are also many fine Protestant churches in Montreal, such as St. James Methodist, Beaver Hall Hill churches, Christ's church Cathedral, and Trinity church on St. Denis street.

Montreal possesses many fine parks, decorated with fine trees and covered with fragrant flower beds where the citizens gather in the cool shades of the inviting trees during the hot months of July and August, or to seek repose after the fatigues of a hard day's work. There, may be seen hundreds of business men, laborers, comfortably seated, reading the news, discussing the political questions of the day, the grand projets of an alderman who aims at embellishing Montreal so as to compare favorably with the great American cities, or to draw up his programme for the morrow. Amongst others, may be mentioned Park Lafontaine which covers an area of nearly one square mile and which is destined to become the finest in Canada. Viger square with its central site is a real forest of tall maples and elms

from 60 to 80 feet high, Dominion square, bounded by St. James Cathedral, the Windsor Hotel and the Y. M. C. A. Building, covers an area of from 20 to 30 acres; Mount Royal Park, on the summit of the Mountain and which may be easily reached in a carriage or by the incline railway. Here the best of carriage routes are kept in condition at the expense of the city: its surface covers 100 arpents situated in the midst of a dense forest. Montreal is very rich in chapels, such as that of the Hotel-Dieu, with its large dome, which shelters within its walls hundreds of sick people attended by the best physicians, under the direction of the Hospitaler Nuns; Our Lady of Lourde, a perfect masterpiece of painting and sculpture; Bonsecours chapel, and Our Lady of Pity annexed to the convent of the Congregation of Our Lady are greatly renowned for the many celestial favors obtained.

Montreal has her monuments erected to the glory of her children who have devoted their lives to the service of their country, such as that of Sir John A. Macdonal, Maisonneuve, Dr Chenier who died on the battlefield for the liberty of his fellow countrymen—a liberty guaranteed by our Constitution; that of her Majesty Queen Victoria; I shall no more than mention that of Nelson on Jacques-Cartier square, he being considered a stranger to this country.

Two Electric Street Railway Companies provide first class transportation for the citizens. There are at least 250 miles of railroad, and more than 300 cars are regularly operated in the principal streets giving an average 3 minute service.

Go through the private residential streets, such as St. Denis, Cherrier, Lafontaine Park, St. Hubert, Sherbrooke, Beaver Hall; through Westmount and the western avenues of the city; Union avenue,

Druimond, St. Catherine street west, Park avenue and Mount Royal avenue with their projected boulevards uncommon on account of their elevation, their points of view, their grand, rich nature which only art and good taste can embellish, and which in their brightest days will rival with those of Naples. Trees especially maple border the greater number of the streets in front of superb residences where a most pleasant and agreeable promenade may be enjoyed. Admire the delicate construction of the Grand Trunk Depot; the massive construction of the Windsor and Viger depot which might easily be mistaken for fortresses or Old Country palaces.

Visit Windsor Hotel whose boarders and visitors may be annually numbered by thousands, and occupies an area of from 3 to 4 arpents with its 420 rooms 16 parlors, and hundreds of other apartments, and you will have an idea of the vastness of this gigantic edifice whose exterior is one of entire beauty.

The environs of Montreal are no less beautiful, a fact of which one may be easily convinced by a car drive around the three mountains. Shoot the Lachine Rapids. Examine the new C. P. R. bridge whose length over the river is no less than 4000 feet.

Montreal can count three Universities: Bishops, Laval, and especially McGill which covers a surface of over 100 acres with its lawns, situated at the foot of Mount Royal, ornamented by a range of superb buildings, all generous gifts of our English millionnaires. Thousand of young men come here to draw from the fountain of liberal science under the able direction of select professors. McGill is unsurpassed by any university in America in the richness of its edifices in

its keeping, and in its site. Not far off we notice the Montreal College and the Grand Seminary, also constructed at the foot of the mountain; it and the Jesuits College are the most celebrated in America. The reputation of those two colleges has reached the farthest points in Canada and the United States, and from those points come many young men eager to avail themselves of a solid instruction. The Grand Seminary can contain over 300 students and supply each with a separate apartment.

Montreal has many assylums for young and old, orphans, for the blind and for deaf-mutes; also kindergartens, homes and hospitals. Amongst the most important may be mentioned. The Hotel Dieu, the Notre Dame, the General, and the Victoria (constructed on the occasion of the Queens Jubilee). The Victoria was built by gifts of \$500,000 each, donated respectively by Sir Geo. Stephens and Sir Donald Smith.

There are 200 schools (including all nationalities and both sexes); Elementary, Academic, Commercial, etc. Amongst the principal ones are: The Protestant English High School, the Catholic English High School, the Catholic Commercial Academy which amongst others has sent out so many young men who have distinguished themselves in the different branches of commerce both home and abroad and have filled most important positions of trust in our banks. This academy is a model in construction, built on an eminence, and constitutes the pride of the city. It is entered from St. Catherine street after traversing one of the most beautiful parterres in Montreal.

Mount St. Louis, under the direction of the Christian Brothers compares favorably with the Commercial Academy as

regards site and construction.

Montreal claims many theatres : Proctor's, the Academy of Music, the Theatre Français, the National Français, Les Nouveautés.

Its two cemeteries, Protestant and Catholic, cover 450 arpents and are situated between the three mountains ; their beauty is not equalled on this continent. How many millions of dollars have been spent on the construction of those long rows of tombs hewn out of the mountain rock, on those thousands of granite monuments which remind us that in that's silent city of death, there are now resting upwards of 300,000 souls !

What is to be said of its daily newspapers which keep us constantly in touch with all that takes place in the world ? Let us refer only to *La Presse* scarcely 18 years in existence and has surpassed all other newspapers in Canada, having a daily circulation of over 72,000 copies ; of its literary, scientific and benefit associations, of its immense workshops, of its manufactories which employ from 1000 to 2500 hands, of its stores which look more like palaces than business houses, of the latter we may mention the S. Carsley Co. employing over 300 clerks. H. Morgan & Co. 200. Dupuis Bros. 150 or more. Murphy, Hamilton, Scroggie and Ogilvie employing more than 100 clerks, of its wholesale and retail establishments and you will say that Montreal deserves to be the metropolis of the Dominion and the centre of commerce of all western Canada and the United States Montreal although having an inland situation is by its geographical position nearer to European ports than any other city bordering on the Atlantic. This explains why the Canadian Government should without delay take the means to make Montreal the finest and greatest national

port on the American continent, and thereby attract all western trade by the construction of suitable canals along the Spanish river, lake Nipissing, French and Ottawa rivers. Then would Montreal be equal, if not superior to New York and Chicago.



QUELQUES NOTES

La ville de Montréal, fondée en 1642 par Paul Chomedy sieur de Maisonneuve, est située au pied du Mont-Royal, d'où elle tire son nom. Elle compte aujourd'hui une population de 350,000 âmes. C'est une belle et grande ville, la plus importante du Canada, tant au point du commerce et de l'industrie qu'à celui des attractions qu'elle offre aux touristes.

Ses premiers développements, de 1642-1690, n'ont été couronnés de succès qu'à force de persévérance et de sacrifices de la part des premiers colons de Ville-Marie, (1) exposés qu'ils étaient surtout aux attaques incessantes des Iroquois, peuplades barbares et sanguinaires.

Incorporée en 1832, elle rivalise aujourd'hui en beauté et en importance avec les premières villes des Etats-Unis, voire même de l'Europe. Aussi sa situation est-elle tout à fait exceptionnelle. Adossée au Mont-Royal, elle voit avec orgueil à ses pieds le plus beau fleuve du monde ; le St-Laurent, dont les eaux limpides sont sillonnées en tous sens par des centaines de vaisseaux de toute dimension, y compris les océaniques du plus fort tonnage.

Du sommet du Mont-Royal,—dont l'altitude au-dessus du fleuve est de 700 pieds,—le touriste ne se lasse d'admirer les points de vue les plus magnifiques que lui

offre la ville et les campagnes environnantes. Les parties centre et ouest de la ville apparaissent aussi à l'œil ébloui du touriste comme une cité bâtie au milieu d'une épaisse forêt. Enfin, aucun accident, quelque peu saillant qu'il soit, n'échappe à son regard qui embrasse toute la ville, tant il la domine du point élevé où il se trouve.

Le port de Montréal est très grand et peut contenir une flotte nombreuse. Ses quais, bien construits, offrent toutes les commodités modernes que les vaisseaux océaniques peuvent exiger. Ses élévateurs, actuellement en construction, et capables une fois terminés de contenir des millions de minots de grain, diront assez à l'étranger même ce qui est et ce que sera demain le trafic du port de Montréal.

Le pont Victoria, qui traverse le fleuve, — reliant Montréal à St-Lambert, — mesure deux milles environ de longueur et soixante pieds de largeur, pendant qu'il s'élève à plus de cent pieds au dessus du fleuve. Démoli en parti en 1900 pour être aussitôt reconstruit sur un plan plus moderne, le pont Victoria, avec ses nombreuses voies pour les chars à vapeur, tramways électriques, voitures, piétons et bycyclistes, constitue une vraie merveille dont s'honore à bon droit le génie humain. Malgré sa construction énorme et massive, le pont Victoria conserve cependant une apparence élégante.

De ce pont, qui repose sur vingt-quatre piliers, le regard embrasse tout le port de Montréal, dont alors on a une idée assez exacte et de son étendue et de son importance. Les travaux considérables qui s'y font actuellement feront sans doute de ce port, l'un des premiers du monde, où les plus gros vaisseaux trouveront aisément un accès sûr et commode.

Pour faciliter encore la navigation du St-Laurent, — un moment interrompue par le

Sault St-Louis, près de Montréal —, un canal, long de huit milles, traverse plusieurs quartiers très populeux de la ville, ainsi qu'une riche et verdoyante campagne, qui s'étend jusqu'à Lachine où il atteint au lac St-Louis. De chaque côté de ce canal, s'élèvent des moulins à farine, des scieries, des manufactures et des usines de tous genres.

La ville de Montréal, par ses rues, offre un aspect régulier. Les rues St-Jacques, Notre-Dame, Craig, Ste-Catherine, Ontario, Sherbrooke, longues de huit à douze milles, la traversent dans le sens de sa longueur, c'est-à-dire, de l'est à l'ouest, pendant que les rues Guy, de la Montagne, Bleury, St-Laurent, St-Denis, Amherst, Papineau, Delorimier, etc., dont la longueur varie de quatre à huit milles, la traversent dans le sens de sa largeur, c'est-à-dire du sud au nord.

Le commerce de gros occupe particulièrement les rues des Commissaires, St-Paul, Ste-Hélène, de Bresolle, etc., pendant que celui du détail se limite aux rues Notre-Dame, St-Jacques, Craig, McGill, St-Laurent, Ste-Catherine, Ontario et autres.

Les maisons Morgan, Carsley, Dupuis, Hamilton, Scroggie, Ogilvie, Bukrs, etc., sont des magasins à départements très considérables, dont pour plusieurs le chiffre d'affaires dépasse un million.

Le marché Bonsecours et la place Jacques-Cartier, lesquels couvrent une superficie de 30 acres ; sont aujourd'hui trop petits pour faire place à tous les commerçants et jardiniers de la campagne qui viennent y vendre les produits de la ferme.

Parmi les édifices publics les plus importants qu'il convient de mentionner ici, citons le Palais de Justice, construction massive autant qu'importante, l'Hôtel de Ville, la Salle d'Exercice, le Bureau de Poste, la Chambre de Commerce.

ainsi que les banques de Montréal, d'Ho-chelaga, de Toronto, de Molson, des Marchands, du New York Life, etc., etc., qui sont des édifices considérables.

Les églises de Montréal sont nombreuses. Celle de Notre-Dame — le temple le plus vaste de la ville — peut, avec ses deux rangées de jubés, contenir commodément 12,000 personnes assises. Ses tours, hautes de 216 pieds, possèdent le plus beau carillon de toute l'Amérique. Du haut de ces tours, on jouit d'un spectacle fort attrayant. L'intérieure est riche et décoré avec un grand goût. L'orgue de Notre-Dame est considéré comme l'un des plus puissants du continent américain.

La Cathédrale St-Jacques, bâtie d'après le plan de la basilique de St-Pierre de Rome, est surmontée d'un dôme qui s'élève à plus de 250 pieds dans les airs. Ce temple, d'une construction aux larges proportions et dont treize statues de bronze ornent la façade, présente un aspect saisissant de grandeur et de majesté. A l'intérieure, on remarque surtout l'autel et le baldaquin qui le surmonte, œuvre d'art d'un très grand prix. Dans la crypte de ce temple reposent les cendres des premiers évêques de Montréal, savoir : Mgrs Lartigue, Bourget et Fabre.

On admire encore beaucoup l'église du Gesù, construite d'après le style grec et latin et embellie à l'intérieur de fresques très appréciées du public connaisseur.

Citons enfin, les églises St-Jacques, de St-Patrice, de St-Pierre, de St-Louis de France, de St-Jean-Baptiste. Ces deux dernières, nouvellement construites sont aussi très admirées, tant pour leur apparence architecturale que pour les décosrations que l'on y remarque à l'intérieur; celle de St-Louis de France possède peut-être le plus beau luminaire électrique (soit 1200 lumières) qui existe à Montréal.

Aux jours des grandes fêtes, ces nombreuses lumières aux couleurs et aux agencements variés donnent au temple un aspect vraiment féérique.

Il y a aussi de fort belles églises protestantes, qui ne manquent ni de richesse, ni de beauté, telles que la Christ Church Cathedral (anglaise), la St. James Cathedral (methodist), etc.

Montréal compte encore un grand nombre de chapelles, dont les plus importantes sont les suivantes : Notre-Dame de Bonsecours, la plus ancienne église de Montréal ; Notre-Dame de Pitié, qui appartient aux Dames de la Congrégation ; celles de Nazareth, du Sacré-Cœur et de Notre-Dame de Lourde, remarquables pour les toiles ou peintures que l'on y voit, et qui ont pour auteur, des artistes canadiens.

Montréal ne manque pas de parcs, magnifiquement ornés de beaux arbres, parsemés de fleurs odoriférantes et très fréquentés des citadins, qui, pendant les soirées de l'été, trouvent l'occasion facile de se délasser des fatigues du jour, tout en y respirant un air doux et parfumé, propre à ces lieux.

Ces parcs sont le carré Viger, avec sa forêt d'arbres et la gare Viger, splendide construction, qui lui fait face ; le carré Victoria, le parc Lafontaine, au centre duquel se trouve un lac artificiel, le carré St-Louis, le carré Philippe, où est la galerie des Arts ; la Place d'Armes, le carré Dominion où sont groupés la Cathédrale St. Jacques, la gare Windsor, l'Hôtel Windsor, la Y. M. C. A. building ; enfin le parc Mont-Royal, ce dernier le plus fréquenté des touristes, parce qu'il est unique en son genre, situé au sommet de la Montagne, le touriste y pervient soit en voiture, par une route carrossale splendide, à pente très douce, soit encore par

le chemin de fer incliné, qui n'est pas une des moindres attractions de ce parc.

La plupart de ces parcs sont encore décorés de riches et magnifiques monuments que la reconnaissance publique a élevés à la gloire de quelques-uns de ceux qui ont le plus mérité de la Patrie.

C'est ainsi que nous remarquons le monument Maisonneuve, élevé à la Place d'Armes ; celui de Sir John A. Macdonald, politicien remarquable, au carré Dominion ; celui du brave Dr Chénier, de 1837-38, au carré Viger ; celui de la reine Victoria, au carré du même nom, ceux d'Iberville et de Jacques-Cartier, enfin celui que les catholiques de Montréal élèveront cet été en face de la cathédrale, au grand et saint évêque Mgr Ignace Bourget.

Mais il est encore d'autres monuments que la ville de Montréal possède, et qui font la gloire de la nation canadienne. Ce sont les nombreuses maisons d'éducation que l'on y remarque. Montréal compte d'abord trois universités ; celle du McGill, l'une des plus riches du continent ; celle de Laval, la plus ancienne de l'Amérique, et enfin celle du Bishop.

Des milliers de jeunes gens puisent chaque année dans ces institutions, sous l'habile direction de professeurs d'élite, les connaissances qui se rapportent aux sciences et aux arts libéraux. Nulle université du continent ne surpasse en beauté et en richesse les édifices du McGill, dont le site au pied de la Montagne est magnifique. Les messieurs de St-Sulpice possèdent aussi un vaste séminaire qui a donné à l'Eglise des prêtres instruits, des évêques distingués, tant pour le Canada que pour les Etats-Unis. Montréal possède encore deux grands colléges classiques : le collège de Montréal, dirigé par les Sulpiciens, et celui de Ste-Marie dont les jésuites ont la direction. Ces deux institutions attirent de tous côtés une jeunesse nombreuse et

avid de s'instruire. Montréal a aussi des écoles normales, entretenues aux frais du gouvernement, et où se forment ceux aux mains desquelles est confiée l'éducation de la jeunesse. Les communautés religieuses de femmes possèdent un grand nombre d'établissements dont la renommée s'étend jusqu'à l'étranger. Nommons en particulier les couvents du Villa-Maria et du Mont Ste-Marie, qui appartiennent aux Dames de la Congrégation; le couvent d'Hochelaga, des sœurs des SS. Noms Jésus Marie; l'académie St-Louis-de-Gonzague, dirigée par les sœurs du Bon Pasteur, etc., etc.

D'autres maisons, d'un caractère spécial, sont encore dignes d'intéresser vivement le touriste. C'est d'abord l'asile Nazareth, pour les aveugles, que dirigent les sœurs Grises, dont la maison-mère sur la rue Guy occupe un vaste espace; c'est l'institution des sourds-muets, confiée aux Frères Viateurs; celle des sourdes-muettes, dont les sœurs de la Providence ont la direction, en même temps que celle de la plupart des asiles ou jardins d'enfances de la ville; c'est encore le Royal Victoria College, institution protestante où les gardes-malades reçoivent une instruction en rapport avec leur mission.

Le Mont St-Louis, des Frères des Ecoles Chrétiennes, l'académie du Plateau et le High School, ces deux dernières sous le contrôle des commissions scolaires, toutes institutions de premier ordre, se partagent le haut enseignement commercial.

L'enseignement élémentaire est aussi pourvu d'un très grand nombre d'écoles, qui répondent parfaitement bien aux besoins de la ville.

Montréal possède aussi pour le soulagement des misères humaines, diverses hôpitaux et hospices où les vieillards, les infirmes et les malades sans fortune, reçoit

ent gratis les soins que nécessite leur état. Parmi ces hôpitaux, citons l'Hôtel-Dieu, dont la fondation remonte aux premiers temps de la colonie; l'hôpital Victoria, dû à la munificence de Sir Donald Smith et de Sir George Stephens, (souscription \$1,000,000) à l'occasion du jubilé de la reine Victoria; l'hôpital anglais, celui de Notre-Dame, l'hospice Gamelin, etc., etc.

A côté de ces maisons, où le zèle, le dévouement et la science ont bien vite raison des plaintes et des souffrances des patients qui les fréquentent, il s'en trouve d'autres d'un ordre bien différent que le public aime à fréquenter parce qu'il y trouve l'occasion de se récréer et de s'instruire. Ce sont les théâtres. De fait, Montréal en compte aujourd'hui plusieurs, tels que le Proctor, l'Académie de Musique, le Français, le National, les Nouveautés, le Palais Royal, le Parc Sohmer, pour ne citer que les plus fréquentés.

Parmi les grands journaux qui se publient à Montréal, il faut compter la *Presse*, le *Star*, la *Patrie*, le *Herald*, la *Gazette*, le *Journal*, le *Witness* et le *Canada*. Le plus répandu de ces journaux est la *Presse*, dont le tirage, chaque jour, atteint jusqu'à 72,000 exemplaires.

Montréal possède encore plusieurs bibliothèques publiques et un musée historique, le "Château Ramezay" (rue Notre-Dame), fort apprécié de tous ceux qui le visitent.

Nous remarquons de plus à Montréal un grand nombre de sociétés de bienfaisance et de cercles pour l'avancement des arts et des sciences.

Il se donne gratuitement, tous les soirs, à la seule bâtie du Monument National, (rue St-Laurent) des cours distincts sur une douzaine au moins de sujets différents, par des professeurs spécialistes, très renommés,

Sur le versant nord-ouest, sont situés les cimetières catholique et protestant, lesquels couvrent un espace de plus de 450 arpents. C'est notre cité des morts, très intéressante à visiter. Les belles allées bordées d'arbres, de fleurs et de verdure, les nombreux monuments funéraires et les riches caveaux que l'on y remarque, en font certainement l'un des beaux cimetières du continent.

Plusieurs compagnies de bateaux et de chemins de fer ont leurs principaux bureaux d'affaires à Montréal; citons entre autres: celles d'Allan, du Richelieu, du Grand Tronc et du Pacifique.

Quent au service des Tramways, deux compagnies s'en partagent le contrôle, et leurs chars circulent d'une façon régulière à travers les principales rues de la ville, constituent un parcours de plus de deux cents milles de voie ferree.

Aux abords des gares de chemins de fer, les voyageurs trouvent de nombreux et vastes hôtels, et des plus confortables, dont les principaux sont le Richelieu, le Queen, le St. James, le St. Lawrence Hall, le Carslake, le Viger et le Windsor. Ce dernier compte pas moins de 400 chambres, 16 salons et possède une magnifique salle de concert très fréquentée.

Montréal est encore remarquable pour ses résidence privées, dont plusieurs sont élégantes, riches, princières même. Les rues Dorchester, Sherbrooke, tout le Beaver Hall, Ste-Catherine ouest, St-Denis, St. Hubert, Cherrier, Parc Lafontaine, Avenue du Parc et autres, y compris le Westmount, sont celles qui en comptent le plus. Partout ces rues sont bordées d'arbres et de parterres au gazon parsemé de fleurs.

Les environs de Montréal ne manquent pas non plus de charme pour le touriste qui y admire tout à son aise les beautés d'une nature riche, fertile et tranquille,

Montréal, aujourd'hui la métropole du Canada et l'une des villes les plus intéressantes du continent, est sans doute destinée, grâce à sa position géographique et au trafic énorme qui vient de l'Ouest, à devenir non-seulement une ville très importante au point du commerce, mais la rivale en quelque sorte de New-York et de Chicago.

Trip 2. Take a Notre-Dame St Car, any time going east, change at La-salle St. for a Terminal Electric car and pay a visit to the chapel of the Reparation. A 4 hours drive for 35 cents.

3. Around the Mountain:

Take the Mountain and Côte des Neiges etc., car going North at corner of St. Catherine and Bleury Streets. 2 hours drive for 15 to 20 cents.

4. Mountain Park:

Take an Amherst car going north or West at corner of Duluth Av., visit the two views and the tower. If you wish to see Montreal on streets cars, attend to the following indications. On any car, buy a dollar's worth of red tickets (25).

5. Take a Notre-Dame St. car going east (1 ticket) to Letourneau St. and transfer to a St. Catherine street car, going to east end of the

City and around Westmount (1 ticket); return on the same car as far as Peel av. (1 ticket) secure for transfer and board for a Windsor & St. Lawrence. Get off at Mount Royal St. and take Amherst car going west, (1 ticket); get off corner Mount Royal and St. Denis streets and take St. Denis car going south and west to end of the city; (1 ticket), you return on the same car as far as corner McGill and Craig (1 ticket), secure a transfer and take Craig & Centre Car; you get down at corner Ontario & Delormier and transfer to the Ontario and Wellington going West (1 ticket) on which you ride as far as southern limits of City; you return as far as corner Notre-Dame and McGill, (1 ticket), but ask for a transfer for Berri and Commissioners car going East. By those drives you see Montreal passing through its principal streets. To accomplish the above, one should set out at above 8 o'clock A.-M., to return about 5 o'clock P.-M. 18. To Québec:

Take the Steamboat "Quebec" or the "Montreal" which leaves Montreal every evening at 7 o'clock p.m.
