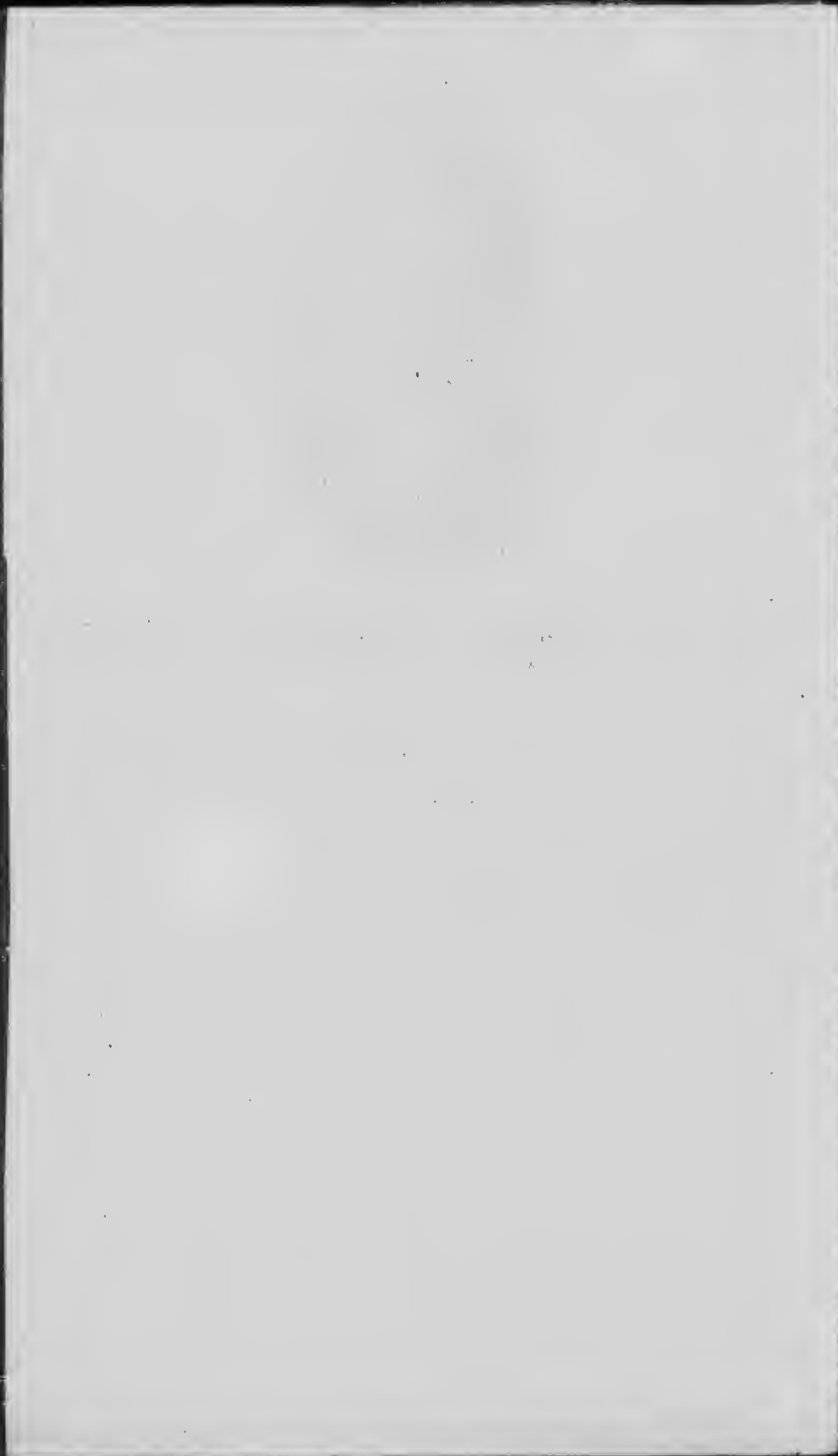




To the Electors of Quebec County

As you are aware, I have been chosen unanimously as the candidate of Sir Wilfrid Laurier at a convention held at Loretteville, the county-town, on the 12th of November.
