The Annual Synod Service was held at St. Alban's on Tuesday evening, 9th June, the Rev. Canon Cayley, Precentor, and Rev. Canons Spragge, Farncomb, and Macnab taking part, and the Rev. H. J. Cody being the preacher. The attendance of clergy was larger than usual, but there were not so many lay members of Synod as we would wish to see present, and there might very well have been more of our own congregation.

The Bishop and Mrs. Sweatman received the members of Synod and others at a garden party at the See House on Wednesday, 10th June. There seemed to be a larger number present than in some former years, among whom were many of the congregation of St. Alban's.

The surroundings were on this occasion enlivened more than usual by a cricket match in the school field between St. Alban's school and the Cavaliers of Upper Canada College, in which our boys were unfortunate and sustained their first defeat of this season, they having played nineteen matches, winning fifteen, the remaining three being drawn.

The Annual Meeting of the School Corporation was held on Monday, 15th June, when satisfactory reports as to the work and progress of the school were presented.

Rev. A. U. DePencier and Mr. W. H. Cross were elected members of the School Corporation.

The Annual Athletic Sports were held on Tuesday, 17th June, the School Championship being won by Edgar Chowne. There was a large gathering of the friends of the boys. The Bishop was present, accompanied by the Bishop of Adelaide, who was passing through Toronto and took occasion to visit the Cathedral and its surroundings, in which he appeared to be much interested.
