I. His Excellency the LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR OF NOVA SCOTIA
for the time being, and the SOCIETIES FOR THE PROPAGATION OF
THE GOSPEL, and for PROMOTING CHRISTIAN KNOWLEDGE shall be
respectfully requested to be the Patrons of this Society.

II. The Bishop of the Diocese shall be the President of the
Society, with a control over all their proceedings. His approval
shall be necessary for the completion of all important acts of the
Society, and especially for the revocation or alteration of any of
the standing rules, and for making any addition to them.

III. There shall be two or more Vice Presidents, of whom the
Archdeacon of Nova Scotia shall be the first; a Secretary, an
Assistant Secretary, when necessary, and a Treasurer.

IV. There shall be a Standing Committee, consisting of the
Officers, all the Clergy, and as many Laymen as it shall be
thought convenient to choose at the Annual Meeting of the
Society. The Lay Members shall continue in the Committee

for a year, or until other Lay Members be chosen in their place; and any or all of them may be re-elected. Seven of the Committee shall be a quorum, provided four of them be Laymen.

V. The Society shall be open to all Members of the Church; all of whom shall be invited to unite with it. Ten pounds, paid at any one time, shall qualify a person to be a Member during his life; and the payment, in advance, of any sum, however small, shall qualify a person to be a Member for a year.

VI. The Members of the Church, in every part of the Province, shall be invited to co-operate with the Diocesan Society, by joining Committees of it, which shall be formed, under the direction of their respective Clergymen, either in each Mission or Parish, or in more than one Mission or Parish united, as shall be deemed most convenient, and in strict accordance with the design and rules of the Diocesan Society; and it is recommended to the Committees to forward their funds, as they may be collected, to the General Committee, who will faithfully apply them to the general objects of the Society; but when the Local Committees desire it, they shall receive books, at cost and charges, to the amount of one-fourth of their remittances.

VII. There shall be one General Meeting of the whole Society, including any Members of the Local Committees who can conveniently attend, on such day and at such place as the President may name, of which due notice will be given, with an invitation to every Committee to send at least one Clergyman and two Laymen to represent such Committee, and with a recommendation that each Committee shall meet at some convenient time, immediately before the General Meeting of the Society, that any necessary suggestions may be offered to the representatives of the Committees for their guidance at the General Meeting. And a Special General Meeting may be called at any time and in any place, when the President, or, in his absence, two or more Vice Presidents, shall consider it desirable to appoint such Special General Meeting.

VIII. The objects to which the attention of the Society shall be directed, shall be, generally, those which have engaged the two great Church Societies, in England, for the Propagation of the Gospel, and for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other.

IX. The following objects shall more particularly engage the attention of the Society, as soon as their means may enable them to afford such attention:—

- 1.—Supplies of Books and Tracts from the stores of the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, and none other, except in cases where other Books or Tracts, in strict conformity with the principles of the Established Church, and particularly adapted to local circumstances, shall first be carefully examined and approved by a Committee of revision, to be appointed by the General Committee,—the approval of which General Committee shall be necessary in the next place,—after which, the books must likewise receive the written approbation of the Bishop.
- 2.—Missionary visits to neglected and destitute places, under the direction of the Bishop.
- 3.—Upholding, by all possible and proper means, the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.
- 4.—Assistance to deserving young men, desirous of being qualified for the Ministry of the Church, but requiring aid in pursuing their studies, at the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.
- 5.—Aid to Sunday and other Schools, in which due attention is paid to instruction in the principles of the Established Church.
- 6.—Encouragement to the instruction and training of respectable Teachers for Sunday and Daily Schools.
- 7.—Assistance to the erection or enlargement of Churches and Chapels belonging to the Established Religion, in peculiar or extreme cases.

To these objects, generally, the general contributions will be applied; while contributors, who desire it, may have their individual contributions scrupulously confined to any one or more of these objects. And as some Members of the Church, who are not unmindful of the great spiritual wants in their own neighborhood, still feel constrained, in pious gratitude for the blessings they enjoy, to allot something, however small, from the means with which a gracious Providence has blessed them, towards the spread of the glorious Gospel among the nations which still sit in darkness—

X. This Society will gladly receive and forward to the Society for the Propagation of the Gospel, whatever sums may be given for the conversion and instruction of the Heathen,—to which object such sums will be strictly confined by the East India Committee of that Society.

XI. Books and Tracts will generally be on sale, at cost and charges;—and whenever, in particular cases, a deviation from this

rule is desired, it must be considered by the Standing Committee, and only permitted when recommended by them and approved by the President, or, in his absence, by two or more of the Vice Presidents.

XII. All Meetings of the Society and of the Committees shall be opened and closed with the prayers used by the two Societies in England, adapted to our situation under the direction of the Bishop.

- 1. Supplies of books and Tracts from the stores of the Society for the use of the Committees of which General Commissions shall be the next place, after which the books must likewise receive the written approbation of the Bishop.
 - 2. Ministers visit to neglected and declining places, under the direction of the Bishop.
 - 3. Upholding by all possible and proper means, the Collegiate Establishments at Windsor.
 - 4. Assistance to deserving young men, students of being admitted for the study of the Church, but requiring aid in pursuing their studies at the College of Exeter or at Windsor.
 - 5. Aid to Sunday and other Schools, in which due attention is paid to instruction in the principles of the Established Church.
 - 6. Encouragement to the instruction and training of respectable Teachers for Sunday and Day Schools.
 - 7. Assistance to the erection or enlargement of Churches and Chapels belonging to the Established Religion, in peculiar or extreme cases.
- To these objects, generally, the General Commissions will be applied; while contributors who desire it may have their individual contributions separately confined to any one or more of these objects. THE Annual Meeting of the DIOCESAN CHURCH SOCIETY OF NOVA SCOTIA took place in the Masonic Hall, at Halifax, on Wednesday, 24th February, 1847, at 7½ o'clock in the evening.

His Excellency SIR J. HARVEY took the chair at 7½ o'clock, and the proceedings were opened by an invitation to those present to sing two verses of the Hundredth Psalm.

The Venerable Archdeacon WILLIS read Prayers.

His Excellency SIR J. HARVEY then briefly stated the object of the meeting, and called upon the Secretary to read the following—

REPORT.

A sense of gratitude to our late Secretary, for the efficient aid which, for so many years, he gratuitously rendered to this Society, suggests the propriety, at this early stage of our proceedings, of recording the expression of our deep regret that the state of his health should be such as to render his retirement from official duty necessary, and that the Society should, in consequence, be deprived of his valuable services. We sympathize with him in his affliction, while we regret the loss which our cause will sustain in being deprived of his advocacy on the present occasion.

The Church Society, which owes to his zealous labors, as Secretary, so much of its prosperity, and in behalf of which we are now assembled together, has strong and acknowledged claims upon our sympathies, as Churchmen. The object which it contemplates, and the instrumentality which it employs, are

such as to commend it to the generous support of every friend of Evangelical truth and Apostolic order. The object proposed is the glory of God and the spiritual good of men; and the instrumentality employed is in perfect harmony with our Ecclesiastical discipline, viz. the members of the Church co-operating with their Bishop, encouraged in their efforts by his counsel and guidance, and striving together in diffusing throughout the Diocese those principles which are dear to themselves, and in spreading the knowledge of that Gospel which has gladdened their own hearts. It is true that the benevolence of the Gospel knows nothing of boundaries,—the world is the field for Christian enterprise,—yet, surely, our own land has the first claim upon our sympathy and love. Its soil may be barren, and its climate ungenial; yet are we bound to it by many and endearing ties; and while it would be criminal to disregard the cry for help, when that cry reaches us from distant regions, how much more so when it comes forth from the moral wilds and deserts of the land in which we dwell. This is a feeling which powerfully exercised the Apostle Paul; for, though he was emphatically the Apostle of the Gentiles; and though he prayed and labored that all men might be saved; and though nothing could satisfy the ardent longing of his soul short of the kingdoms of this world becoming the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, yet the salvation of his own countrymen was the object ever nearest to his heart; and the claims of his “kindred according to the flesh” he felt to be superior to the claims of all others. Actuated by similar feelings, our first efforts are directed towards the spiritual good of our countrymen; and to send the Gospel with its blessings to our less favored brethren, cut off, as many of them are, from the ordinances of religion, and struggling with the difficulties of a new country, is the holy object of our association. A wide door and effectual is opened up, and we are invited to go in and possess the land; and it is a subject for devout thanksgiving to Almighty God, that the members of our Church, at length awakened to a sense of their responsibility, are responding to the call of duty, and coming up to the help of the Lord,—to the help of the Lord against the mighty.”

INCOME.

The following remittances from the Local Committees have been received during the past year:—

ANNAPOLIS.—From this Mission has been forwarded the very handsome sum of £31 6s. 9d. The Rev. E. Gilpin, in transmitting it, writes in the most encouraging strain, and assures us “that the interest of his people, in the design and advancement of the Church Society, is gradually gaining that strength which it ought to possess.”

AYLESFORD.—The contributions of this Mission have very largely increased during the present year, amounting to £19, inclusive of £1, contributed by Mr. W. Tupper, in aid of Missions to the Heathen.

BRIDGETOWN.—The sum of £11 15s. 9d. has been received from this Mission, which shews a slight falling off from that of the preceding year, not from any want of zeal in the Society's cause, as the Rev. Mr. Robertson assures us, but from the force and pressure of local circumstances.

BARRINGTON.—From this place, which has not yet had the advantage of a stated Minister, the Rev. Mr. Snyder has transmitted the sum of £3.

CHESTER.—The Rev. Dr. Shreve has transmitted from this Mission the sum of £15, conveying, at the same time, the good wishes, both of himself and people, for the continued prosperity of the Society.

CORNWALLIS AND HORTON.—The remittance from this Branch is £8 15s. 10d. The annual subscriptions, we are informed, have not decreased, but the Missionary's health not having permitted him to exert himself as formerly, the amount forwarded is not quite so large as in the preceding year.

DARTMOUTH.—The exertions of this Branch are worthy of the highest commendation. The amount collected this year is £26 1s. 8d., a fact which seems to say that they are determined to take their stand, as formerly, in the front rank of the auxiliaries of the Society.

DIGBY.—From this Branch has been received £25. In addition to this, it is our pleasing duty to record a donation of £10, from Mr. Wm. Johnson, of Digby Neck, constituting him a Life Member of the Society. The Rev. Mr. Bullock, in communicating the gratifying intelligence, thus writes:—"Be pleased to acquaint the General Committee of the Church Society, that our Treasurer has received from Mr. Wm. Johnson, of Digby Neck, the sum of £10, with the request to be enrolled a Life Member of the Society, and with an assurance of providing another like sum, to be payable at his death. I have the greater pleasure in making this communication, as the donor is in humble life, and because, in all probability, the offering is more in amount than a tenth of all the money he possesses in the world."

GRANVILLE.—From this Mission the sum of £17 has been remitted, affording most convincing proof of the unabated favor in which the Society is held in that portion of the Diocese.

YARMOUTH.—The Rev. Mr. Moody, who has recently been appointed to this Parish, has sent forward the handsome sum of £40. Of this sum, £10 have been contributed by Dr. James Collins Farish, constituting him a Life Member of the Society. It is requested that said £10, together with £15 of the remaining £30, may be appropriated to King's College, Windsor,—leaving £15 for the general purposes of the Society.

LUNENBURG.—The Rev. J. C. Cochran has paid in the sum of £25, and reports very favorably of the good feeling of his people towards the Society.

ST. CLEMENTS.—The Rev. Mr. Godfrey has sent forward the sum of £11.

NEWPORT.—The Rector of this Parish has remitted £10 4s. 4d. and is full of hope as to the continued interest of his people in the prosperity of the Society.

SHELBURNE.—The Rev. Mr. White has remitted £17, and presents the thanks of himself and people to the General Committee for their past liberality to his Mission.

PICTOU.—The contribution for Pictou this year is £14 8s. 1d. shewing a considerable increase above that of last year, and afford-

ing gratifying proof that as the objects of the Society are better understood, its friends will multiply. Of this sum, £1 15s. is to be appropriated to Windsor College.

TRURO.—The annual meeting of this Branch took place on 21st January, and the Rev. Mr. Leaver writes "that it was encouraging to observe that the duty of using greater exertions to support the Church among us, now that the benevolent Societies in England feel it their duty to devote their funds to newer Colonies, and to the improvement of the opportunity opened by Providence in Eastern lands, was fully recognized and advocated." Their contribution amounts to £13.

SACKVILLE.—From this Mission there has been sent forward the sum of £11 0 7½d.

GUYSBOROUGH.—The remittance from this Branch amounts to £17 4s. 1d., which shews a considerable increase above that of last year.

WEYMOUTH.—The Rev. Mr. Snyder has remitted the sum of £9.

WINDSOR.—The Rev. Alfred Gilpin has sent forward £18 4s. 2d.—one pound of which is for the Church Missionary Society.

MARGARET'S BAY.—The Rev. Mr. Stannage has paid in £9 7s. 11½d.—a contribution which does great credit to his people, pressed, as they just now are, with local objects.

HALIFAX.—The contributions in behalf of the Society, from this city, amount to £168 12s. 9½d., which we trust will be largely increased by the contributions of this evening, and the collections of Sunday next. The above sum includes the collection taken up at the Harmonic Hall, in June last, amounting to £12 6s. 11½d.

LIVERPOOL.—The Rev. Mr. Nichols, who has been recently appointed to this Mission, has forwarded £20.

MAHONE BAY.—The Rev. Mr. Filleul has handed in £13 4s. 5d., and speaks encouragingly of the interest of his people in the good cause.

RAWDON AND DOUGLAS.—The Rev. Mr. Maynard has paid in £15 5s. 1d., and speaks most gratefully of the liberality of his people, and their continued interest in the prosperity of the Society.

EASTERN SHORE.—The Rev. Mr. Jameison, to whom the charge of this extensive district is committed, has this day handed in £27 18s. 4d. as the contribution of his poor but noble hearted fishermen. This is an offering which, when the circumstances of the people are taken into account, deserves, and no doubt will receive, the marked thanks of this Society.

The several subscriptions and contributions above enumerated, amount to £597 10s. 0d.

EXPENDITURE.

MISSIONARY VISITS.—During the past year the following appropriations have been made. It has long been the earnest wish of the Committee, to provide for the support of Visiting Missionaries, for the more destitute settlements of the Province; and in the last year they determined, with full hope of largely increased assistance, to make such provision for two Missionaries, who might travel through the Eastern and Western portions of the country most in need of their spiritual instruction. Search has been made for men duly qualified for this important work, but as yet none have been found within the Province; and inquiries for them in England have been equally unsuccessful. The inquiries will be continued with unremitting perseverance, and the Committee indulge the hope that their efforts will, at no distant day, be successful. The most that could be effected, in the last year, was a visit of several weeks in the more remote and destitute settlements at the Western extremity of the Province, by the Rev. E. E. B. Nichols, now appointed to the Mission of Liverpool; and subsequently, by the Rev. W. H. Snyder, Missionary at Weymouth, to the same parts; who, at the request of the President, undertook this duty, and have forwarded to the Committee reports of their journeys and labors. The call that was made, in the last year's Report, upon the members of the Church in the city to come forward and at least double their contributions to the treasury of the Society, has not been unheeded. Several members have cheerfully responded to it, and it is earnestly hoped that their example will be imitated by many others, who will rejoice

to strengthen the hands of the Society for the extension of their labors of love.

The Committee have paid to the Rev. E. E. B. Nichols, to defray the actual expenses incurred by him, in Missionary Visits to Barrington, £7 10 0

To Rev. Mr. Snyder, for a like purpose, 12 10 0

The sum of £20 has also been placed in the hands of the Ven. Archdeacon Willis, to meet Missionary expenses during the past year, 20 0 0

Amounting, in all, to £40 0 0

LAY READERS.—By a resolution of the General Committee, passed on the 18th June last, relative to the payment of Salaries to Lay Readers, the consideration of which had been postponed until the clergy should meet in visitation; the resolution of March 1st, 1844, that the amounts heretofore granted for the Salaries of Lay Readers should cease, was carried into effect,—in consequence of which, this expenditure ceased with the expiration of the past year.

BOOKS.—The Local Committees, as usual, have generally availed themselves of the privilege of receiving back in Books the amount of one fourth of their remittance.

There have been issued from the Depository of the Society during the past year, 119 Bibles, 156 Testaments, 1028 Prayer Books, 6535 Tracts, 1161 bound Books, and other Publications.

The various appropriations thus referred to, when added together, amount to £389 16 10.

From the balance of £349 19 5, which appears in the Treasurer's account on 31st Decr., 1846, the sum of not less than £90 is appropriated in defraying the second moiety of the Grants mentioned in the preceding Report.

The Committee cannot close this Report without congratulating the Society on the steady progress which the Redeemer's cause is making among us. True, with us it is but the day of small things, yet our efforts have been evidently owned and blessed of the Most High. And how cheering the reflection, that at a time when the venerable Societies in England, which, with parental love and tenderness, cared for and cherished us while in infant weakness, have felt constrained to withdraw, to some extent, their helping hand, and leave us to lean upon our own strength, and rely upon our own resources—how cheering is the reflection that at such a time the Church should be found in some measure equal to the emergency, and determined, with God's blessing, to enter upon the cultivation of that field which otherwise must go waste. Those noble Societies have most properly directed their efforts to other lands. India is stretching forth her hands to them for help. China, with her millions, is sending forth her exploring cry.—The voice of Providence is heard from those lands, proclaiming with a distinctness that cannot be misunderstood, "Prepare ye the way of the Lord, make his paths straight."

Who among us then will regret—what christian heart will not rejoice that the Church in Nova-Scotia should be thrown upon the sympathies of her own children for the supply of their reluctant lack of service, while the good Providence of God is making those noble Societies the honored instruments in his hand of spreading among the Heathen the knowledge of his saving name, and converting the moral Deserts and Valleys of the East into the fruitful gardens of the Lord.

II.—Resolved, That whilst thankful for the measure of success, which has hitherto attended our efforts, yet, that this Society will not have fulfilled its duty, nor the Church in Nova Scotia have assumed her proper attitude as a Missionary Church, until the wish of our Diocesan, so often expressed, is fully carried out, and every baptized individual of our Holy Communion has been enrolled as a Member of the Society, and become a contributor to its Funds.

Which was seconded by Rev. Mr. COCHRAN, and passed.

Rev. Mr. LEAVER moved the third Resolution :

III.—Resolved, That as the Church must mainly depend, for Laborers in the Lord's vineyard, upon the supply to be derived from the College at Windsor, this Meeting hails with satisfaction the exertions which have been put forth to sustain this Institution in efficiency, and calls upon the Members of the Church through the Province to give their aid to this good work.

Which was seconded by the TREASURER, and agreed to.

The Hon. the CHIEF JUSTICE moved the fourth Resolution :

IV.—Resolved, That the thanks of this Society are due to those Members who hearkened to the call made upon them at the last Meeting, and doubled their subscriptions. The Society trust that this good example will be speedily followed by all whom God has pleased to enable so to do.

APPENDIX.

As great inconvenience has resulted from the general practice of the Local Branches in delaying too long the sending forward of their Reports, the following Resolution was passed at a General Meeting held on 18th Feby., 1847:

Resolved, That in order to ensure the insertion of the proceedings of the Local Committees in the Annual Report of the Society, it will be necessary that their Contributions and Report should be sent forward on or before the 31st day of Decr., in each year.

Inconvenience having been experienced also by the General Committee from the want of attention to the following particulars, the notice of the Presidents and Officers of Local Committees is particularly requested to them, viz:—

The General Committee meets in Halifax on the third Tuesday in each month, from November to May inclusive; and all applications for aid should be forwarded to the Secretary at least a week before either of those dates.

Every application for aid should contain the following information, in defect of which the application must be postponed for fuller particulars:

For aid in the erection of a Church—

- 1.—The precise situation, specially with reference to the nearest Place of Worship, and to the amount of population within five miles of the Church.
- 2.—The Title of the Ground, on which the building is to be erected.
- 3.—The size of the building; the numbers it can accommodate; and probable amount of the congregation that will usually attend it.
- 4.—The supposed cost of the building; the progress it has made towards completion; and the amount of contributions on the spot in money or labour.

For aid to Day and Sunday Schools—

- 1.—The Title to the Ground on which the School House was erected.
- 2.—The situation of the School as regards the nearest adjoining School.
- 3.—The number of scholars in usual attendance, and the general circumstances of their parents.
- 4.—Is the Church Catechism taught? and the School generally conducted with a due regard to the principles of the Established Church?
- 5.—The nature of the aid required: whether books, assistance towards Master's Salary, &c.?

The Annual General Meeting of the Society will, for the future, be held within the first ten days of Lent, or as near thereto as the General Committee shall decide upon: and it is desirable that Local Committees should hold their Anniversary Meetings, and make their Annual Collections some time in the month of January, in order that their proceedings and remittances may be acknowledged in the Annual Report presented at the General Meeting.

APPENDIX II.

For the information of Local Committees applying to the Depository of this Society for Books and Tracts, it is thought desirable to publish the following extract from the minutes of the General Committee, under date of May 7, 1841.

"The Chairman of the Sub-Committee, to whom the concerns of the Depository were entrusted, reported several Resolutions which had been agreed to by the Sub-Committee, and are as follows:—

"I. *Resolved*, That whereas the Diocesan Church Society can receive no books from the Society for Promoting Christian Knowledge, except to the amount of the sum remitted with the order—no books can be supplied from the Depository of the Diocesan Church Society, unless the orders be accompanied with a remittance to the full amount.

"II. That all outstanding debts due the Depository be immediately called for, and, until they be satisfactorily arranged, no further supply of books shall be issued to those who are in arrears.

"III. That be requested to forward their accounts without delay to the several persons indebted to the Depository, together with a copy of these Resolutions.

"Whereupon it was *resolved*—

"That whereas the importation of books to the Depository must, by the present arrangement of the Book Fund, depend entirely upon the returns made for books supplied from the Depository, the Committee feel bound to approve of and adopt the Resolutions of the Sub-Committee."
