

BILL.

An Act to amend the laws regulating the Election of Members of the Legislative Assembly in certain Counties, in so far as relates to the Return of Writs.

W HEREAS the Magdalen Islands in the Gulf of Saint Preamble. Lawrence, which are included in and form part of the County of Gaspé, as well as certain other parts of the said County, are inaccessible at certain periods of the 5 year and with difficulty accessible at any season, and whereas certain parts of the said County, and of the County of Saguenay, are situate at great distances from the public place most central and most convenient for the great body of the Electors in each of the said Counties, at

- 10 which the Returning Officer is by law bound to proceed to the election of a Member to serve in the Legislative Assembly of this Province, whenever a Writ of Election is issued for that purpose, and it is therefore expedient and proper to provide for such Writs being made return-
- 15 able so as to obviate the possibility of either of the said Counties being at any time unrepresented for want of a sufficient delay between the issuing of any such Writ and the period at which the same may be made returnable, or for want of time to give the necessary notices in pur-
