Parcel No. 1.—Sub Lot, Number Twenty-four, West side of Eureka street, containing three and a-half acres, more or less, on which are situated the Parsons Wells, Nos. 1 and 2, with Engines, Boilers, Derricks, Engine Houses, Machinery, Tanks, &c., &c., in complete working order, with a string of good two-inch tubing from the wells to the G. W. R. Station and shipping tanks at Station.

Parcel No. 2.—Seven and one-half Acres off the North-east quarter of Lot No. 12, in the 1st Concession of Enniskillen, on which are situated the Gem, Moonlight and Eclipse Wells, and the machinery of said wells complete.

Parcel No. 4.—The South Quarter of Lot No. 11, in the 11th Concession of Enniskillen, (now in the Town of Petrolia), containing fifty acres, more or less. This lot is well cleared, fenced and in a good state of cultivation, with good buildings, and is well adapted for a farm.

Township of Enniskillen.

Parcel No. 5.—The East-half of Lot No. 4, in the 13th Concession of Enniskillen, containing one hundred acres, more or less. This property is situated about two miles East of the Village of Marihville, and is situated in what is considered the best virgin oil territory in Lambton. On the east side, and adjoining this land, are situated the famous Noble wells. On the North the celebrated Coral well, and on the South are situated a number of good producing wells. The property has been subdivided into one acre lots, and will be sold in parcels to suit purchasers.

Parcel No. 6.—The East-half of Lot No. 30, in the 1st Concession of Enniskillen, containing 1.0 acres, more or less. This property is situated near the town line between Enniskillen and Brooke, and is well timbered, and well adapted for a farm.

Parcel No. 6.—The East-half of Lot No. 30, in the 1st Concession of Enniskillen, containing 1.0 acres, more or less. This property is situated near the town line between Enniskillen and Brooke, and is well timbered, and well adapted for a farm.

Parcel No. 7.—The East-half of Lot number eleven, in the thirteenth concession of Enniskillen, containing one hundred acres, more or less; this land is situated in or near the heart of the oil territory, near the famous Montcalvo oil wells; it is nearly all cleared, and partly fenced with a dwelling house situated thereon. The soil is well adapted for farming.

Parcel No. 8.—The West quarter of Lot number 15, in the thirteenth concession of Enniskillen, containing fifty acres, more or less; this land is cleared, and situated in a good farming locality, in close proximity to the oil territory.

Parcel No. 9.—Part of North-east quarter of Lot number eleven, twelfth concession of Enniskillen, containing one acre.

Parcel No. 10.—The West half of sub lot number forty eight, survey of lot number eleven in the twelfth concession of Enniskillen.

Parcel No. 11.—The South half of sub lot number seven, in the survey of the South half of the East half of Lot number eleven, in the twelfth concession Enniskillen, containing two and one-half acres, more or less.

Parcel No. 12.—The East half of lot number twenty, in the Eleventh concession of Enniskillen, containing one hundred acres, more or less. This property is situated about one mile from the Town of Petrolia, is well timbered, and is adapted for farming.
