


A PROCLAMATION for



HEREAS, notwithstanding the Good Methods used by the Native Tribes, inhabiting the Eastern Parts of his Province, and in Peace and Friendship with His Royal Government in enduring many Acts of Violence against their solemn Treaties, they have at length perniciously excited upon the innocent People inhabiting our Frontiers, and are daily committed by some of the *Western* Tribes of Indians on the Inhabitants of the Province ; And whereas divers of the *Western* Tribes of Indians, have broken their Oath of Allegiance to His Majesty's Subjects of these Provinces, and have given their Aid and Assistance to the French, by various Artifices and unmerciful Treasures collected by the French Nation ; Which distressed the People of this Province, and put them under the Curse and Judgment of Almighty GOD against this People ;

WE have thought fit, with the Advice of His Royal Council,


