PASTORAL GREETING
TO THE MEMBERS AND ADHERENTS OF ST. GABRIEL
CHURCH.

MY DEAR BRETHREN,

I gladly avail myself of the privilege of drawing your attention to the matters embraced in the accompanying report, and to other things which have an important bearing on the welfare of the congregation.

Every department of the Church's work is in a prosperous state. The congregational organization is complete ; so that every one in the Church has a place. The past year has been, as regards the highest aims of a congregation, the most cheering in my ministry. My hands are held up as they never were before by the members of the Church. Ready help has been afforded me in carrying out every plan suggested for the good of the people ; and I desire to thank heartily all that have aided in one way or the other the work of God carried on among us. I specially thank those friends who kindly, as asked, doubled their offerings every tenth Sunday, in order to meet the financial deficit. The response made to the appeal on the last Sunday of the year, to provide for the extraordinary expenditure of the year, showed a noble spirit, and has strengthened our people's confidence in themselves.

The usual annual canvass was made by the Young People's Association, with a view to ascertaining and reaching such families in our district, claiming to belong to our communion, as are living in neglect of ordinances ; and with results which give promise of being satisfactory. Our Church being on the border line between the districts occupied by the well to do and lowly classes respectively, we have a strong leverage which we must use for keeping the people around us in sympathy with divine things. The increase of the congregation goes on steadily if not rapidly.

The balance of debt on the Church is felt to be a drag on the congregation's prosperity, and the time has come when an effort should be

made to lessen it, if not wipe it out altogether. The statement submitted by the Building Committee shows that in proportion to their means the members of the congregation generally have contributed liberally to the Purchase and Interest Fund. But how much better it would be, if the amount which they are called upon annually to expend in this way were set free, so that they might give it rather for the maintenance of Home and Foreign Missions, and the other numerous schemes by which the Church at large is endeavouring to help the extension of the Master's Kingdom. Considering the strength of the congregation and the large amount of City Mission work it has done and is doing, we may reasonably claim sympathy and aid from generous friends in other congregations; and if the members of the Church will put forth an effort to pay their subscriptions during the present year, I will see what I can do in the way of securing them assistance from outside. Besides the mortgage of \$13,000 on the Church, there is a floating debt of about \$1200 which has to be provided for. The amount subscribed and paid in altogether, on account of the Building Fund is \$5102. Besides there remain unpaid subscriptions amounting to \$3473, the most of them bearing interest at 6 p.c., or \$8576 in all, raised in six years for this fund. A vigorous effort made during the year ought to lift a large share of this burden off our beautiful edifice.

Two other things let me briefly urge. Let all help as they can to make the weekly offering system a success. Let no one undertake to give more than he or she can afford; and if any have promised too much, let them inform the Treasurer; but let them give regularly what they can. Let no arrears accumulate; and above all, let no one stay away from Church because he or she does not find it convenient to put an envelop on the plate. If you cannot give an offering, at least give yourselves to the Lord's service.

Let me add that the number present at the observance of the quarterly Communion bears too small a proportion to the entire number on our roll. There are no doubt reasons for this, some good and some not so good. But I would earnestly urge members of families so to arrange their domestic plans, as to admit of all communicants sharing sometimes in this most holy and helpful service.

Commending you anew to God and the Word of His Grace, which is able to keep you and build you up.

ANNUAL MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION
OF ST. GABRIEL CHURCH,
January 10th and 17th, 1894.

In accordance with the Constitution and By-Laws the Annual Meeting of the Congregation of St. Gabriel Church, was held in the Lecture Room on the evening of Wednesday, January 10th, 1894.

On motion of Mr. John A. Stuart, seconded by Mr. J. M. Farquhar, the Rev. Dr. Campbell was called to the chair, and Robert Stewart, Jr. requested to act as Secretary.

The report of the Trustees not being before the meeting, it was moved by Mr. J. M. Farquhar, seconded by Mr. J. R. Bain, and carried.

"That this meeting stands adjourned until the evening of Wednesday, January 17th, 1894.

The adjourned Annual Meeting of the Congregation of St. Gabriel Church, was held in the Lecture Room on the evening of Wednesday, January 17th, 1894.

Moved by Mr. A. McNaughton, seconded by Mr. Charles Byrd, and carried :—

"That the Rev. Dr. Campbell act as Chairman, and Robert Stewart, Jr., as Secretary."

After devotional exercises conducted by the Chairman, the minutes of last Annual Meeting were read and confirmed.

The report of the Trustees, also one from Mr. A. Watt as Treasurer, and one from Mr. J. M. Farquhar, Secretary-Treasurer, of the Purchase and Interest Fund were then read.

Moved by Mr. James Henry, seconded by Mr. George Pringle, and carried :—

"That the Reports and Financial Statements as now read, be received and adopted, and that the same be printed and distributed among the members and adherents of the Congregation."

Moved by Robert Stewart, Jr., seconded by Mr. M. Hodge, and carried unanimously :—

"That the past year has been one of special encouragement, as affecting the highest interests of the Congregation, and we in Annual Meeting assembled gratefully acknowledge the many favours both temporal and spiritual which have been showered down upon us from Heaven."

"That the faithful Visitors in providing for the sick and visiting the sick of the Congregation, and the Ladies' Aid Society, be commended for their year."

Moved by Mr. J. R. Bain, seconded by Mr. J. McGregor, and carried :—

“That the faithful and estimable services of the Ladies' Aid Society and Lady Visitors in providing timely assistance and comfort to those in adversity, and by visiting the sick as well as in other christian duties, are much appreciated by the Congregation, and this meeting hereby offers a vote of thanks to the members of the Ladies' Aid Society and Lady Visitors, for their attention to these duties during the year.”

It was then moved by Mr. W. Clelland, seconded by Mr. George Pringle, and carried .—

“That the Congregation continues to note with pleasure, the members forming the Choir, and their untiring zeal in leading the services of praise in the Church, and that the thanks of this meeting are hereby tendered to Mr. J. R. Bain, and the other members of the Choir for their efficient services during the past year.”

Moved by Mr. J. C. S. Bennett, seconded by Mr. W. C. McAllister, and carried :—

“That the careful and systematic instruction of the children and the young people in Bible knowledge, and the attachment to the Church of Christ, is one of the most important departments of Church Work, and this meeting now expresses its deep interest in our large and very efficient Sabbath School, and while thanking the Superintendent, and staff of Teachers, this meeting also hereby requests the Board of Trustees to make financial provision for the proper maintenance of the Sabbath School during the current year.

“That the Congregation appreciates the arduous duties of the Treasurer and Secretary, and that this meeting now tenders a vote of thanks to Mr. A. Watt, the Treasurer, and Mr. Wm. Reed, the Secretary, jointly with Mr. Andrew McAllister, for the valuable services performed in their respective offices.”

Moved by Mr. W. J. Mundell, seconded by Mr. A. Watt, and carried :—

“That the Congregation record their continued satisfaction with the Purchase and Interest Fund Committee, and now convey their thanks to the Convener, Mr. A. McNaughton, and Mr. J. M. Farquhar, the Secretary-Treasurer, for the zealous interest they have always manifested in the prosperity of the Church, and that the same Committee be appointed for the current year, with authority to take up subscriptions to this Fund, upon the usual terms, or in a special manner, with the view of cancelling a portion of the debt remaining on the Church.”

Moved by Mr. Thos. Stewart, seconded by Mr. Thos. Sonne, and carried :—

“That in accordance with Article III of the Bye-Laws, this meeting does now nominate and elect Messrs. Charles Byrd, A. McNaughton, W. Reed, and Archibald Watt, to be members of the Board of Trustees, to fill the vacancies occurring at this time, and that the interim election of Sub-Chief Beckingham, to replace Mr. James Robertson, resigned, be now confirmed.”

Moved by Mr. J. C. Bennett, seconded by Mr. P. M. McTavish, and carried :—

"That Messrs. J. R. Eakin and James Henry, be appointed Auditors for the current year."

After a vote of thanks had been tendered the Rev. Dr. Campbell, for the efficient manner in which he had filled the office of chairman, refreshments were served by the Ladies, and the remainder of the evening spent in pleasant social intercourse.

ANNUAL REPORT OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE ST. GABRIEL CHURCH.

For the year ending 31st December, 1893.

The Board of Trustees of the St. Gabriel Church have again the pleasure of placing before the Congregation the Annual Report on the Financial and Temporal affairs of the Church for the year 1893.

The Treasurer's Statement which has as usual been made out in detail, showing the Revenue and the Expenditure, will be presented.

The Purchase and Interest Fund Account, has also as usual been made out in detail, showing all receipts and payments on that account, during the past year.

These important statements are the essence of the prosperity and vitality of the Church, and the Trustees hope that the accounts will be well studied by the contributors to the Funds.

The Treasurer's Statement shows the amount received during the year, as revenue proper for the maintenance of the Church, to have been :—

It will at once be noticed that the relative figures have changed considerably, the final result being a very desirable increase in the total revenue.

The average income for the five years 1888 to 1892. was \$3060.35, giving an increase this year of Weekly offerings \$310.00, but the open Plate Collections have decreased \$53.78, making a net increase of \$256.22, to which may be added the amount of Special Collection for repairs to Cupola, &c., \$257.00, making altogether an increase this year of \$548.90.

The willingness of our people is well proved by this gratifying increase in the Revenue, and yet, besides this, it is regrettable that the Treasurer reports that the unpaid proportion of promised Weekly Offerings continues to fall into arrears, the past two years showing arrears about \$568 for weekly offerings and \$90 for pew rents. The latter amount is considered to be good and will be collected. But the arrears for weekly offerings the Trustees do not consider so favourably; and it is a subject for some thought and concern that those in arrears should see clearly that it is their duty to carry out their just dues more faithfully. The Trustees would point out that they exercise every economy possible, with the proper maintenance of the Church, and with a worthy provision for the worship of God, but in order to do this they depend upon the promised offerings being duly placed in the Treasurer's hands, with becoming regularity, and in cases of absence from the Church services, the arrears should be carefully made up as early as possible.

By a very heavy storm which passed over the city, the large iron ventilating cap on the dome of the Church was blown, off, and rolled down the roof into the street, where it was found a shapeless and useless wreck. The expense connected with replacing this large cap with a new one was very considerable. That and some other repairs to the roof, amounted to \$247.60. To meet this unforeseen expense

the minister, by a special request from the pulpit, asked the congregation for a special collection on the last Sabbath of the year. The response to this request was in every way worthy of the congregation, as the Treasurer was made happy by receiving in special marked envelopes the aggregate sum of \$257, as mentioned in his statement.

In reviewing the whole financial situation, the Board congratulates the congregation upon the growing spirit of prosperity, which has become evident, and whilst returning thanks for the increase shown in the year 1893, it is hoped that the new year now beginning will be still better. More attention to regularity would close up those embarrassing blanks called arrears. The Trustees on their part will endeavour to economise wherever possible in the expenditure.

In September last the Trustees gave an order to have the Auer Light introduced into the Church and Sabbath School, with a view both to economy of cost and improved lighting. The great heat in the gallery caused by the gas jets was an objection which it is hoped will be cured, and when sufficient time has elapsed it is hoped that the quarterly bills for lighting will also be reduced. The agreement is for one year on trial, so that, if not satisfactory, it can be changed again.

Since last Annual Meeting, Mr. James Robertson resigned his seat in the Board of Trustees, and to fill the vacancy the Trustees elected Sub-Chief John Beckingham to be Trustee. His name will be submitted to the meeting, so that his election may be confirmed regularly.

The Secretary Mr. Wm. Reed having interests which took him out of town during most of the Summer, the Board has been without the advantage of his experience and of his very useful pen as Secretary for some months; but the duties of his office have been well performed in his absence by Mr. Andrew McAllister.

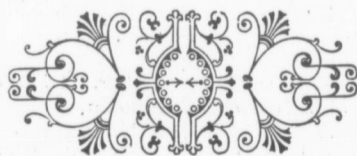
