## TOUGH DOUGHQUES OF NEWBURG

Harley Davidson and Johnson Assailed by the Newbury Staters—Contestants in Danger of Their Lives.

New York, Jan. 20.—The Herald, describing yesterday's races at Newburg, says: The most startling feature of the day's amateur sport was the exhibition of prowess given by the famous Doughques family. The races of the day showed that Johnson can skate all around them, but how the Doughques can fight, Joe, the champion, knocked down Johnson in the quarter-mile race, Jim deliberately grabbed Johnson and threw him down in the mile event. Charles Doughques knocked down Harley Davidson of Toronto, and after the five-mile race Joe Doughques struck Davidson and Johnson in the race in the drawing room set apart for the racing men. So great was the terror inspired that both of Minneapolis was the only starter in the 10-mile event, the last of the program.

## A FAMILIAR FIGURE PASSES AWAY

Ticket Taker Tom Noonan of the Island Ferry Service died at the General Hospital.

The familiar voice which has sounded "Yonge and Brock" this way—ticked at the ferry wharf on Hamilton Point for many years past will be heard no more. It was "Capt." Tom Noonan, died Saturday morning at the General Hospital, where he has been a consumption patient for over three years. "Tom" was well known to every frequenter of the Island, and his ever-obliging manner and genial assistance made him a host of friends, who will be sincerely grieved to hear of his demise.

He has been associated with the ferry business for many years, having commenced with the Toronto Company, the first ferry company running boats to the Island. He has since been with Dyer's and other companies, and has been a valuable servant of the Toronto Ferry Company since its organization. He had been subject to asthma for two or three years, and it is thought he contracted consumption a year ago. During the coming summer many will miss his smiling face on the wharves at the Island.

## A PORT DOVER BOOM.

A Summer Hotel to be built this season—The Lake Erie Railway Ferry to be in operation next July.

Application will soon be made for the incorporation of a company to build and operate a summer hotel at Port Dover. Among those interested in the project are: F. W. Cockburn, Brantford; C. W. Tisdale, M.P. Simcoe; Lawyer Finkle, Woodstock; H. W. Ansley, Port Dover; E. Harris, president of the Long Point Ferry Company; Port Dover, C. Morgan, coal merchant, Port Dover, together with some Detroit capitalists. It is expected that a good business can be done, as Port Dover is considerable of a summer resort at the present time. Each season during the past few years there have been between 300 and 500 people from different points passing the summer months at this place. The bathing at Port Dover is unsurpassed. The Grand Trunk Railway, which will be necessary for the accommodation of the railway ferry-boats that are to ply between Port Dover and Connetquot, across the lake. It is expected that everything will be ready by July 1, and the day the railway ferry-boats will begin to run between these two points. As the water in the harbor does not freeze, the system will be in operation the whole year. Between the new summer hotel and the new ferry system, Port Dover expects to have quite a boom during the present year. Port Dover is the terminus of two branches of the Grand Trunk Railway, the Hamilton and Northwestern and the Georgian Bay and Lake Erie. It would undoubtedly be a good thing for Port Dover and Toronto as well, if there were one or two through trains daily between these two points. Port Dover has much to profit by good train connection with Toronto as it is with Hamilton. The Grand Trunk ought to continue some of its Toronto-Hamilton trains through to Lake Erie. The route from Hamilton to Port Dover is almost in a straight line with the Toronto branch.
