

An Act to continue for a limited time the several Acts and Ordinances therein mentioned, and for other purposes.

HEREAS it is expedient further to continue the Acts Preamble.
and Ordinances hereinafter mentioned, which would
otherwise expire at the end of the present Session: Therefore,
Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legisblative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

The Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Lower Canada aforesaid, passed in the sixth year of the Reign of His 6 W. 4, c. 19. late Majesty King William the Fourth, and intituled, An Act to regulate the Fees of persons employed by Justices of the Peace 20 in the Country Parishes, as Clerks or Bailiffs in certain cases, shall be and is hereby continued to the said first day of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, and thence until the end of the then next ensuing Session of the Provincial Parliament, and no longer: Provided always, that in the se-25 veral Judicial Districts of Lower Canada, so much of the said Act as relates to the Fees to be granted to persons acting as Clerks to Country Magistrates, shall cease to have any force in the said Districts respectively, if or so soon as a Tariff of Fees shall have been promulgated in such District, under the 30 provisions of an Act, passed in the Session of the Legislature held in the fourteenth and fifteenth years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, An Act to facilitate the performance of the duties of Justices of the Peace out of Sessions, with respect to persons charged with indictable offences. 35

Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall prevent the effect of any Act passed during the present Session, repealing, amending, rendering permanent, or continuing to any further period than that herein appointed, any of the Acts or Ordinances hereinbefore mentioned and continued, 40 nor shall continue any provision or part of any of the Acts or Ordinances in this Act mentioned, which may have been repealed by any Act passed during the present Session or in any previous Session.
