To bring before the people of Canada the value of science applied to every branch of work. This to be accomplished by lectures, deputations, publications and personal effort.

To collect exact data, by the Secretary, through the co-operation of the members, which may be of public service in undertaking work of any kind.

To bring before the London Guild, and through them to the people of Great Britain, questions which affect Canadian interests.

To aid the London Guild, wherever possible, in bringing before the people of Canada, scientific matters which affect imperial interests.

To aid in collecting information about scientific or technical education, with a view of creating greater unity of effort and system throughout the Empire.

To aid Universities or Technical Institutes, or other places where scientific work is being done, and to assist in bringing before the public such of the work as may affect the general development and welfare of the country.
