REAL ESTATE IN BRITISH COLUMBIA—The British Columbia Western Minister, E. C. says—several of the largest tracts of farm property, which have taken place in the province, have just been concluded. Mr. J. C. Callison, formerly of Albert, N. B., has sold his farm on the delta of 800 acres to Messrs. Page Bros. of Nova Scotia, for the sum of \$62,500. The sale does not include the live stock and farming implements, which are valued at \$15,000. Mr. Callison purchased this land five years ago for \$18,000, which was considered a very high figure, and the neighboring farmers all decided that the bargain was a bad one for Mr. Callison. With the help of his five sons Mr. Callison drained and cultivated the land, and secured it into such a state of perfection that it has now been sold at a figure which exceeds the most sanguine ever dreamed would be obtained.

A NOVELTY IN BRITISH COLUMBIA—A novelty in building may be seen on Cameron street near the corner of St. George, where contractor Philip Gaudet has under way a new residence for Mr. John Galt, of the mechanical department of the C. P. R. The building to be a large one, of extreme width about 40 feet and nearly 50 feet deep. The walls are made of a composition consisting of cement, sand, calcium and asbestos. The frame or skeleton is fixed on top and this filled with the composition, which is pounded in and quickly solidifies. The frame or box is then raised up and the operation repeated. The wall is now more than half way up the first story and the bottom layers are already as hard as stone and will be still harder. When finished the walls are so strong and cannot be distinguished from stone and will be cut in imitation blocks. Mr. Gaudet, who is a master of large experience, says the building will be fire proof to stone and that the cost will be little more than stone block and considerably less than pressed brick. There is a substantial cellar under the entire building and the excavation will be watched with a good deal of interest.—Monroton Times.

British Columbia—The hull and most of the outfit of the steamer Morris, stranded at Cape North, C. B. has been purchased by E. Laing, Innes & Co.

The work of grading between Digby and Annapolis is being pushed forward very vigorously. Two pile drivers are being made use of on the bridge work.

R. T. Mullin, for some time engaged as eyes writer at the establishment of W. H. Thorne & Co., was last evening presented by his fellow employees with a letter of appreciation and a complimentary address. Mr. Mullin enters Dalhousie college next week.

The Canadian Pacific railway agents yesterday received word that the freight on the Short Line had been decided. Freight will be received at the railway stations and shipments will be made daily on and after Monday.

Arrangements are being made for the extension of the C. P. R. telegraph service to Halifax. Most of the poles have been delivered along the route, and the wire and glass have been ordered from Montreal.

A man named Blair, of St. John, was in Halifax Wednesday, looking for his wife, who skipped out with a man Doug, Summers, taking money out of Blair's pocket.—Acadian Recorder.

A Captain's Complaint of the Pilotage Regulations.

"A ship captain" writes to the Gazette complaining of the pilotage regulations that prevail at this port. He says in direct opposition to the wishes of his brokers, a pilot has within a few days been sent to a ship of more than 2000 tons, by the pilots' office, who looks upon the preference of owners and brokers with supreme indifference. When a captain comes in and complains that the pilot provided for him was without capacity and he might as well go into port without him the broker has but one answer to make, viz: That in this respect he is without any voice in the control of the property which he is expected to protect. It would be well for the government to look after the unfair and unscrupulous manner in which some of the pilots are treated. Some of the best men rarely have a chance to go for a ship. The merchants should have control as formerly, in this matter. Some of the pilots have made \$500 during the past year, while others just as capable have not made \$100. The present condition of affairs is highly detrimental to the country, and well as to the deep water trade.
