

BILL.

An Act to incorporate "Saint Francis College."

WHEREAS it has been represented to the Legislature of this Province Preamble. that divers inhabitants thereof are engaged in establishing a College at Richmond, in the District of Saint Francis, for the education of youth on liberal and unsectarian principles; And whereas it would greatly conduce 5 to the usefulness of the said College to have the same incorporated: Be it therefore enacted, &c., as follows:

There shall be and is hereby constituted and established at Richmond, in Corporation the Township of Shipton, in the District of Saint Francis, a body politic of St. Francis and corporate under the name of "Saint Francis College," which Corstituted: of 10 poration shall consist of a President, Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer whom to con-and nine Trustees, and of all the Professors of the said College, and sistshall have perpetual succession to be kept up in manner hereinafter directed, and shall have a common Seal with power to break, alter and General powrenew the same, and may in and by their corporate name, contract and en 15 be contracted with, sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded, in all the Courts of law in this Province, and shall have power to acquire, hold and alienate property moveable and immoveable, provided the net annual revenue from immoveable property held by the Corporation shall not and that all the property of the Corporation be For what pur-20 exclusively devoted to the advancement of education in the said College poses only and the Schools connected therewith.

II. The following persons shall be the first Trustees of the said Corpor-First Trustees ation: Richard Norris Webber, Chester Bissel Cleveland, William Hoste Webb, George Knight Forster, Thomas Tait, William Brooke, Udolphus 25 Aylmer, Thomas Christie and Thomas Stele-and one third of them and Term of office. their successors in office shall retire at the end of each year after this Act shall go into effect, and shall be replaced by a like number of persons to be annually elected by a majority of the votes of the President, Vice-By whom President, Secretary, Treasurer, Trustees remaining in office, Professors elected after-30 of the College and Subscribers to the Stock of the Corporation, of not less wards. than twelve pounds ten shillings each.

III. The Trustees shall decide by lot which of their number shall retire Order of reat the end of the first and second year; and shall have power to make and tiringestablish By-laws (not inconsistent with the laws of this Province, and By-laws. 35 possessing no exclusive sectarian character) conducive to the advancement of education in the said College or Schools, or to the good government thereof, or of the officers and teachers thereof, or to the proper management of the property of the said Corporation.

IV. The Trustees shall appoint the President, who shall be ex officio President. 40 Chairman and one of the Trustees; and the President and Trustees (of whom seven shall concur in any appointment or removal) shall appoint Appointment of officers. Commencement of Act. and remove for reason of immorality, default or incapacity, the Vice-President, Secretary, Treasurer and Professors, and other officers and teachers or agents of the College: And this Act shall be held to take effect on the day of appointing the first President.

The President with consent of the Trustees and Professors or of two 5 fer degrees, &c thirds of them, shall have power to give and confer all such diplomas, degrees, honors and licences, as are usually conferred in Colleges or Universities, having in all cases due regard to the morals and merits of the Proviso: when candidates therefor: Provided that this section shall not be acted upon until such time as the Governor of this Province shall signify that the 10 power shall be College is in such a state of educational efficiency as to render it expedient that they should then exercise that power.
