REPORT.

The Missionary Meeting has become a marked feature in the arrangements of the church in modern times. Whether the general character of that church will bear a comparison with that of former periods, or whether, as some believe, Christianity in its modern aspects is less pure, less earnest, and less devoted in the work of saving men, it is undeniable that associations to promote the extension of the Redeemer's kingdom have become almost a necessity of our ecclesiastical existence. A sectarian ambition may, in some instances, have originated these associations; but the pecuniary resources they provide, the zeal they exhibit, the devoted labourers they call forth and sustain, and the undeniable good they have effected, proclaim them associations of a useful and beneficent character.

The genius of the gospel evidently warrants and demands such associations for its due expression and developement. However holy, happy, or zealous the individual Christian may be, he does not find the sweetest of his enjoyments to consist in eating his morsel alone. However numerous, or influential the Christian church may be, it seems to live in an element unfriendly to its health and vigour, unless it stretch out its arms to embrace the uninstructed and unsaved who lie far beyond. Christian privileges are but ill appreciated when they are retained in a monopolizing and selfish spirit. A fellowship of holiness and happiness is the only true and healthy condition of our spiritual being. While there are souls to save; while whole nations

and tribes of men remain in ignorance, in barbarism, and spiritual death, a Christian spirit would lose its purity and expansive beneficence ere it could rest contented amidst such claims upon its active and generous interference to help and save the lost. It is by Christian co-operation and enterprise that Zion has lengthened her cords and strengthened her stakes. It is by the vitality of her principles, and the zeal of her sons that she still lives amidst the ruins of so many institutions raised up to oppose her progress and thwart her designs: and never will the genius of the Gospel be fully developed until provision is made for still wider conquests than those already achieved; until provision is made for the instruction and salvation of every nation and people under heaven, and until the earth shall be filled with the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea.

It remains, however, an important question where shall we begin? The fields are white unto harvest, where shall we thrust in the sickle? Abroad and at home there are cries for help. Forms of error to be overturned, and of spiritual destitution to be supplied, may be called legion for they are many. The reason and the rule of our Christian enterprise is, Go into *all* the world, and preach the Gospel to every creature. Whether at home or abroad the Christian labourer is fulfilling his mission. Whether he is striving to awaken to practical earnestness the sensibilities and energies of a people already blessed with the letter and the institutions of the Gospel, or whether he is instilling into the mind of the heathen or the savage the elementary principles of our holy religion he is still employed in his master's service, and shall enjoy his master's smile and blessing. The principal necessity is that whatever we find to do in the field we should do it with our might; and then whether we have taken a wider or a narrower, a nearer or a more remote circle as the sphere of our toils, we shall meet at last in some part of the field, and rejoice, bringing our sheaves with us.

The Society whose proceedings we are now to report may be called a Home or Domestic Mission. The sphere of its operation, though very extensive, does not lie beyond the bounds of this Province. For many years the Methodist New Connexion in England has employed missionaries in this country. And about seven years ago it was thought possible and desirable to originate an Auxiliary Missionary Society, to co-operate with the parent institution in promoting the spiritual welfare of the Province. The labours of the society have been and still are chiefly employed in the newly settled or more backward districts of the country. The ground occupied by our agents stretches from the East below Montreal to the extreme West of the Province. In this field there are employed 50 missionaries, who minister to a membership of 4149.

Associated with our movements during the past year, several pleasing features demand at least a passing notice. On nearly every part of our field of labour the tendency to enlarge our borders is manifest. This, of course has required an additional number of labourers; and although many more were required to supply the lack, it is pleasing to find a few coming forward to dedicate themselves to the work of the Lord. In the various churches associated with our beloved connexion in Canada there still exist abundant reason for combined supplication for the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Without *this* our labours will fail of success—without *this* our hopes will be blighted. Conscious, however, that both ministers and people need a deeper baptism of the Divine Spirit, your Committee would record to the glory of God, as a stimulous to effort, and for the encouragement of hope,—that during the past year several of our stations have been visited with gracious outpourings of the Holy Spirit. Under these baptismal influences, believers have been quickened and sinners brought to God. Hence amid removals and deaths, whereby our ranks have been somewhat thinned, we have a total increase of 115 and 347

on trial. This places within our connexional pale and in the enjoyment of church privileges 4496 souls. Important charge! May ministers and people feel their responsibility!

Taking into account the low prices of agricultural produce, the financial results of this Auxiliary Association are pretty fair. The sum raised is £497, which together with the usual liberal grant of the Parent Society, places quite a handsome sum at the disposal of the Annual Conference for the extension of the kingdom of the blessed Saviour. But in this our rejoicing, let a chastened spirit of trembling pervade our hearts. The aggregate subscriptions to this auxiliary amount to a considerable sum. Yet, is it not to be feared that respecting very few of its contributors could it be said, "He hath done what he could?" Greatly indeed, must our liberality be multiplied ere a sufficient amount is placed at the disposal of the Conference, to do justice to its benevolent intentions, and the many voices from whom emanate the Macedonian cry, "Come over and help us." Let us all abound in this good work.

The retirement of the late General Superintendent, the Rev. Dr. Crofts, from the Canadian work, and the entrance of his successor in office, the Rev. J. H. Robinson, on his new scene of labours, constitute an important feature in our connexional movements during the past year. Your Committee would, however, record with pleasure, their sense of gratitude to the beloved parent body for the evidence of their continued regard for our welfare, so clearly evinced in the selection of one whose talents, experience, and business habits so admirably fit him for the responsible office of General Superintendent of this mission. And in terms no less respectful would your Committee record its sense of gratitude to the Rev. J. H. Robinson, who has willingly torn himself from the dearest earthly associations, and from the land of his nativity, in order to promote the interests of the blessed work of evangelization in this country.

But it is with hesitation, though under a deep sense of our responsibility, that we allude to the fact, that although *nominally* the General Superintendent, our esteemed brother Robinson, has been in *reality* the stationed preacher in the city of Toronto. The lack of labourers induced our Conference at its previous session to make this arrangement,—an arrangement, however, very unsatisfactory to Mr. R.; and which we are happy to say, has this year been obviated, affording the General Superintendent time and opportunity to visit the several circuits throughout the Province. And it is the sincere prayer of your Committee that his coming among the churches may be as the Ark of the Lord to the house of Obed-edom,—the prelude of great prosperity.

Your Committee feel confident that the patrons of our Auxiliary Society will rejoice to hear that although the ocean's waves roll between us and our late esteemed General Superintendent, he is still rendering efficient services to our Canadian mission, by informing the beloved connexion at home, more fully respecting our true position and real wants. To Dr. Croft, the best thanks of this Auxiliary are due.

To the Parent Society, whose untiring zeal and abounding liberality we feel pleasure in once more acknowledging in our Annual Report, your Committee would present their sincere thanks. It is, however, essential to the prosperity of our work that while grateful for assistance generously afforded, we should diligently cultivate and zealously labour to evolve the resources we possess. The time may come, and at no distant day when the liberality of the parent body will be exhibited in an increased grant to our colonial mission. Should this take place, your Committee humbly trust that the patrons of our Auxiliary Society will feel bound to make a similar advance on their former liberality.

The past year, though not one of abundant ingatherings of souls in the parent body, has been characterized by great efforts

laying the foundation for more extensive usefulness. Chapels have been erected, chapel debts removed, Home missions cultivated with great success, and some blessed revivals of religion enjoyed. In being "watered" themselves they but enjoy the fulfilment of the promise recorded for those who "water" others.

The Irish Mission has likewise presented a most encouraging aspect. Amid the dreariness of desolation which has so long reigned in that green, though unhappy and ill-fated Isle, the Lord has graciously poured out his Holy Spirit, and refreshed and comforted his heritage. Revivals, such as were witnessed in the palmy days of Methodism, have been enjoyed on several of the stations in Ireland. Large numbers both of the Protestant and Roman Catholic population have been—

"Gathered into Christ's fold,
With his people enrolled,
With his people to live and to die."

May that good work never cease !

Presenting their best thanks to collectors and contributors, who have nobly assisted in our benevolent enterprise, and soliciting continued and abounding zeal and liberality, your Committee would conclude their present Report by calling attention to the following thrilling appeals contained in the Report of the Parent Society for last year. It illustrates the spirit by which the advocates and patrons of the Connexional Missionary Association are directed in their benevolent work.

"In concluding their report, the committee, while expressing their devout gratitude to God, for the success with which He has crowned the faithful labours of His servants, both at home and in Ireland, but more especially in Canada—cannot but express their disappointment and regret that the amount of contributions to the fund, from our home circuits, has decreased. Looking at the commercial prosperity of the country, and at the peace and spiritual prosperity with which it hath pleased the God of all grace and consolation to bless the Connexion during the preceding year, the committee had anticipated a very different and more honorable result; and willing to receive the promises of increased support, made in some of our circuits, as proofs of a deepening interest in the missionary cause, and as a pledge of a more abundant liberality in its support, they cherished the confident hope, expressed in the last report, that the year would be characterized by more ardent zeal and more vigorous efforts, and that existing engage-

ments would thus be easily met; and the sphere of our missionary operations rapidly extended. But, though in some cases pledges have been redeemed, and anticipations realized, yet the slightest perusal of the following lists of contributions will shew that the example set has been but partially imitated. Those lists exhibit, indeed, some individual subscriptions, and public collections and juvenile and sabbath school contributions, which do honour to the parties concerned, and to the character of the churches with which they are associated. In the latter respect Liverpool stands pre-eminent, and arrangements are made to render the present year still more productive than the past. But those lists present instances yet more numerous, of a very different character; and the *entire* sum raised in our home circuits for missionary objects, whether viewed in relation to the ability possessed by them, or compared with the sums raised by the Wesleyans and other dissenting Communities, must be deemed unsatisfactory by any who understand the character and objects of the religion they profess, the exigencies of the times in which they live, and the responsibilities attaching both to the churches collectively and their individual members. And earnestly do the committee wish that all our churches, and *every member* of them, would ponder the claims of the missionary cause with that seriousness which their importance deserve; claims, too, which were never more pressing than they are now.

A world, redeemed by the precious blood of the Son of God, which is his rightful inheritance, and the theatre on which the most signal triumphs of his power and grace are to be achieved, is still *in the arms of the wicked one*. While the heathen nations are wandering in the bewildering mazes of their idolatry, and are at once corrupted by its vices and debased by its orgies; at home, the powers of darkness, and the victims and votaries of superstition, together with the apostles of infidelity, under its most fascinating and most revolting forms, are marshalling their hosts in increased numbers, are drawing into closer union, and are becoming more open, and fierce and frequent in their assaults on those forms of truth which alone deserve the name of CHRISTIANITY, and on those branches of the professing church which hold with the greatest firmness *the faith delivered to the saints*. It is therefore imperative on those branches of the church, and every individual member of them, to acquaint themselves with all the means both of defence and aggression which Zion's King has provided, and with the varied weapons of both offensive and defensive warfare, which the Captain of their salvation has placed in their hands. Nor does it less become them to shake off whatever of sloth may have attached to them; to put away whatever of jealousy, or bitterness, or sectarian bigotry may have kept them asunder, and in closer phalanx, and with indomitable courage, to go forth in the name and strength of the Lord; put to flight the armies of the aliens,—plant the standard of the cross wherever fallen humanity may be found; and reduce a rebellious world to the obedience of faith. Among the weapons provided for the militant hosts, *the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God*, and which is mighty through him, to the pulling down of strongholds, stands pre-eminent; and among the means whereby this weapon has been most successfully wielded, *missionary labours* occupy a prominent, if not the most prominent place. The Saviour of the world having en-

circled the missionary character and work with the halo of his own glorious example, completed the honour thus put upon it, by commanding his apostles—his churches—and his servants wherever found, to “Go into *all the world*, and preach the gospel to *every creature*,” promising to be with them to the end of the world.

To the *Christian Church*—its officers and members—is thus committed that Word by the instrumentality of which, chiefly, the mighty change is to be effected for which the whole creation groans, and for the accomplishment of which, the sighs and prayers of the saints have, in every age, gone up to heaven: a word which, as a sword, is to be sharp in the hearts of the king’s enemies, causing them to bow at his feet;—as a medicine, is to heal the spiritual maladies of men, restore them to health and vigour; and as a treasure, is to supply all spiritual wants; and to satisfy, with the true riches, the impoverished, helpless, and otherwise hopeless, heirs of eternity. Not only, therefore, are the purposes of the world’s Redeemer and King made known to His churches, but to them also is entrusted the accomplishment of them. Thoughtlessly inattentive to his designs, or indolently neglecting them, the wounding sword may remain unused; the healing medicine unapplied; the enriching treasure unopened. Enemies may be left to triumph, and unnumbered millions may go down to the grave without help and without hope. These facts, with the dread responsibilities so obviously involved in them, the committee would press, with all possible urgency and affection, on the attention of our churches. They strongly feel, and they wish *every member of the community* strongly to feel, that Christianity is *essentially* and pre-eminently a MISSIONARY INSTITUTION, with the whole world as its theatre of enterprise, and the perfect subjugation of that world to Christ as its incomparably high and holy work. That Church, therefore, most justly appreciates its duties, and must secure the fullest measure and clearest tokens of Divine approval, in which the missionary spirit burns with the greatest intensity, and is presented in its most varied and perfect development. It becomes matter, then, of serious enquiry, how far the barrenness of some of our churches is owing to the want of that spirit; and how far, by its more diligent cultivation and correspondent fruits, the fulfilment of that promise made to the ancient church of God, may be realized, in all the fulness and spirituality of its import,—*Prove me now herewith saith the Lord of Hosts, if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*—MAL. iii. 10.

The encouragement to increased efforts, are as great as the obligations are imperative. The gradual ingathering of souls to Christ in Ireland and our home mission stations; the glorious out-pourings of the Divine Spirit in Canada; the condition of millions of our “own flesh,” and our own countrymen, perishing for lack of knowledge; and the loud and repeated calls to send to them the word of life and the messengers of salvation, present incitements which powerfully appeal to all the sympathies of the renewed heart, and encouragingly invite all the labours and sacrifices of christian faith and love. Let *all*, then, come up to the *help of the Lord, to the help of the Lord against the mighty*. Let the means recommended in the resolutions of the Conference missionary
