Provincial Legislation

On public works to determine what officers shall be paid, and also to fix their salaries. Let the members recollect that these powers are to be given to a Council over whom the rate-payers—

Supporting a County contained two rich parishes and four poor ones; under the provisions of this Bill the four poor parishes might, and probably would, decide in favor of some great public works and the people in the two wealthy parishes would be obliged to pay most of the cost. He was opposed to the appointment of those great officers, and endorsing the Municipal Corporation with unlimited powers, while none but the occupiers of the land should be the rate-payers.
